Dobnak, who will be in his second stint with the Twins, has appeared in three games (2 starts) for the Red Wings this month, going 2-1 with a 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER), five walks, nine strikeouts and a .167 opponents' batting average...the 24-year-old completed his single-season climb from Single-A Ft. Myers to the Twins with his Major League debut on August 9 against Cleveland, scattering six hits with three strikeouts over 4.0 scoreless relief innings...to make room on the 25-man roster, the Twins optioned left-handed pitcher Lewis Thorpe to Triple-A Rochester after Sunday's game vs. Detroit...during his most recent stint with the Twins, Thorpe made two relief appearances, allowing three runs on five hits with one walk and four strikeouts in 3.0 innings pitched. LAST TIME OUT: Pineda was the starter and winner in his last start on Tuesday against the division rival White Sox at Target Field...he allowed four runs on six hits with no walks and four strikeouts over 6.0 innings pitched...reached 800 career strikeouts becoming one of three Twins pitchers with 800 or more over their career (Jake Odorizzi-933, Kyle Gibson-825)...tossed two scoreless innings until a three-run, three-hit third inning put the Sox ahead...Yolmer Sánchez reached on a single to rightfield and would come home on a Tim Anderson double for their first run of the game and that was followed by a tworun shot from José Abreu making it a 3-2 ball game after three innings of play...pitched perfect fourth and fifth innings before giving up a solo shot to Anderson in the sixth... recorded a perfect seventh before exiting.

The Marked the first time he's allowed multiple home runs in a game since May 16 at Seattle, a span of 14 starts...also marks the first time he's give up multiple home runs vs. the Sox (7 career games).

PINEDA IS ROLLIN': Pineda is 5-2, with a 3.18 ERA (65.0 IP, 23 ER) over his last 11 starts dating back to June 13...he ranks eighth in the AL for ERA since June 13 (min. 65.0 innings pitched)...the Twins have went 8-3 over that stretch...he has allowed 59 hits, with 13 walks, 60 strikeouts and an opponents' slash line of .241/.280/.384.

- Pineda is 5-2 in his last seven decisions while going 3-1 on the road and 2-1 at Target Field over those seven.
- The has limited teams to three earned runs-or-less in 15 of his last 17 starts, dating back to May 5 at New York-AL...he owns a 3.69 ERA (100.0 IP, 41 ER) while striking out 91 batters over that stretch (Twins are 11-6), with 10 quality starts and a 1.09 WHIP.

WALK TALK: Pineda is third in all of baseball with 24 free passes this season with at least 20 starts (excludes openers)...his walks-per-nine innings rate is 1.67, which ranks sixth best in the majors among starters with at least 125.0 IP...has eight starts without walking a batter this season and 10 with walking just one.

Michael also averages one walk per 0.45 batters he faces, which is the sixth lowest in baseball among pitchers with at least 125.0 IP while his 4.71 strikeout-to-walk rate sits 15th in the majors.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Pineda is making his fourth start away from Target Field since July 26 ...has had success on the road this season, as he owns a 6-2 record with a 4.33 ERA (62.1 IP, 30 ER) with 12 walks and 56 strikeouts away from his home turf...his road numbers have fared well in 2019, but as for his career, he owns a 23-26 record away from his home ballpark with a 4.39 ERA (389.2 IP, 190 ER).

CHICAGO CALLED: Big Mike will be making his eighth career start against the White Sox here tonight and his fourth of the 2019 campaign after facing them a week ago from today at Target Field...owns a lifetime record of 4-3 with a 3.40 ERA (45.0 IP, 17 ER) with eight walks and 39 strikeouts...in his last start on Tuesday against the Pale Hose, he earned the win after allowing four runs (all earned) on six hits with no walks and four strikeouts over 7.0 innings of work, matching his season-high for innings pitched...in four career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field, Pineda is 2-2, 3.46 ERA (26.0 IP, 10 ER) while holding batters to a .217 average (20-for-92).

Over seven starts against AL Central opponents this season, Pineda is 4-1, 4.11 ERA (46.0 IP, 21 ER) with three walks and 40 strikeouts...however, in his career he is 13-12, 3.90 ERA (191.1 IP, 83 ER) with 32 walks and 184 strikeouts over 32 games (all starts).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JAKE ODORIZZI (SEASON: 13-6, 3.57 ERA // CAREER: 60-54, 3.90 ERA)

Odorizzi will be making his 26th start of the season here tomorrow night and his third against the White Sox...suffered his sixth loss of the year in his last start on August 21 vs. the Pale Hose after allowing four runs (3 earned) on eight hits in just 5.0 innings...brings a 13-6 record into tomorrow's start (T-8th most wins in the American League)...is 2-3 and owns a lifetime ERA of 3.22 (44.2 IP, 16 ER) against the Sox...is 0-1, 4.02 ERA (15.2 IP, 7 ER) with two home runs, seven walks and 21 strikeouts over three career starts at Chicago-AL.

PINEDA VS. CHICAGO-AL
