TWINS LOSE SERIES TO NATS: The Twins lost to the Nationals last night at Target Field by a score of 12-6...Kyle Gibson (13-7) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs (5 earned) on eight hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the bullpen allowed six runs in the final four innings...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Jonathan Schoop - tying his season-high...Schoop (22) and Nelson Cruz (36) each homered as Cruz's homer was the fourth to ever be hit into CATCH in centerfield.

▼ The Twins completed Interleague Play having homered in every game this season, joining Toronto (2000) as the only teams to homer in every IL game in a season...they extended their IL home run streak to an MLB record 23 straight.

ALL A-RRAEZ: Luis Arraez has hit safely in 10 straight, his third double-digit hit-streak (his long is 12) this season...it is tied with David Dahl and Tommy Pham for second longest active streak in baseball, trailing just Austin Meadows (11)...during the streak, Arraez is hitting .436 (17-for-39) with a .488 OBP and a 1.078 OPS...additionally, Arraez is one of six AL players with three different double-digit hitting streaks this season, the others being DJ LeMahieu, J.D. CAREER YEAR CONTINUES: Odorizzi has set a career high with 14 wins (14-6 in 28 starts), surpassing his 11 victories for Tampa Bay in 2014 (11-13 in 31 starts)...the first-time All-Star is tied for sixth in the American League in wins and tied for eighth in winning percentage (.700), while also ranking seventh in ERA (3.60; 147.1 IP, 59 ER) and opponents' OPS (.680), eighth in FIP (3.57), ninth in opponents' batting average (.236, 130-for-552), 10th in strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (career-best 9.90, 162 SO in 147.1 IP) and 13th in WHIP (1.23).

© The Twins' .714 winning percentage (20-8) with Odorizzi on the mound is tops among the club's starting rotation.

HIGH QUALITY, IF NOT HIGH QUANTITY: Odorizzi averages about 5.1 innings per start and owns just nine efforts of 6.0-plus innings, including only two in his last 14 trips to the hill...he throws the most pitches-per-batter in the majors at 4.23 and most pitches-per-inning in the AL at 17.6 (3rd in MLB).

The Twins are 8-1 when Jake pitches at least 6.0 innings, while he is personally 7-0 with a 1.45 ERA (56.0 IP, 9 ER) and .169 opponents' batting average (33-for-195).

A RETURN TO FORM: Jake's last eight starts have produced seven Twins wins, while he is 3-1 with a 3.05 ERA (44.1 IP, 15 ER), 15 walks and 54 strikeouts...he is trying to craft a stretch drive to mirror how his season began, as in his first 14 starts (through June 15), Odorizzi led the AL with a 2.24 ERA (76.1 IP, 19 ER) and 10 wins...over his next six (June 20 - July 24), he posted an 8.44 ERA (26.2 IP, 25 ER) and won just once...a closer look at the three stretches:

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD: Pitching during the year of the home run, Odorizzi has yielded an average of 0.98 per 9.0 innings (16 HR in 147.1 IP), his lowest rate since 2015 (0.96) and fourth-best in the AL...has allowed just one homer in his last six starts (128 at-bats and 142 batters faced).

The has surrendered only 16 home runs despite having the third-lowest ground ball rate in the game at 35.8 percent.

ROAD RULES: The Twins have won all five of Odorizzi's road starts since the All-Star break (July 13 at CLE, July 30 at MIA, August 16 at TEX, August 28 at CWS and September 2 at DET), while he is 3-0 with a 3.25 ERA (27.2 IP, 10 ER) and a .220 opponents' batting average (22-for-100).
