THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-0 through two games on their final homestand of the 2019 season...tonight the Twins win play the three-game series finale and their last game vs. the Sox weekend...the Twins have 11 games remaining, six on the road and five at home.

TORREYES TAKES ONE FOR THE TEAM, TWINS WIN IN 12: The Twins beat the White Sox last night in walk-off fashion, overcoming two extra-inning deficits...Ronald Torreyes, in just his sixth plate appearance as a Twin, was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded, scoring Marwin Gonzalez from third base...Martín Pérez was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on 10 hits in 4.2 innings pitched...Twins pitchers allowed 20 hits, marking their third ever win (since 1961) with allowing as many hits...Nelson Cruz reached 600 career walks, Eddie Rosario reached 100 RBI for the season and Miguel Sanó hit his 30th homer...Sanó's homer marked the fifth Twin with 30-plus, setting a major league record...below are the Twins all-time single-season 30-homer groups

IF YOU SMELL WHAT THE ROC IS COOKING: Rocco Baldelli now has 93 managerial wins in his first season as skipper...Baldelli is the fifth manager in Twins/Senators franchise history to reach 93 victories in his first full managerial season...Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970 and Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing each other for the 19th and final time this season...the Twins are 13-5 against Chicago this season, going 6-2 at Target Field and 7-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins have won five straight over Chicago, their longest win-streak since taking seven straight September 28, 2018-May 26, 2019...the Twins are 17-5 in the last 22 vs. the Sox...Twins have gone 37-19 vs. Chicago since the start of 2017, their most wins vs. any opponent since.

THE 100'S: Eddie Rosario recorded his team-leading 100th RBI last night....he became the 18 th player in baseball to reach 100 RBI and eighth in the AL...first Twin to reach that mark since Josh Willingham had 110 in 2012...marks the 34th time in club history for a player to reach 100 and 16th for an outfielder.

PITCHERS ON STRIKE: Twins pitchers have recorded 1,345 strikeouts this season, the second most in club history, needing 32 to tie their club record of 1,377 set in 2018...starters have 789 strikeouts, 81 short of the club record ( 870 in 1967) and relievers have 556 strikeouts, 61 short record of the club record of 617 in 2018.

CAREER YEAR CONTINUES: Odorizzi has set a career high with 14 wins ( $14-6$ in 28 starts), surpassing his 11 victories for Tampa Bay in 2014 (11-13 in 31 starts)...the first-time All-Star is tied for seventh in the American League in wins and tied for 10th in winning percentage (.700). F He enters tonight's start 3.2 innings shy of qualitying for league leaders in additional categories....if
he did qualify, Odo would rank sixth in the AL in 0pponents' OPS (680), seventh in FIP (3.57) and he did qualify, Odo would rank sixth in the AL in opponents oPS (.680), seventh in FIP (3.57) and opponents batting average (.236, 130-for-552), eighth in ERA (3.60; 147.1 IP, 59 ER), ninth
in strikeouts-per- 9.0 innings (career-best $9.90,162$ SO in 147.1 IP) and 10 th in WHIP (1.23).
$\Phi$ The Twins' .714 winning percentage (20-8) with Odorizzi on the mound is tops among the club's starting rotation.

HIGH QUALITY, IF NOT HIGH QUANTITY: Odorizzi averages about 5.1 innings per start and owns just nine efforts of 6.0 -plus innings, including only two in his last 14 trips to the hill....he throws the most pitches-per-batter in the majors at 4.23 and most pitches-per-inning in the AL at 17.6 . क The Twins are 8-1 when Jake pitches at least 6.0 innings, while he is personally 7-0 with a 1.45
ERA (56.0 IP, 9 ER) and 169 opponents' batting average (33-for-195).
) 169 opponents batting average (33-for-19J).
JUST KIDDING: Jake's last "start" was washed out after 2.0 innings last Friday night at Cleveland, as rain struck with the game tied 2-2 and did not let up, resulting in a postponent...game was restarted the next day, played as Game 1 of the Twins doubleheader sweep....Jake's last official start came here September 7 vs. the Indians, when he struck out 10 over 5.1 innings.
A RETURN TO FORM: Jake's last eight starts have produced seven Twins wins, while he is 3-1 with a 3.05 ERA (44.1 IP, 15 ER), 15 walks and 54 strikeouts....in his first 14 starts (through June 15), Odorizzi led the AL with a 2.24 ERA (76.1 IP, 19 ER) and 10 wins....over his next six (June 20 - July


SWING AND A MISS: Odorizzi owns a career-high rate of 9.90 strikeouts per 9.0 innings, having fanned 162 batters in 147.1 innings pitched...is 12 strikeouts shy of matching his career high of 174, set back in 2014 with Tampa Bay.

Jake has struck out 25 in 16.1 innings over his last three starts, and 54 over 44.1 frames in his last eight trips to the hill.

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD: Pitching during the year of the home run, Odorizzi has yielded an average of 0.98 per 9.0 innings ( 16 HR in 147.1 IP ), his lowest rate since 2015 ( 0.96 ) and what would rank as fourth-best in the AL...has allowed just one homer in his last six starts (128 at-bats and 142 batters faced).

HOMEWARD BOUND: The Twins have won 10 of Odorizzi's 14 starts this season at Target Field, while he is personally $7-2$ with a 3.43 ERA ( $78.2 \mathrm{IP}, 30 \mathrm{ER}$ ) here at home...he has struck out 94 batters ( 10.31 per 9.0 IP ) against just 23 walks at home ( $3.65 \mathrm{SO} / \mathrm{BB}$ ratio)
क The Twins are 20-10 over the last two seasons when Jake toes the rubber at home, while he is 12-6 with a 4.07 ERA (159.1 IP, 72 ER).

until his trade to Minnesota on February 17, 2018.
- On May 29, 2016 vs. New York-AL, retired his first 16 batters faced, tied for third-Iongest perfect game bid in Rays history.
