**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 4-1 through five games on their 10-game roadtrip, starting with a three-game sweep of the White Sox, followed by a win and a loss in Detroit this weekend...today the Twins will continue the trip with the third of four at Detroit through Monday, followed by three vs. the Red Sox from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have 27 games remaining, 12 against teams above .500 and 15 against team below .500.

**BOMBAS FLY BUT TWINS FALL:** The Twins lost to the Tigers at Comerica Park last night by a score of 10-7...Martín Pérez (9-6) was the starter and loser, allowing eight runs (7 earned) on nine hits in 2.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded 10 hits, including six home runs... Mitch Garver hit two home runs, his 25th and 26th of the season.

⚡ Despite hitting 6 home runs, the Twins lost to the Tigers...they had never in franchise history lost a game in which they had hit even 5 home runs, going 49-0 in such games.  
⚡ That was the most wins before a loss when homering 5+ times in a game by any MLB team (credit Elias Sports).

**800 CLUB:** Twins have scored 802 runs this season, marking the eighth time in club history to reach the 800-run mark...the club record is 877, done in 1996...the current club is on pace to score 962...just six teams since 1961 have scored 962 runs, the most recent being the 2007 Yankees (968).

**TWINS AND TIGERS:** The Twins are playing the 15th of 19 games against the Tigers this season...each of the final five meetings between these two teams will be in Detroit...they have gone 9-5 vs. Detroit thus far, 6-3 at Target Field and 3-2 at Comerica Park...Twins have won 11 of their last 16 over the Tigers and 15 of their last 21...Twins are 6-0-1 in series play vs. Detroit in their last seven, home or away.  
⚡ Twins have out-scored the Tigers 92-67 this season.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Twins announced today that they have selected the contracts of right-handed pitcher Brusdar Graterol and outfielder Ian Miller from Triple-A Rochester...they have also recalled left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer and right-handed pitchers Zack Littell and Kohl Stewart...additionally, they will return both catcher Williams Astudillo and outfielder LaMonte Wade Jr. from their respective rehab assignments and reinstate both from the 10-day Injured List...in a separate transaction, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Kyle Gibson on the 10-day Injured List with Ulcerative Colitis...in 28 games (27 starts) for the Twins this season, Gibson has gone 13-6 with a 4.58 ERA (149.1 IP, 76 ER), 146 strikeouts and 45 walks...this marks Gibson's first trip to the Injured List since 2016...to replace Gibson on the roster, the Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Lewis Thorpe from Triple-A Rochester...Thorpe has appeared in six games (1 start) for the Twins this season, going 1-1 with a 4.40 ERA (14.1 IP, 7 ER), three walks and 14 strikeouts.

**TWINS ML WEEKLYS:** Twins have named Triple-A Rochester infielder Zander Wiel and Rookie-Elizabethton right-handed pitcher Cody Lawerlyon Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...in seven games for the Red Wings, Wiel hit .370 (10-for-27) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, three walks and a 1.271 OPS...Lawerlyon made the start on Monday vs. Greenville, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, no walks and 15 strikeouts.

**RIP, HAL NARAGON:** Former Twins catcher Hal Naragon passed away yesterday morning at the age of 90...Naragon played for the Washington Senators and Twins from 1959-1962.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was the starter and winner last Tuesday night at Guaranteed Rate Field after tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball with four hits, a home run and eight strikeouts... extended his win-streak to four games and has now been on earned the win in five of his last eight starts dating back to July 6 vs. Texas...pitched three perfect innings until a solo shot from Tim Anderson in the fourth inning put the White Sox on the board marking his only earned run of the game...exited after the fifth inning after giving up a single to Yolmer Sánchez, forcing Adam Engel into a pop-fly, and striking out Leury García and Tim Anderson.

**STAYING IN THE WWWWIN COLUMN:** Pineda is 6-2, with a 3.09 ERA (70.0 IP, 24 ER) over his last 12 starts dating back to June 13...he ranks eighth in the AL for ERA since June 13 (min. 70.0 innings pitched)...the Twins have went 9-3 over that stretch...he has allowed 59 hits, with 13 walks, 60 strikeouts and an opponents' slash line of .256/.287/.444.

- ☞ Pineda is 6-2 in his last eight decisions while going 4-1 on the road and 2-1 at Target Field over those eight.
- ☞ He has limited teams to three earned runs-or-less in 16 of his last 18 starts, dating back to May 5 at New York-AL...he owns a 3.60 ERA (105.0 IP, 42 ER) while striking out 99 batters over that stretch (Twins are 21-6), with 10 quality starts and a 1.09 WHIP.

**WALK TALK:** Pineda is tied for third fewest in all of baseball with 25 free passes this season with at least 20 starts (excludes openers)...his walks-per-nine innings rate is 1.68, which ranks seventh best in the majors among starters with at least 130.0 IP...has eight starts without walking a batter this season and 10 with walking just one.

- ☞ Michael also averages one walk per 0.45 batters he faces, which is the sixth lowest in baseball among pitchers with at least 125.0 IP while his 4.71 strikeout-to-walk rate sits 15th in the majors.
- ☞ Pineda has a combined 18 starts this season with walking one or fewer batters...over those 18 he owns a 9-4 record.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Pineda is making his fifth start away from Target Field since July 26...has had success on the road this season, as he owns a 7-2 record with a 4.14 ERA (67.1 IP, 31 ER) with 13 walks and 64 strikeouts away from his home turf...his road numbers have fared well in 2019, but as for his career, he owns a 24-26 record away from his home ballpark with a 4.36 ERA (394.2 IP, 191 ER).

- ☞ Pineda now has seven wins over 12 road games this season, which matches a career-high and is the most since his 2015 season where he went 7-5 over 12 games away from home (all starts).

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** Pineda will be making his eighth career start against Detroit and his fourth of the season (second at Comerica Park)...is 2-2, 4.28 ERA (40.0 IP, 19 ER) with six walks and 42 strikeouts in his career...is 1-0, 4.76 ERA (17.0 IP, 9 ER) over three starts this season...his last win in Detroit came June, 2 2016 as a member of the Mariners, allowed one run on seven hits with zero walks and eight strikeouts over 5.2 innings...is a career 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA when facing the Tigers in Detroit.

- ☞ Last time out vs. the Tigers was June 7 of this season...took a no-decision after allowing three runs (all earned) on eight hits and zero walks with three strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work.

## CAREER NOTES

- Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from "Tommy John" surgery on right elbow.
- Appeared in four minor league games in 2018, allowing two runs over 12.0 innings pitched.
- Was shut down due to right knee discomfort suffered while throwing a bullpen in late August.
- Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
- Was an AL All-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 3.03 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of .198 in the first half, and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting.
- In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007).
- Was signed by Seattle as a 16-year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005.
- He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic, where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops.
