THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game, seven-day homestand, losing a three-game series to the Indians last weekend, followed by a win and a loss to the Nationals the last two nights...tonight the Twins will play the third of three with Washington...post-game the Twins will travel to Cleveland for three at Progressive Field over the weekend...the Twins have 17 games remaining, four against teams above .500 and 13 against teams below .500...Twins have gone 6-10 in rubber games this season.

NATS EVEN UP SERIES: The Twins lost to the Nationals last night by a score of 6-2, evening the series at one game apiece...Martín Pérez (10-7) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Luis Arraez... Jorge Polanco hit his 21st home run...Twins went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position and left nine men on base.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Twins have gone 8-11 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Philadelphia, 1-3 vs. New York, 2-2 vs. Milwaukee, 2-1 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Atlanta and 1-1 vs. Washington...they have had just one winning season against the NL since 2010, that coming in 2017 (13-7).

☞ The Twins are 9-8 all-time against the Montreal/Washington franchise...excluding Montreal, the Twins are 6-8 against Washington.

☞ From 1997 (IL Play's inception) to 2009, the Twins went 132-96 in IL Play, second to only the Yankees (133-95) in wins during that span...since then they have gone 87-106, 24th most IL wins in baseball in that span.

☞ Mitch Garver is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with a 1.277 OPS in 12 IL games this season... Garver's nine IL home runs this season are tied with Nolan Arenado for most in baseball...he is now tied with Trevor Plouffe (2012) for most single-season IL home runs in club history.

☞ Jorge Polanco is a career .305 hitter (53-for-174) with a .842 OPS in 49 IL games.

SAUCE ON THE SIDE: Mitch Garver has hit 30 home runs this season, 29 at catcher (1 at DH), the most at the position in all of baseball, ahead of Gary Sánchez (27)...Garver's .681 slugging percentage as a catcher is the second best single season SLG by a catcher since data is available back to 1974 (min. 250 PA as catcher).

ALL A-RRAEZ: Luis Arraez is hitting .342 (93-for-268) in 78 games this season...Tony Oliva holds the Twins/Senators franchise record for batting average among rookies, hitting .323 in 1964... below are franchise rookie hitting records (since 1901), minimum of 300 plate appearances:

ROCCO ON THE 90'S: One more win and Rocco Baldelli will become the sixth manager in Twins/Senators franchise history to reach 90 victories in his first full managerial season... Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in his first season in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970, Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933 and Bucky Harris went 92-64 in 1924...last managers to reach 90 wins in their rookie seasons were Boston's Alex Cora (108-54) and New York's Aaron Boone (100-62) both in 2018.

A SOUTHPAW STORY: The Twins are hitting .284 (392-for-1379) with 61 doubles, 86 home runs, 129 walks and an .871 OPS vs. lefties this season...they rank second in baseball in both batting average vs. lefties and OPS.

☞ Mitch Garver is hitting .323 (30-for-93) and C.J. Cron is hitting .325 (39-for-120) vs. lefties...Max Kepler is hitting .295 (43-for-146), with an .885 OPS...Kepler's average vs. lefties ranks third best in the AL for left-handed batters, trailing Kevin Kiermaier (.318) and Michael Brantley (.297).

PITCHING FIGURES: Where Twins pitching ranks in a few key categories on the season (all MLB): third in overall pitching WAR (21.1), eighth in ERA (4.15), sixth in K/BB (3.18), fourth in fewest homers allowed (178), ninth in WHIP (1.30) and third in first-pitch strike percentage (62.8%)...since the trade deadline (August 1): second in team pitching WAR, second in bullpen WAR, third in bullpen ERA, and fourth in win probability.

ROBERTO CLEMENTE AWARD: MLB today announced the 30 Club nominees for the 2019 Roberto Clemente Award, the most prestigious individual award for major league players...the Roberto Clemente Award is the annual recognition of a major league player who best represents the game of Baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field...the nominees will be officially recognized on Wednesday, September 18, marking the 18th annual Roberto Clemente Day, which was established by Major League Baseball to honor the late Hall of Famer's legacy as a humanitarian...Kyle Gibson is the 2019 Twins nominee, the first of his career...last season's club nominee was Joe Mauer.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY J-ROW! Twins Hitting Coach James Rowson is celebrating his 43rd birthday today...he shares a birthday with Freddie Freeman, former basketball player Yao Ming, drummer Neil Pert, rapper 2 Chainz, former Colts quarterback Andrew Luck, and Dan Gladden's favorite rapper Bizzy Bone.

WELCOME BACK, GIB: Gibson is back on the bump tonight for the first time since August 30 in Detroit, missing nine games with ulcerative colitis...earned his second consecutive win against the Detroit Tigers the last time out, despite allowing 10 hits (2nd straight game) and four runs with five strikeouts...yielded a five-hit first inning (2 runs), while allowing runs in the second (back-to-back doubles) and fourth innings (John Hicks solo home run)...

2019 ROBERTO CLEMENTE AWARD NOMINEE, KYLE GIBSON: Kyle was named a Roberto Clemente Award nominee earlier today by Major League Baseball, his first career nomination...Joe Mauer (4 times) was the 2018 nominee for the Twins...Yadier Molina (STL) was last year's winner.

THE SHERIDAN STORY: Gibson, along with catcher Jason Castro, is proud to support The Sheridan Story, an organization dedicated to fighting child hunger in Minnesota...the innovative organization serves more than 6,500 kids in over 200 schools - with the aid of strong community partnerships... Kyle will donate \$100 for every Twins win while Jason will contribute \$250 per victory...coming into tonight's start, Gibson is set to donate \$8,900.

THE OTHER SIDE OF THE BATTERY: Over his 28 games, Gibson has thrown to each of the three catchers this season: Astudillo (3 games), Castro (10 games) and Garver (15 games)...below is a breakdown of how he has fared, depending on who's calling his pitches:

GROUND POUND: Since 2014, nobody has induced more ground ball double plays than Gibson, who has 135 over 1025.1 IP in that span...so far this season, Gibby has continued the trend, recording 16 GDPs, tied for seventh-best in the American League, and the best on the Twins.

- Twins 'pen is 28-19-44 with a 4.17 ERA (502.1 IP, 233 ER), 84 holds, 164 walks & 524 strikeouts this season (145 games)...allowing a .257 opp. batting average (503-for-1955).
- For the season, Twins 'pen ranks 5th in the AL...6th in the majors in save percentage (69.8%, 44-for-63)...pen has 9.39 K/9, 5th best in AL and their 2.94 BB/9 is the best in the AL and in all of baseball.
- Relievers have fashioned a 2.62 ERA (92.2 IP, 27 ER) in the last 24 games (beginning 8/16), best ERA in baseball in that span.
- Twins bullpen is now 4-4-15 with a 6.68 ERA (64.2 IP, 48 ER) with 15 holds and 68 strikeouts over 19 games vs. NL opponents this season...2-2-4 with a 6.59 ERA in nine games at home vs. NL teams.
