**THE TWINS:** After completing their last roadtrip with a record of 2-1 in Cleveland, the Twins began their final homestand of 2019 with a win over the White Sox last night...tonight the Twins will continue the homestand with the second of three with Chicago...after the series finale tomorrow night, the Twins will host the Royals for four over the weekend...the Twins have 12 games remaining, six on the road and six at home.

**TWINS CONTINUE TO WEAR OUT SOX:** The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 5-3. José Berríos (13-8) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on five hits in 7.1 innings pitched. Tyler Duffey (13) and Sergio Romo (14) each earned a hold and Taylor Rogers earned his 27th save...the offense recorded 10 hits, three from Luis Arraez and two from Mitch Garver...the Twins went 4-for-10 with runners in scoring position...Twins have won four straight over Chicago.

**IF YOU SMELL WHAT THE ROC IS COOKING:** Rocco Baldelli now has 92 managerial wins in his first season as a major league manager...only two other active managers won 92-or-more of their first 150 games as a manager in the major leagues: Alex Cora (103-47) and Aaron Boone (92-58). (Credit Elias).

Baldelli is the sixth manager in Twins/Senators franchise history to reach 92 victories in his first full managerial season...Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in his first season in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970, Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933 and Bucky Harris went 92-64 in 1924.

**TWINS AND SOX:** The Twins and White Sox are playing each other for the 18th of 19 times this season...the Twins are 12-5 against Chicago this season, going 5-2 at Target Field and 7-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field...the Twins are 16-5 in the last 21 vs. the Sox...Twins have gone 36-19 vs. Chicago since the start of 2017, their most wins vs. any opponent since.

Miguel Sanó is hitting .346 (18-for-52) with six home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.125 OPS in 15 games vs. the White Sox this season...has reached safely in 13 of the 15.

Nelson Cruz is hitting .455 (25-for-55) with five doubles, eight home runs, 24 RBI and a 1.490 OPS in 14 games against the Sox this season...has eight multi-hit games and seven multi-RBI games.

Max Kepler is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with four doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.352 OPS in 11 games against Chicago this season...six multi-hit games.

Since 1970, eight different players have hit eight-plus homers vs. the Sox in one season: Albert Belle (9 in 1995), Juan González (9 in 2001), Brian Dozier (8 in 2016), Justin Morneau (8 in 2007), Eddie Murray (8 in 1987), Jim Thome (8 in 1997) and Max Kepler/Cruz now.

Since 1920, Kepler and Cruz are the franchise's first set of teammates to have at least eight homers and 20 RBI against a single team in a single season.

**CAUTION, HIGH WATER:** The Twins are currently at their high-water mark of 34 games over .500 for the sixth time this season...prior to 2019, last time the Twins were 34 games over was when they ended the 1970 season at a record of 98-64...last time they were 35 over was at the end of the 1965 season when they were 42 over with a record of 102-60.

**ALL HE DOES IS HIT:** Luis Arraez has reached base safely in 15 straight...during that stretch, he is hitting .426 (23-for-54) with a .483 OBP and a 1.039 OPS...Arraez's batting average is tied for eighth best among rookies in the Live Ball Era (min. 300 plate appearances and since 1920):

**PEN PALS:** Since August 1, Taylor Rogers, Sergio Romo, Tyler Duffey, Zack Littell and Trevor May have combined to post a 1.64 ERA (82.1 IP, 15 ER), a .180 (53-for-294) opponent batting average, 104 strikeouts, 28 holds and 14 saves.

Since August 16, the bullpen as a whole has posted a 2.95 ERA (113.0 IP, 37 ER) with a 5.26 strikeouts-per-walk ratio...their ERA in that span ranks second in baseball, their 5.26 K/BB figure leads baseball and their 1.09 WHIP ranks second.

**4 FOR 30:** The Twins have four players with 30-plus homers, Nelson Cruz (37), Max Kepler (36), Eddie Rosario (31) and Mitch Garver (30)...it ties a major league record, done 12 times, most recently by the 2009 Phillies (Howard - 45, Werth - 36, Ibáñez - 34 and Utley - 31) and 2006 White Sox (Dye - 44, Thome - 42, Konerko - 35 and Crede 30)...Miguel Sanó needs one home run to set a new major league record.

**LEADING OFF...THE CATCHER...** Mitch Garver has led off 21 times this season...he is hitting .301 (25-for-83) with four doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 20 RBI, 23 runs scored, 11 walks, a .392 OBP and a 1.163 OPS from that spot...he leads baseball in catchers at-bats from the leadoff spot, ahead of Tampa Bay's Travis d'Arnaud (58)...11 home runs for a catcher at the top spot in the order is the most since Paul Lo Duca had 14 for the Dodgers in 2001.

- Battled through injury in 2018 after breaking his non-throwing arm in the offseason after being charged by his pet bull.
• According to Inside Edge, opponents had a groundball rate of 67.3 percent (37/55) against Pérez's changeup in 2018, the highest in Major League Baseball with at least 80.0 IP.
• Led the Rangers in wins (13-career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
• His career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25-or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
• Went 10-6 with a 3.62 ERA (50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11).
