BACK AT IT IN BOSTON: Following his seven run, 2.2 inning performance, which was tied for his shortest start of the season, on August 31 in Detroit, Pérez moved right back to the win column after tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball with just two hits, two walks and a strikeout in Beantown on September 5...marked his 11th quality start of the season and his fifth start in his last eight lasting 6.0 innings.

⚡ Pitched a perfect three innings before Mookie Betts connected on a solo shot in the fourth inning for his only run of the game...tossed another perfect inning in the fifth and gave up one hit in the sixth, a double to Betts, before his exit.

⚡ Marked his second start this season allowing just two hits or fewer with the other coming on May 6 at Toronto...now has seven career starts in which he gave up two or less hits.

TROUBLE WITH MEN ON: Martín has seen a lot of success in 2019 when working out of the wind-up, as he boasts an opponents' batting average of .233 (79-for-339) with an OPS of .690 when the bases are clear...however, once he allows someone to reach base, Pérez struggles to a .317 average (76-for-240) with an .860 OPS when pitching out of the stretch...with runners in scoring position, the lefty hasn't found much success either, as opponents are hitting .290 (40-for-138) with 11 XBH and 56 RBI with RISP, including .300 (21-for-70) with 27 RBI with RISP and two outs.

THE OTHER SIDE OF THE BATTERY: Over his 27 games, Pérez has thrown to each of the three catchers this season: Astudillo (4 games), Castro (9 games) and Garver (15 games)...below is a breakdown of how the left-hander has fared, depending on who's calling his pitches, courtesy of Baseball Reference:

SWEET, SOFT CONTACT: Pérez has created a lot of weak contact in 2019, as referenced by the 84.9 MPH average exit velocity against him this season, the second lowest in baseball behind Tampa Bay's Ryan Yarbrough (83.9 MPH), with a minimum of 300 batted balls...he also owns an average distance on balls in play of 150 feet, tied for third-best in the American League.

⚡ Pérez also ranks in the 94th percentile in opponents' hard hit percentage (T-4th in baseball, 29.0%, min. 300 batted balls).

NATIONAL TREASURE: Pérez is making his second career start against the Washington Nationals, first since June 10, 2017 at Nationals Park...in that outing, he did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.0 innings of two run-ball with seven hits, a walk and five strikeouts.

⚡ Lifetime, is 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA against Washington, with a BAA of .350 (7-for-20).

NATIONAL LEAGUE NUMBERS: Pérez enters tonight's start with a 6-8 record against National League opponents in 26 games (23 starts), but his teams are 15-11 in those games...owns a 4.12 ERA (146.1 IP, 67 ER) with 92 strikeouts, but a total of 48 extra-base hits out of 154 total.

⚡ Is making his fourth start against a National League opponent this season, but his sixth appearance, as he pitched twice out of the bullpen on the Twins' initial roadtrip of the season in Philadelphia and New York, while starting against the Mets, and one start apiece against the Braves and the Brewers...has posted a 0-1 record with a 4.76 ERA (22.2 IP, 12 ER) with 13 walks and 19 strikeouts against NL teams in 2019.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - KYLE GIBSON RHP (SEASON- 13-6, 4.58 ERA ; CAREER- 67-67, 4.48 ERA)

Gibson was reinstated from the 10-day injured list yesterday after missing the last nine games with Ulcerative Colitis...he is making his 28th start of the season tomorrow night and just his second career against the Nationals, with his last start against them coming on April 22, 2016...in his last start on August 30 at Detroit, he earned the win after tossing 5.0 innings with four runs on 10 hits with five strikeouts...he is looking for his first win against a National League opponent this season, first since September 12, 2017 vs. San Diego...is 0-0, 5.59 ERA (9.2 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and nine strikeouts over two starts against NL opponents this season (at NYM and at MIL).

- Battled through injury in 2018 after breaking his non-throwing arm in the offseason after being charged by his pet bull.
• According to Inside Edge, opponents had a groundball rate of 67.3 percent (37/55) against Pérez's changeup in 2018, the highest in Major League Baseball with at least 80.0 IP.
• Led the Rangers in wins (13-career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
• His career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25-or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
• Went 10-6 with a 3.62 ERA (50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11).
