MOWED DOWN BY MOTOWN: Being opposed by Drew VerHagen, who was making his eighth career start and who owned a career ERA north of 5.00, Berríos was handed a Detroit Tigers team that had won just 38 of their first 125 games...

- Berríos had traffic on the base paths early in the game, but never broke as he stranded four runners through the first three innings...faced the minimum through the fourth and fifth, including a double play ball from Victor Reyes, but was rocked for five runs on five hits in the sixth inning, punctuated by a Ronny Rodríguez grand slam.
• Despite the tough outing, Berríos is still tied for fifth in the American League (T-10th in MLB) with 17 quality starts, while 18 out of his 26 starts have gone at least 6.0 innings (including nine 7.0+ inning efforts)...

WAKE ME UP WHEN SEPTEMBER STARTS: Earlier this season, Berríos made his second career appearance in an All-Star Game, and it was ultimately deserved, as he pitched to an 8-5 record with a crisp 3.00 ERA (117.0 IP, 39 ER) with 104 strikeouts and 15 home runs allowed in 18 starts...

- His month of August has been particularly brutal, as he owns an 8.44 ERA (21.1 IP, 20 ER) following a 12-start stretch in which he went 4-3 with a 2.31 ERA (78.0 IP, 20 ER), from May 24-July 31.
• Since the beginning of August, he has seen both of his fastballs dip in velocity, going from 93.6 MPH (12% whiff) to 92.4 MPH (8% whiff) on his four-seam fastball, and 92.7 MPH (8% whiff) to 91.3 MPH (4% whiff) on his two-seam fastball.
• He is no stranger to second-half swoons, as he owns a career 3.58 ERA (379.1 IP, 151 ER) from March-July (62 starts), but has pitched to a 5.56 ERA (183.0 IP, 113 ER) with 28 home runs allowed from August-October (37 games, 35 starts, includes postseason).

EL REY DE CHICAGO: Berríos owns a lifetime line of 9-2, 2.24 ERA (80.1 IP, 20 ER) with 17 walks and 84 strikeouts over 12 games (all starts) vs. the White Sox; his 2.24 ERA is the 13th-lowest ERA vs. the Pale Hose (min. 10 starts) in the Live Ball Era (1920-present)...

- Is 2-1 with a 2.57 ERA (21.0 IP, 6 ER) against the White Sox this season...he pitched at least 6.2 innings in each of his starts against them and all three starts were quality starts.

CAREER NOTES

- Teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 Ks on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893 - when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall of Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
• Finished 2018 with 32 starts, his fifth-straight season with at least 28 starts; along with Kyle Gibson (32) and José Berríos (32), they became the first trio of Twins with 30-plus starts in the same season since 2007 (Johan Santana - 33, Carlos Silva - 33, and Boof Bonser - 30).

- Has played in 103 games for the Twins this season, hitting .256 (100-for-390) w/ 44 R, 21 2B, 21 HR, 68 RBI, 27 walks and a .790 OPS.

- Since 1970, eight different players have hit eight-plus homers vs. the Sox in one season: Albert Belle (9 in 1995), Juan González (9 in 2001), Brian Dozier (8 in 2016), Justin Morneau (8 in 2007), Eddie Murray (8 in 1987), Jim Thome (8 in 1997) and Kepler/Cruz now.
- Has 33 HR, most ever in single season by a Twins designated hitter (Chili Davis had 29 in 1991).

- Leads majors with 24 HR as a catcher...tied Joe Mauer (2009) for the second-most homers by a Twins catcher in a single season, trailing only Earl Battey (26 in 1963)...they are the only three Twins catchers to reach 20 homers in a season.

- Has hit safely in 13 of his last 17 games (6 multi-hit efforts), going 23-for-67 (.343) w/ 9 R, 4 2B, 3 HR, 13 RBI & an .909 OPS...Twins are 10-7 in those 17 games.

- AL ranks: 20th in wOBA (.378), 6th in hits (155), T-8th in 2B (34), T-8th in 3B (6), 12th in AVG (.295) & T-12th in total bases (258)...owns team-leading 44 multi-hit games (T-8th in AL), including 11 w/ 3+ hits.
