THE TWINS: The Twins completed their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 vs. the Indians and 1-2 vs. the Nationals...today and tomorrow the Twins will play their final series with Cleveland, a three-game set at Progressive Field...the Twins have 16 games remaining, three against teams above .500 and 13 against teams below .500.

TWINS LOSE SERIES TO NATS: The Twins lost to the Nationals Thursday night at Target Field by a score of 12-6...Kyle Gibson (13-7) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs (5 earned) on eight hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the bullpen allowed six runs in the final four innings...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Jonathan Schoop - tying his season-high...Schoop (22) and Nelson Cruz (36) each homered as Cruz's homer was the fourth to ever be hit into CATCH in centerfield.
☞ The Twins completed Interleague Play having homered in every game this season, joining Toronto (2000) as the only teams to homer in every IL game in a season...they extended their IL home run streak to an MLB record 23 straight.

TWINS-TRIBE: The Twins are 7-9 vs. the Indians this season, going 4-6 at Target Field and 3-3 at Progressive Field...more team comparisons in box to lower right.

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .305 (93-for-305) with 15 doubles, four triples, 17 home runs, 38 RBI, 48 runs scored and a .885 OPS in 80 career games vs. Cleveland; the homers and hits all being his personal most vs. any opponent...his 93 hits and 17 homers vs. Cleveland since 2015 lead baseball.

☞ Max Kepler has 14 career home runs against Cleveland, his most in any ballpark...11 have come at Progressive Field, his most in any opposing ballpark...since 2016, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark.

☞ Nelson Cruz has 23 career home runs vs. the Indians (second-most among actives, Cabrera - 46), including 12 in his last 24 games (21 RBI).

ROAD RAGE: Twins have won 12 of their last 14 on the road, out-scoring opponents 98-60 in that span...they lead baseball in road wins, going 48-24 away from Target Field...below are the Twins all-time best road seasons (since 1961):

ALL A-RRAEZ: Luis Arraez has hit safely in 10 straight, his third double-digit hit-streak (his long is 12) this season...it is tied with David Dahl for third longest active streak in baseball, trailing Tommy Pham (11) and Austin Meadows (12)...during the streak, Arraez is hitting .436 (17-for-39) with a .488 OBP and a 1.078 OPS...additionally, Arraez is one of six AL players with three different double-digit hitting streaks this season, the others being DJ LeMahieu, J.D. Martinez, Rafael Devers, Tim Anderson and Whit Merrifield, all with three.

CRUZ MISSILES: Nelson Cruz has 36 home runs, tied with Max Kepler and Gleyber Torres for third-most in the AL...20 of those home runs have been hit since the All-Star break, second-most in the AL, trailing Jorge Soler (21)...below is where Cruz ranks on MLB's all-time home run list:

NOTE: Cruz has 19 balls hit at least 420 feet, tied with Jorge Soler for the second most in baseball, trailing just Mike Trout (21)...Cruz has hit five balls with an exit velocity of 115 mph-plus, the third most in baseball, trailing Vlad Guerrero Jr. (8) and Aaron Judge (7).

ROCCO ON THE 90'S: One more win and Rocco Baldelli will become the sixth manager in Twins/Senators franchise history to reach 90 victories in his first full managerial season...Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in his first season in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970, Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933 and Bucky Harris went 92-64 in 1924...last managers to reach 90 wins in their rookie seasons were Boston's Alex Cora (108-54) and New York's Aaron Boone (100-62) both in 2018.

☞ Where Twins pitching ranks in a few key categories on the season (all MLB): third in overall pitching WAR (20.7), eighth in ERA (4.20), sixth in K/BB (3.15), fifth in fewest homers allowed (182), ninth in WHIP (1.30) and third in first-pitch strike percentage (62.8%).
☞ Mitch Garver is hitting .301 (41-for-136) with a 1.033 OPS in 39 road games.
