ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have recalled right-handed pitcher Kohl Stewart from Triple-A Rochester...Stewart appeared in 16 games (15 starts) for the Red Wings this season, going 6-5 with a 6.00 ERA (72.0 IP, 48 ER), 36 walks and 62 strikeouts... this will be Stewart's sixth recall of the season, including two in July...he has appeared in six games (2 starts) with the Twins, going 2-2 with a 4.66 ERA (19.1 IP, 10 ER)...to make room for Stewart on the 25-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Cody Stashak to Triple-A Rochester...Stashak appeared in five games for the Twins, pitching 7.2 innings, going 0-1 with a 5.87 ERA (7.2 IP, 5 ER) with nine strikeouts and zero walks.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Twins have gone 6-8 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Philadelphia, 1-3 vs. New York, 1-1 vs. Milwaukee, 2-1 at Miami and 1-1 vs. Atlanta...they have six more IL games remaining, one vs. the Braves, two at Milwaukee August 13-14 and three vs. Washington September 10-12...they have had just one winning season against the NL since 2010, that coming in 2017 (13-7).

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- ₱ Eddie Rosario is hitting .322 (55-for-171) with 13 doubles, 12 home runs and 28 RBI in his last 42 games vs. NL opponents.
- ₱ Jorge Polanco is hitting .314 (48-for-153) with an .853 OPS in 44 career games vs. NL teams

CHOP CHOP: The Twins and Braves are playing each other in the regular season for the 19th time in their history...Twins are 8-10 all-time against the Braves in the regular season...they have won three of their last four against Atlanta, dating back to 2016 after losing seven straight to the Braves from 2010-16.

BRINGER OF SANÓ: Miguel Sanó is hitting .296 (32-for-108) with six doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 26 RBI, 19 walks, 22 runs scored, a .402 OBP/.648 SLG/1.050 OPS in his last 33 games since June 28...prior to that date, he was hitting .195 (23-for-118) with a .278 OBP/.483 SLG/.761 OPS in 31 games to begin the season.

EXTRA STRENGTH: The Twins enter tonight having recorded at least one extra-base hit in 67 straight games, dating back to May 20, the seventh longest XBH-streak in club history...the club record is 98 straight from June 9-September 29, 2009...the Twins lead baseball in both extra-base hits (464) and slugging percentage (.501).

A SOUTHPAW STORY: The Twins are hitting .288 (308-for-1068) with 49 doubles, 66 home runs, 97 walks and an .877 OPS vs. lefties this season...they lead baseball in batting average vs. lefties and rank second in OPS (Houston - .887).

TWINS WIN, PÉREZ STRUGGLES: In his last start, Pérez labored through 5.0 innings against the Kansas City Royals, yielding a season-high tying three home runs for five total runs, but saw the Twins overcome his start by pushing 11 runs across the board to win 11-9...the Royals scored their initial tally in the first inning as a leadoff Whit Merrifield single came around on a two-out knock by Jorge Soler...Pérez retired the next seven batters he saw before Hunter Dozier hit the first of three Royals' home runs off the lefty to lead off the fourth, while another run scored on a balk... the fifth inning proved to be the end of Pérez's effort as Cam Gallagher began the inning with a solo shot while Dozier added his second with two outs, effectively ending the game for Pérez following a ground out by Soler.

That now allowed eight home runs in his last four starts after having allowed just seven total over his first 18 appearances (15 starts).

SWEET, SOFT CONTACT: Pérez has created a lot of weak contact in 2019, as referenced by the 85.2 MPH average exit velocity against him this season, tied for the third-lowest in baseball (with August a last venerate and venerate descriptions and Ryan Yarbrough (84.6), with a minimum of 250 batted balls...he also owns an average distance on balls in play of 151 feet, fourth-best in the American League, immediately behind Kyle Gibson (149 feet).

NATIONAL (LEAGUE) TREASURE: Pérez enters today's start with a 6-7 record against National League opponents in 24 games (21 starts), but his teams are 14-10 in those games...owns a 4.02 ERA (134.1 IP, 60 ER) with 83 strikeouts, but a total of 42 extra-base hits out of 136 total.
