ROSTER MOVES: The Twins announced today that they have recalled left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer and outfielder Jake Cave from Triple-A Rochester...Smeltzer has made two starts for the Twins this season, posting a 3.65 ERA ( 12.1 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and nine strikeouts...Cave is 13 -for-74 over his first two stints with the Twins, but has batted .353 ( 12 -for-34) with five runs and seven RBI for the Red Wings since being optioned on June 29...to make room on the 25 -man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Kohl Stewart to Rochester and have placed outfielder LaMonte Wade Jr. on the 10-day Injured List with a right thumb dislocation.
\#BOMBASQUAD: The Twins 166 home runs are the most in baseball, ahead of Seattle (158)...they had 166 home runs all of last season.. they have a plus +58 home run differential, which also leads baseball.
$\Phi$ After Marwin Gonzalez's home run yesterday, the Twins now have 10 players with 10-plus homers (Kepler - 21, Rosario - 20, Cron -
17, Cruz-16, Schoop-14, Sanó - 13, Garver-13, Polanco-13, Castro-10 and Gonzalez-10)...Buxton has nine...the club record is 11 players in 2016.
SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins are seeking their eighth sweep of an opponent this season...their previous seven sweeps came: three games May $24-26$ vs. Chicago-AL, three games May 20-22 at Los Angeles-AL, three games May $6-8$ at Toronto, three games April 26 - 28 vs. Baltimore three games at Baltimore April 20-21, two games April 13-14 vs. Detroit, and two games April 2-3 at Kansas City...Twins recorded seven sweeps all of last season...last sweep of Texas came September 3-5, 2010 at Target Field...Twins are 7-4 when attempted to secure a sweep
ML WEEKLYS: Triple-A Rochester outfielder Jaylin Davis and Single-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Luis Rijo have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...in eight games (DH Friday) for the Red Wings, Davis hit . 364 (12-for-33) with three doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, two walks and a 1.128 OPS...Davis, 25 , was a 25th round pick by the Twins in 2015 and has hit 284 (81-for-285) with 15 doubles, 17 home runs and 47 RBI in 77 games between Double-A Pensacola and Rochester...Rijo made the start on Thursday vs. Burlington, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, no walks and 10 strikeouts...the 20-year-old Venezuela native was acquired by the Twins in 2018 from New York-AL, in exchange for right-handed pitcher and current Ranger Lance Lynn.
BIRTHDAY BOYS: Twins radio broadcasters Dan Gladden and Cory Provus are both celebrating their birthdays today...the Twins are 21-35 all-time on their birthday, tied for fourth fewest wins of any day in July...the Twins beat the Orioles on their birthday last year by a score of 5-4...they share a birthday with Gladden's former broadcast partner John Gordon, comedian Jim Gaffigan and musician Ringo Starr

Gladden appeared in five career games on his birthday, hitting . 526 ( 10 -for-19) with one double, four RBI, five runs scored and three three-hit games.
ARE YOU SIRIUS?: Today at 6 pm (CT) Progressive Field will host the SiriusXM Futures Game...two minor leaguers will represent the Twins: Single-A Ft. Myers shortstop Royce Lewis was selected and right-handed pitcher Jordan Balazovic...Lewis was the first overal pick in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft and Balazovic was drafted by the Twins in the fifth round in 2016.

LAST STINT IN THE BAY: Gibson was the starter and did not receive a decision last Wednesday in Oakland after tossing 6.0 inning, allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits with a season-high four walks and five strikeouts...marked his eighth start this season with $6.0+$ innings pitched, sixth while yielding two or less earned runs....after a clean first inning, an error and a walk preceded a Ramón Laureano three-run home run in the bottom of the second inning...Gibson wouldn't allow another run in the outing, as he went on to retire 13 of the last 19 batters he saw following the homer.

SWING AND A MISS: Gibson has recorded 93 strikeouts through 17 appearances (16 starts) and owns a $\mathrm{SO} / 9$ rate of 8.94 and a $\mathrm{SO} / \mathrm{BB}$ ratio of 3.44 ...the $\mathrm{SO} / 9$ ranks 14th in the American League while his $\mathrm{SO} / \mathrm{BB}$ rate sits 15 th.

KEEPING THINGS CONSISTENT: Gibson enters today's start with the sixth-most starts (165) and the seventh-highest innings pitched total (969.2) in the American League since the beginning of 2014...he also ranks first in opponents grounding into double plays (128, most in baseball), 11 th in wins ( 60 ) and 14th in strikeouts (749)

NO DAMAGE DONE: Gibson has only allowed 29 XBH this season, tied for the 17th fewest allowed in the AL and tied for 27th fewest in baseball among starters with at least 15 starts... opponents are slugging . 409 against Gibson, 21st lowest in the AL...Gibson has given up 14 doubles, which is tied for the eighth fewest in the AL among starters with at least 15 starts.

AGAINST THE RANGERS: Gibson is making his seventh career start and first of the year against Texas....over six starts, is 2-1, 3.16 ERA ( 37.0 IP, 13 ER) with nine walks and 30 strikeouts...last start against the Rangers was August 5, 2017 at Target Field where he was given the loss after allowing three runs on seven hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 5.1 innings pitched... last win against Texas came almost exactly three years ago on July 3,2016 , when he allowed four runs (two earned) on five hits and two walks with six strikeouts over 6.2 innings pitched.
HOME SWEET HOME: Gibson is $5-1,3.77$ ERA (45.1 IP, 19 ER) with 12 walks, 41 strikeouts and an opponents batting average of .210 ( 34 -for-162) in eight games ( 7 starts) at Target Field this season....on the road this season, Gibson is 3-3, 4.47 ERA ( $48.1 \mathrm{IP}, 24 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with 15 walks, 52 strikeouts and a 284 (56-for-197) batting average against...in his career at home, he is 29-33, 4.54 ERA (492.0 IP, 248 ER) with 166 walks and 379 strikeouts in 86 games ( 85 starts), and the 29 wins are the most by any pitcher in Target Field history...on the road, he is 33-32, 4.34 ERA (528.2.1 IP, 255 ER ) with 197 walks and 399 strikeouts in 90 starts.

JULY JOTTINGS: Gibby owns a lifetime record of 13-12 in the month of July...carries a 4.52 ERA ( 181.1 IP, 91 ER) with 61 walks and 142 strikeouts over 30 career starts...July marks one of two months over his career with a winning record; is 12-9 over 28 career starts in the month of September (also 1-0 in March)...last season, went 3-2, 3.43 ERA (39.1 IP, 15 ER) with 13 walks and 39 strikeouts in July...the strikeout totals were the most out of any month in his 2018 campaign, and marked the most he's had in that month over his entire career.

HISTORY MADE: With a Cam Callagher ground out in the sixth inning on June 14, Gibson became the 11th pitcher in Twins history to eclipse the 1,000 inning threshold... the right-hander, who began his tenure as a Twin back in 2013, became the first Twin to do so since Johan Santana, who tossed 1308.2 IP with Minnesota from 2000-2007... below are the 11 pitchers in Twins history with 1000.0+ IP:
