**THE TWINS:** The Twins completed their short three-game roadtrip in Cleveland winning two games on Saturday, followed by a loss yesterday afternoon...tonight, the Twins will begin their final homestand of 2019 with the first of three against the White Sox through Wednesday, followed by four vs. the Royals from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have 13 games remaining, six on the road and seven at home.

**TWINS CAN'T COMPLETE SWEEP OF TRIBE:** The Twins lost to the Indians yesterday afternoon at Progressive Field by a score of 7-5...Randy Dobnak was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (1 earned) on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 13 hits, three from Eddie Rosario, who hit his 30th and 31st home runs of the season...Miguel Sanó added a home run, his 29th on the season.

**TWINS AND SOX:** The Twins and White Sox are playing each other for the 17th of 19 times this season...they have won the season-series three consecutive seasons and six times in their last seven years...the Twins are 11-5 against Chicago this season, going 4-2 at Target Field and 7-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field...the Twins are 15-5 in the last 20 vs. the Sox...Twins have gone 35-19 vs. Chicago since the start of 2017, their most wins vs. any opponent since.

- ☞ Miguel Sanó is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with six home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.142 OPS in 14 games vs. the White Sox this season...has reached safely in 12 of the 14.
- ☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .471 (24-for-51) with five doubles, eight home runs, 23 RBI and a 1.566 OPS in 13 games against the Sox this season...has eight multi-hit games and seven multi-RBI games...Cruz's OPS is the third best vs. the Sox in a single season, trailing just Babe Ruth's 1.616 OPS in 1920 and Lou Gehrig's 1.603 OPS in 1934.
- ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with four doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.352 OPS in 11 games against Chicago this season...six multi-hit games.
- ☞ Since 1970, eight different players have hit eight-plus homers vs. the Sox in one season: Albert Belle (9 in 1995), Juan González (9 in 2001), Brian Dozier (8 in 2016), Justin Morneau (8 in 2007), Eddie Murray (8 in 1987), Jim Thome (8 in 1997) and Max Kepler/Cruz now.

**CRUZ MISSILES:** Nelson Cruz has 37 home runs, tied with Gleyber Torres for third-most in the AL...21 of those home runs have been hit since the All-Star break, tied for first in the AL with Jorge Soler...below is where Cruz ranks on MLB's all-time home run list:

**THE 'PEN:** The Twins bullpen has gone 14-10-19 since the All-Star Break, and has pitched to a 4.01 ERA (222.0 IP, 99 ER), the fourth-lowest ERA in the American League in the second half...against the AL Central this season, the 'pen has thrown to a 3.61 ERA (561.0 IP, 225 ER), five points lower than the Twins interdivisional record of 3.66 (684.0 IP, 278 ER) set back in 2005.

**4 FOR 30:** The Twins have four players with 30-plus homers, Nelson Cruz (37), Max Kepler (36), Eddie Rosario (31) and Mitch Garver (30)...it ties a major league record, done 12 times, most recently by the 2009 Phillies (Howard - 45, Werth - 36, Ibañez - 34 and Utley - 31) and 2006 White Sox (Dye - 44, Thome - 42, Konerko - 35 and Crede 30)...Miguel Sanó needs one home run to set a new major league record.

**ROSTER MOVE:** Earlier today, the Minnesota Twins announced that right-handed pitcher Marcos Diplan was claimed off waivers by the Detroit Tigers...Diplan was designated for release or assignment on Saturday to make room for the addition of right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcalá...Diplan pitched in eight games with Double-A Pensacola, making two starts, posting a 4.09 ERA (11.0 IP, 5 ER) with 10 strikeouts, seven walks and an opponents' batting average of .250...he was acquired by the Twins on July 31 from the Milwaukee Brewers for cash considerations.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1970, Bert Blyleven, a 19-year-old rookie, ties an American League record by striking out the first six batters and strikes out 10 in 6.2 innings...in 1991, Kevin Tapani (15-8) becomes the Twins third 15-game winner (Morris & Erickson), pitching a three-hitter for 7.2 innings against the Royals...in 1993, Dave Winfield becomes the 19th player to collect 3,000 hits as he singles to left off Dennis Eckersley in the Metrodome...in 1996, Paul Molitor records his 3,000th hit, tripling at Kauffman Stadium.

### THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ Zack Littell owns a 0.73 ERA (24.2 IP, 2 ER) over his last 22 games, dating back to June 18...since that date, his ERA is the lowest in baseball (min. 20.0 IP).
- ☞ The Twins have a team .495 slugging percentage, the best in team history, surpassing the .437 SLG set by the 2002 Twins...it also currently sits as the highest slugging percentage in baseball history.
- ☞ Twins are 40-23 against the AL Central, tied for the 11th best interdivisional record in club history.

BERRÍOS BOUNCES BACK VS. NATIONALS: Following a tough start to September (5.0 IP, 6 ER in Boston), the two-time All-Star recovered with a 7.0-inning, two-hit shutout performance against the Washington Nationals last Tuesday night at Target Field.

- Berrios held the Nats hitless through 4.1 innings before Howie Kendrick reached base with a single to right field...Berrios made his first error of the season on a pickoff attempt of Kendrick (he has made exactly one error in each of his first four big league seasons)...allowed a leadoff single to Trea Turner in the sixth, but set down five of his last six batters, including a double play off the bat of Juan Soto in the seventh inning...Sergio Romo and Trevor May retired the final six batters of the game, completing the Twins' ninth shutout of the year.
• Marked the fourth time this season that he has thrown at least 5.0 innings without allowing an extra-base hit, the 14th time in his career.
• Berrios is tied for fourth in the American League (T-11th in MLB) with 19 quality starts, while 20 out of his 29 starts have gone at least 6.0 innings (including nine 7.0+ inning efforts)...not only that, but in 100 career starts, Berrios has thrown 49 quality starts (49.0 percent).

THIS IS 30: Berrios will be making his 30th start of 2019 tonight, his second consecutive season with 30-plus starts (32 last year).

• Playing in his age 25 season, he is just the 10th Twins pitcher to log multiple 30-start campaigns prior to his 26th birthday...the list of Twins to do so is below:

EL REY DE CHICAGO: Berrios owns a lifetime line of 10-2, 2.40 ERA (86.1 IP, 23 ER) with 19 walks and 92 strikeouts over 13 games (all starts) vs. the White Sox; his 2.40 ERA is the eighth-lowest ERA all-time vs. the Pale Hose by a Twin (min. 10 starts)...in six starts at Target Field, Berrios owns a 1.21 ERA (44.2 IP, 6 ER), with his last win here coming on May 24 when he threw 6.2 innings, allowing four runs (1 earned) on nine hits in an 11-4 Twins win...the 1.21 ERA is his lowest vs. any opponent he's made at least three starts against at home.

• Teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 Ks on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893 - when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall of Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.

Pérez starts tomorrow night opposite Lucas Giolito...Pérez is making his 27th start of the season, and he is coming off a tough outing against the Washington Nationals last Wednesday night, as he threw 5.0 innings, allowing five runs on six hits in a 6-2 Twins loss...has only faced these White Sox once this season, back on July 27 at Guaranteed Rate Field, when he was handed the loss despite a quality start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER, 4 SO), as the Twins only gave him one run of support in a 5-1 defeat...is 5-4 at Target Field this season with a 4.96 ERA (85.1 IP, 47 ER), including 1-2 with an 8.31 ERA (26.0 IP, 24 ER) over his last five starts here.

- Twins 'pen is 30-20-45 with a 4.18 ERA (521.0 IP, 242 ER), 87 holds, 168 walks & 544 strikeouts this season (149 games)...allowing a .255 opp. batting average (521-for-2028).
Twins bullpen is 11-5-2 with a 1.07 ERA (42.0 IP, 5 ER) with 7 holds and 48 strikeouts over 16 games vs. CWS this season...4-2 with a 0.55 ERA in six games at Target Field vs. CWS in '19.
Relievers have fashioned a 2.91 ERA (111.1 IP, 36 ER) in the last 28 games (beginning 8/16), best ERA in baseball in that span.
For the season, Twins 'pen ranks 5th in the AL & 6th in the majors in save percentage (69.2%, 45-for-65)...pen has 9.40 K/9.0, 5th best in AL and their 2.90 BB/9 is first in the AL and in all of baseball.
