have 12 games remaining, six on the road and six at home.

TWINS CONTINUE TO WEAR OUT SOX: The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 5-3...losé Berríos (13-8) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on five hits in 7.1 innings pitched...Tyler Duffey (13) and Sergio Romo (14) each earned a hold and Taylor Rogers earned his 27th save...the offense recorded 10 hits, three from Luis Arraez and two from Mitch Garver...the Twins went 4-for-10 with runners in scoring position...Twins have won four straight over Chicago.

IF YOU SMELL WHAT THE ROC IS COOKING: Rocco Baldelli now has 92 managerial wins in his first season as a major league manager...only two other active managers won 92-or-more of their first 150 games as a manager in the major leagues: Alex Cora (103-47) and Aaron Boone (92-58). (Credit Elias).

 ■ Baldelli is the sixth manager in Twins/Senators franchise history to reach 92 victories in his first full managerial season...Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in his first season in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970, Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933 and Bucky Harris went 92-64 in 1924.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing each other for the 18th of 19 times this season...the Twins are 12-5 against Chicago this season, going 5-2 at Target Field and 7-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field...the Twins are 16-5 in the last 21 vs. the Sox...Twins have gone 36-19 vs. Chicago since the start of 2017, their most wins vs. any opponent since.

➡ Miguel Sanó is hitting .346 (18-for-52) with six home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.125 OPS in 15 games vs. the White Sox this season...has reached safely in 13 of the 15.

➡ Nelson Cruz is hitting .455 (25-for-55) with five doubles, eight home runs, 24 RBI and a 1.490 OPS in 14 games against the Sox this season...has eight multi-hit games and seven multi-RBI games.

➡ Max Kepler is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with four doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.352 OPS in 11 games against Chicago this season...six multi-hit games.

➡ Since 1970, eight different players have hit eight-plus homers vs. the Sox in one season: Albert Belle (9 in 1995), Juan González (9 in 2001), Brian Dozier (8 in 2016), Justin Morneau (8 in 2007), Eddie Murray (8 in 1987), Jim Thome (8 in 1997) and Max Kepler/Cruz now.

LAST START: Suffered his seventh loss of the season last Wednesday after allowing five runs on six hits with a home run, three walks and four strikeouts vs. the Washington Nationals...marks just his

hits with a home run, three walks and four strikeouts vs. the Washington Nationals...marks just his third start this season with five-or-more earned runs with at least 5.0 innings of work...finished the regular season 0-2 with a 5.53 ERA against NL opponents and is now 6-9 over 24 career IL starts.

The Nationals jumped on Pérez right away with a two-run, three-hit first inning...Adam Eaton started things off with a double to right field, then Juan Soto singled bringing home Eaton and that was followed by a single from Ryan Zimmerman plating Soto...pitched a perfect second inning before allowing three runs on two hits in the third...a Howie Kendrick double scored Soto who reached on a walk and that was followed by a two-run shot from Zimmerman to bring the score to 5-2 heading into the bottom half of the third...gave up just one hit and a walk in his last two innings before exiting after 5.0 innings of work.

TROUBLE WITH MEN ON: Martín has seen a lot of success in 2019 when working out of the windas he boasts an opponents' batting average of .231 (81-for-350) with an OPS of .687 when average (80-for-250) with an .876 OPS when pitching out of the stretch...with runners in scoring position, the lefty hasn't found much success either, as opponents are hitting .299 (43-for-144) with 12 XBH and 60 RBI with RISP, including .311 (23-for-74) with 30 RBI with RISP and two outs.

THE OTHER SIDE OF THE BATTERY: Over his 29 games, Pérez has thrown to each of the three catchers this season: Astudillo (4 games), Castro (10 games) and Garver (15 games)...below is a breakdown of how the left-hander has fared, depending on who's calling his pitches, courtesy of Baseball Reference:

SWEET, SOFT CONTACT: Pérez has created a lot of weak contact in 2019, as referenced by the 85.1 MPH average exit velocity against him this season, the second lowest in baseball behind Tampa Bay's Ryan Yarbrough (83.7 MPH), with a minimum of 300 batted balls...he also owns an average distance on balls in play of 151 feet, tied for third-best in the American League.

Perez also ranks in the 94th percentile in opponents' hard hit percentage (5th in baseball, 29.5%, min. 300 batted balls).

**PÉREZ VS. THE PALE HOSE:** Pérez is making his sixth career start against the Chicago White Sox, second of the season (last faced them 7/27 at Guaranteed Rate Field)...he was given the loss in that outing despite allowing three runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, as the Twins gave him just one run of support in a 5-1 loss.

• His last start on his home turf against the Sox came August 19, 2017 where he was the winner

- after tossing seven innings of six-run ball with seven hits, three walks and four strikeouts as a member of the Texas Rangers.
- One of his three career complete games came on April 18, 2014 against these White Sox in Arlington, as that was the first of back-to-back complete game shutouts he'd throw (also April
