THE TWINS: After completing their their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4 (1-2 vs. the Indians and 1-2 vs. the Nationals), the Twins began their penultimate roadtrip of 2019 with a doubleheader sweep in Cleveland...today the Twins will play their final game of the season with Cleveland...following today's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with three vs. Chicago from Monday-Wednesday and four vs. Kansas City from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have 14 games remaining, seven on the road and seven at home.

DOUBLE W'S ON A SATURDAY: The Twins beat the Indians twice yesterday, the first game by a score of 2-0, the second game by a score of 9-5...in the first game, five pitchers combined for the shutout, led by Devin Smeltzer's 3.0 innings, followed by Taylor Rogers' 1.2 innings to earn his 26th save...the second game was highlighted by a Miguel Sanó grand slam, the first of his career...Jorge Polanco finished the day 4-for-9 with a double, a home run and three RBI.

ROCCO ON THE 90'S: Yesterday afternoon Rocco Baldelli became the sixth manager in Twins/Senators franchise history to reach 90 victories in his first full managerial season...Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in his first season in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970, Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933 and Bucky Harris went 92-64 in 1924.

TWINS-TRIBE: The Twins are 9-9 vs. the Indians this season, going 4-6 at Target Field and 5-3 at Progressive Field...more team comparisons in box to lower right.

⚡ Eddie Rosario is hitting .301 (94-for-312) with 15 doubles, four triples, 18 home runs, 40 RBI, 50 runs scored and a .883 OPS in 82 career games vs. Cleveland; the homers and hits all being his personal most vs. any opponent...his 94 hits and 18 homers vs. Cleveland since 2015 lead baseball.

⚡ Max Kepler has 14 career home runs against Cleveland, his most vs. any opponent...11 have come at Progressive Field, his most in any opposing ballpark...since 2016, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark.

⚡ Nelson Cruz has 24 career home runs vs. the Indians (second-most among actives, Cabrera - 46), including 13 in his last 26 games (23 RBI).

SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins are seeking their 11th sweep of an opponent this season...their previous 10 sweeps came: three games August 27-29 at Chicago-AL, four games August 15-18 at Texas, three games August 2-4 vs. KC, three games May 24-26 vs. CWS, three games May 20-22 at LAA, three games May 6-8 at TOR, three games April 26-28 vs. BAL, three games at BAL April 20-21, two games April 13-14 vs. DET, two games April 2-3 at KC...Twins recorded seven sweeps all of last season.

CAUTION, HIGH WATER: The Twins are currently at their high-water mark of 34 games over .500 for the fifth time this season...prior to 2019, last time the Twins were 34 games over was when they ended the 1970 season at a record of 98-64...last time they were 35 over was at the end of the 1965 season when they were 42 over with a record of 102-60.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2002, the Twins clinched the AL Central Division title with a 5-0 win at "Jacobs" Field, marking the Twins first playoff appearance since 1991...they also won the division in the next two seasons...in 2017, the Twins celebrated Big Sexy Night as Bartolo "Big Sexy" Colon made the start...Big Sexy allowed four runs on five hits in 6.0 innings as the Twins lost to the Blue Jays by a score of 4-3.

SO FAR, SO GOOD: Through six big league appearances, Dobnak has thrown 12.0 innings, allowing just three earned runs...Dobnak has had a lot of traffic on the basepaths, however, as he has already allowed 17 hits (14 singles, 2 doubles, 1 home run) with 10 strikeouts...pitched twice in the last home stand, tossing 3.0 IP, allowing three runs on four hits vs. Cleveland (9/8) and Washington (9/11).

FIRST BIG LEAGUE APPEARANCE: In his first big league appearance, Dobnak relieved Devin Smeltzer with 4.0 shutout innings on August 9, striking out three without issuing a walk against this Cleveland Indians lineup.

- ⊕ Yielded his first hit to perennial All-Star Francisco Lindor, the second batter he faced, while notching his first strikeout in the seventh inning, setting down Roberto Pérez swinging.
- ⊕ Allowed a baserunner to reach in each of his innings of work, but stranded all seven of them (6 singles and 1 fielder's choice), limiting the Indians to a 1-for-11 clip with runners on (.091 AVG).
- ⊕ **Became just the sixth reliever in Twins history, first since Francisco Oliveras on May 3, 1989 vs. Milwaukee, to throw 4.0-or-more shutout innings in his ML debut.**
- ⊕ Faced them again last Sunday at Target Field, receiving his first career loss after yielding two runs on three hits over 2.0 innings as the opener for Smeltzer again.

AS A STARTER IN THE MINORS: Dobnak is no stranger to starting, as he started 45 of his 54 career games in the Minor Leagues, amassing a 2.53 ERA (228.0 IP, 64 ER) with 167 strikeouts to just 47 walks as a Minor League starter, as opposed to a 2.73 ERA (69.1 IP, 21 ER) in his 11 relief appearances.

- ⊕ His last start with Triple-A Rochester came on August 23 at Syracuse (New York-NL), throwing 5.0 innings of two-run ball, scattering four hits with four strikeouts and two walks.
- ⊕ He left the Minors with an active streak of 11 starts throwing at least 5.0 innings, dating back to May 29 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (3.2 IP).

AMATEUR HOUR: Prior to joining the Twins organization, Dobnak spent six weeks playing amateur ball for the Utica Unicorns of the United Shore Professional Baseball League.

- ⊕ In six games with the Unicorns, finished with a 3-0 record in 35.0 innings pitched while allowing just 22 hits, six walks, and had 29 strikeouts, and a 2.31 ERA and WHIP of just 0.80.
- ⊕ In 2016, as a junior at Division II Alderson Broaddus University in West Virginia, he finished with a 7-3 overall record with five complete games, leading the G-MAC in strikeouts with 89 and ranked 43rd in NCAA Division II in strikeouts...opponents hit just .246 against him and allowed only three home runs.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Randy won Pitcher of the Week for the week ending July 28 after making two starts, going 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA (12.1 IP, 2 ER) with seven hits, a hit batsman, three walks and 10 strikeouts...he was the only IL pitcher with two wins, tied for the league lead with 12.1 innings, and ranked fourth in the league with a 0.81 WHIP, and seventh with a .159 batting average against during the period.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSÉ BERRÍOS (SEASON: 12-8, 3.63 ERA // CAREER: 41-34, 4.21 ERA)

Berrios will have his start pushed back a day as he takes the ball tomorrow night in the series opener against the Chicago White Sox...earned his 12th win of the year in his last start on September 10 vs. Washington, firing 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and a walk with four strikeouts...is 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 9 ER) against Chicago-AL this year, and 10-2 with a 2.40 ERA over 13 career starts against them...owns a 6.64 ERA over his last seven starts, allowing 29 ER over 39.1 IP with eight home runs and 16 walks with a .302 BAA (49-for-162).
