**BOMBA COUNTER:** After three home runs last night, the Twins now have 258 homers on the season, moving within nine of the MLB all-time record and within two of tying Texas' 2005 total for third...below is baseball's all-time single-season home run list:

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing each other for the 16th of 19 times this season and final time in Chicago...last night's win secured the season-series for the third straight season and sixth time in their last seven years...the Twins are 10-5 against Chicago this season, going 4-2 at Target Field and 6-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field...the Twins are 14-5 in the last 19 vs. the Sox...Twins have gone 34-19 vs. Chicago since the start of 2017, their most wins vs. any opponent since.

♣ Miguel Sanó is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with six home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.142 OPS in 14 games vs. the White Sox this season...has reached safely in 12 of the 14.

♣ Nelson Cruz is hitting .468 (22-for-47) with five doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.604 OPS in 12 games against the Sox this season...has seven multi-hit games and six multi-RBI games...Cruz's 1.085 slugging percentage is the seventh best all-time for a single-season vs. the White Sox.

MOWED DOWN BY MOTOWN: Being opposed by Drew VerHagen, who was making his eighth career start and who owned a career ERA north of 5.00, Berrios was handed a Detroit Tigers team that had won just 38 of their first 125 games...Berrios was ultimately handed his seventh loss of the season, pitching to an unsightly 5.1 IP, 5 ER, 10 H statline, but that doesn't tell the story of his start, as he was dominant through the first five innings before things quickly unravelled in the sixth.

- Berríos had traffic on the base paths early in the game, but never broke as he stranded four runners through the first three innings...faced the minimum through the fourth and fifth, including a double play ball from Victor Reyes, but was rocked for five runs on five hits in the sixth inning, punctuated by a Ronny Rodríguez grand slam.
- Despite the tough outing, Berrios is still tied for fifth in the American League (T-10th in MLB) with 17 quality starts, while 18 out of his 26 starts have gone at least 6.0 innings (including nine 7.0+ inning efforts)...not only that, but in 97 career starts, Berrios has thrown 47 quality starts (48.5 percent).

WAKE ME UP WHEN SEPTEMBER STARTS: Earlier this season, Berríos made his second career appearance in an All-Star Game, and it was ultimately deserved, as he pitched to an 8-5 record with a crisp 3.00 ERA (117.0 IP, 39 ER) with 104 strikeouts and 15 home runs allowed in 18 starts...since then, he has stumbled to a 2-2 record with a 4.89 ERA (46.0 IP, 25 ER) with 51 strikeouts and seven homers in just eight starts.

- 6 His month of August has been particularly brutal, as he owns an 8.44 ERA (21.1 IP, 20 ER) following a 12-start stretch in which he went 4-3 with a 2.31 ERA (78.0 IP, 20 ER), from May 24-July 31.
- Since the beginning of August, he has seen both of his fastballs dip in velocity, going from 93.6 MPH (12% whiff) to 92.4 MPH (8% whiff) on his four-seam fastball, and 92.7 MPH (8%
- whiff) to 91.3 MPH (4% whiff) on his two-seam fastball.

  He is no stranger to second-half swoons, as he owns a career 3.58 ERA (379.1 IP, 151 ER) from March-July (62 starts), but has pitched to a 5.56 ERA (183.0 IP, 113 ER) with 28 home runs allowed from August-October (37 games, 35 starts, includes postseason)
