LAST TIME OUT: Gibson was the starter and loser his last time out on August 19 vs. Chicago-AL, as he allowed five runs (all earned) on six hits with a home run, a walk and four strikeouts in a 6-4 defeat...

Has now allowed 17 runs (15 earned) on 22 hits over four starts in the month of August, the most runs he's given up in a month this season and the most since August of last year (22 runs, 17 earned).

THE OTHER SIDE OF THE BATTERY: Over his 26 games, Gibson has thrown to each of the three catchers this season: Astudillo (3 games), Castro (9 games) and Garver (14 games)...

Mitch Garver, owns baseball's fifth-best catcher's ERA this season (min. 50 starts as catcher) at 3.82 (519.0 IP)...in fact, the 3.82 CERA is the lowest by a Twins catcher with at least 50 starts since Joe Mauer's 3.81 CERA (951.2 IP) in 2010.

AGAINST THE TIGERS: The right-hander is making his 21st career start against the Tigers, second this season...owns a career record of 8-9 with a 5.30 ERA (112.0 IP, 66 ER) against them...

Gibson is one of just three players on the current Twins roster ever on a Ron Gardenhire-managed team in Minnesota, starting 10 games for Gardy in 2013 and 31 games in 2014...

GROUND POUND: Since 2014, nobody has induced more ground ball double plays than Gibson, who has 133 over 1015.0 IP in that span...so far this season, Gibby has continued the trend, recording 14 GIDPs...

Only four Twins since 1961 have recorded more double plays than Gibson...the list includes Jim Kaat (248 from 1961-73), Brad Radke (174 from 1995-2006), Bert Blyleven (158 from 1970-88) and Dave Goltz (148 from 1972-79).

- Twins 'pen is 25-18-37 with a 4.40 ERA (433.2 IP, 212 ER), 69 holds, 150 walks & 450 strikeouts this season (128 games)...allowing a .261 opp. batting average (442-for-1696).
Relievers are 1-1-3 with six holds with a 4.35 ERA (31.0 IP, 15 ER) with 13 walks & 39 strikeouts in 10 games vs. DET this season...4.29 ERA with five holds in 21.0 IP vs. the Tigers at home in '19.
For the season, Twins 'pen ranks 7th in the AL and 11th in the majors in save percentage (67.3%, 37-for-55)...Twins are T-3rd with Kansas City in fewest relief innings pitched in the AL (433.2 IP), behind Cleveland (405.1 IP), Chicago-AI (431.1 IP).
Since the All-Star break, Twins 'pen has gone 9-8-11 with a 4.61 ERA (134.2 IP, 69 ER)...that is the sixth-highest bullpen ERA in the AL (ahead of only Baltimore, Detroit, Los Angeles-AL, Kansas City & Texas) also 12th-highest ERA in MLB...Twins bullpen also has 12 blown saves in the second half, T-1st with San Francisco for most in baseball.

- 1.1 scoreless innings last night vs. DET...has not allowed a run in his last 13 appearances dating back to July 28 at Chicago-AL...since July 28, he joins Tampa Bay's Nick Anderson (12 g, 11.0 IP) as the only pitchers to not allow a run (min. 10 games played since 7/28)...over that span, his SO/9 ratio (13.09) ranks T-10th in baseball (min. 10 games).
Has made four appearances against the Tigers this season (4 scoreless) with 4.1 IP with six strikeouts...Twins have gone 3-1 in those games.
Career 4-3 with three holds & a 3.78 ERA (47.2 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks & 39 strikeouts in 21 games vs. Detroit...1.34 WHIP in those games.

Career 24-23 with 59 saves, a 3.40 ERA (381.0 IP, 144 ER), 126 walks and 308 strikeouts in 371 games with TOR, MIA, TEX, SF & MIN.
Acquired from San Francisco on 7/31 for outfielder Jaylin Davis and right-handed pitchers Prelander Berroa and Kai-Wei Teng.
Posted a 4-1-2 record in a team-high 49 games with the Giants, including a 2.47 ERA (51.0 IP, 14 ER) with 47 strikeouts to just 7 walks...was uncared upon in 15 of his last 17 appearances with SF, allowing three runs in 17.0 innings (1.59 ERA).

Is 2-3 with 19 saves, 10 holds, a team-best 2.59 ERA (55.2 IP, 16 ER), 10 walks (2 IBB) & 72 strikeouts in 47 games this season...among Twins relievers, ranks tied for fourth in wins (2), third in games (47), first in innings pitched (55.2 IP) and first in strikeouts (72).
Leads Twins in saves (19)...19 saves ranks 7th in the AL...also ranks 4th among AL relievers (6th ML) with a 7.20 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
When pitching on back-to-back days: 0-2-2 with a 7.82 ERA (12.2 IP, 11 ER)...at least one day of rest: 2-1-16 with a 1.05 ERA (43.0 IP, 5 ER).
Recorded his seventh save of the season that necessitated six outs (2.0 + innings) 8/10 vs. CLE, first since 7/18 vs. Oakland...is the first Minnesota reliever with five-or-more such saves in a single season since Rick Aguilera saved six 2.0+ IP games in 1990...the last Twin to have at least seven 2.0-inning saves in a single season was Jeff Reardon (also 7) back in 1987.
