TWINS LOSE SERIES TO NATS: The Twins lost to the Nationals Thursday night at Target Field by a score of 12-6...Kyle Gibson (13-7) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs (5 earned) on eight hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the bullpen allowed six runs in the final four innings...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Jonathan Schoop - tying his season-high...Schoop (22) and Nelson Cruz (36) each homered as Cruz's homer was the fourth to ever be hit into CATCH in centerfield.

◆ The Twins completed Interleague Play having homered in every game this season, joining Toronto (2000) as the only teams to homer in every IL game in a season...they extended their IL home run streak to an MLB record 23 straight.
