A MAN GETS ONLY WHAT HE EARNS: Pérez has surrendered just eight home runs this season in 101.0 innings of work, giving him a 0.71 HR/9 IP rate, which ranks third in all of baseball behind only Washington's Max Scherzer (0.63, 9 HR in 129.1 IP) and Atlanta's Mike Soroka (0.44, 5 HR in 102.1 IP)...he also ranks tied for 10th in baseball (6th in the AL) with 28 extra-base hits allowed. BOMBAS MEET BOMBERS: Pérez is making his fifth career start against the New York Yankees, first since August 12, 2018 at Yankee Stadium (with Texas)...in that outing, he was dealt the loss after allowing seven runs on 11 hits in just 5.0 innings pitched, and he matched up against tonight's starter CC Sabathia, who threw 6.0 innings of one-run ball with seven strikeouts.

• His last win against the Yankees came back on Sept. 8, 2017 in Arlington in what was an 11-5 Rangers win...Pérez allowed five runs (two earned) over 5.2 innings pitched that night.
