**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 5-1 through six games on their 10-game roadtrip, starting with a three-game sweep of the White Sox, followed by two wins sandwiching a loss in Detroit this weekend...today the Twins will continue the trip with the fourth of four at Detroit, followed by three vs. the Red Sox from tomorrow-Thursday...the Twins have 26 games remaining, 12 against teams above .500 and 14 against team below .500.

**TWINS RIDE 11 SINGLES TO VICTORY:** Despite going bomba-less, the Twins bounced back from Saturday night's loss to the Tigers at Comerica Park with an 8-3 victory yesterday afternoon...Michael Pineda (11-5) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings pitched with nine strikeouts, recording his 12th quality start of the year...the offense collected 12 hits, with Luis Arraez's second-inning double being the lone extra-base hit for the Twins...Arraez finished with two hits, as did Jorge Polanco and Jake Cave, while Nelson Cruz had three.

☞ Pineda improved to 9-3 with a 3.57 ERA since May 5 (19 starts), with 11 quality starts.  
☞ Arraez recorded his first multi-hit game since August 19...had been 6-for-his-last-28 prior.

**THE BEST HOME RUN HITTING TEAM IN BASEBALL HISTORY:** The Twins have 268 home runs on the season the best in baseball history...below is baseball's all-time single-season home run list:

☞ The longest streak in baseball history was set by the Boston Red Sox from May 3, 2004-May 3, 2005 (164 games).

☞ They have 559 extra-base hits this season, already surpassing their franchise record of 551 set by the 2002 club...the single-season record for extra-base hits is 649, done by the 2003 Boston Red Sox...the Twins are on pace for 665 extra-base hits this season.

**800 CLUB:** Twins have scored 810 runs this season, marking the eighth time in club history to reach the 800-run mark...the club record is 877, done in 1996...the current club is on pace to score 964...just six teams since 1961 have scored 964 runs, the most recent being the 2007 Yankees (968).

**BRUS'D AND BATTERED:** Twins prospect Brusdar Graterol made his highly-anticipated Major League debut yesterday, firing a scoreless ninth inning with a strikeout and a game-ending double play...below are a couple of notes about his debut, with assistance from Statcast:

☞ At 21 years and six days old, he was the youngest *player* to debut for the Twins since Jorge Polanco (20 years, 356 days) in 2014.  
☞ He also became the youngest Twins pitcher to debut since Rich Garces (19 years, 123 days) on Sept. 18, 1990 vs. the Colorado Rockies.  
☞ Graterol threw 14 pitches (11 fastballs, 3 sliders)...the first pitch he threw was a 99.6 MPH fastball for a strike...without rounding up, he threw six pitches 99.0 MPH or faster, which already ranks second-best in Twins history since data is available back to 2008...only Juan Morillo (9 in 2009) threw more...Trevor May threw a pitch 99.8 MPH on August 5, the only other Twin this year to reach 99 MPH.

**TWINS AND TIGERS:** The Twins are playing the 16th of 19 games against the Tigers this season...each of the final four meetings between these two teams will be in Detroit...they have gone 10-5 vs. Detroit thus far, 6-3 at Target Field and 4-2 at Comerica Park...Twins have won 12 of their last 17 against the Tigers and 16 of their last 22...Twins are 6-0-1 in series play vs. Detroit in their last seven, home or away.  
☞ Twins have out-scored the Tigers 100-70 this season.

**NO BULL FROM THE 'PEN:** The Twins' bullpen has posted a 4.24 ERA (462.2 IP, 218 ER), which is the lowest bullpen ERA by the Twins since 2015 (3.95)...included in that, the Twins own a 2.67 ERA (175.0 IP, 52 ER) in 56 games against the American League Central so far this season with 20 games remaining...2.67 would be the lowest inter-divisional bullpen ERA by the Twins since the division was created back in 1994 (previous best was 2.86 back in 2005).

☞ Over their last 36 games since July 24, the Twins bullpen has pitched to a 3.52 ERA (122.2 IP, 48 ER) with a 9.2 SO/9 ratio...3.52 ranks as the third-best bullpen ERA in baseball since that date, trailing only the St. Louis Cardinals (2.86) and the Boston Red Sox (3.44).

**CAREER YEAR FOR THE ALL-STAR:** Odorizzi has set a career high with 14 wins (14-6 in 25 starts), surpassing his 11 victories for Tampa Bay in 2014 (11-13 in 31 starts)...the first-time All-Star is tied for fifth in the American League in wins and tied for eighth in winning percentage (.700), while also ranking eighth in FIP (3.70), ninth in ERA (3.55; 137.0 IP, 54 ER) and opponents' OPS (.685), 10th in opponents' batting average (.235, 121-for-514) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (career-best 9.53, 145 SO in 137.0 IP), and 15th in WHIP (1.24).

☞ The Twins' .692 winning percentage (18-8) with Odorizzi on the mound is tops among the club's starting rotation.

**HIGH QUALITY, IF NOT HIGH QUANTITY:** Odorizzi averages about 5.1 innings per start and owns just nine efforts of 6.0-plus innings, including only two in his last 12 trips to the hill...he throws the third-most pitches-per-inning in the AL at 17.6 and is tops in the majors with 4.21 pitches-per-batter. ☞ The Twins are 8-1 when Jake pitches at least 6.0 innings, while he is personally 7-0 with a 1.45 ERA (56.0 IP, 9 ER) and .169 opponents' batting average (33-for-195).

**HOT AUGUST NIGHTS CONTINUE IN CHICAGO:** After struggling to a 7.43 ERA in July, Odorizzi ranked 12th in the AL with a 2.86 mark in August (28.1 IP, 9 ER)...he concluded the month with a quality start and 8-2 win last Wednesday night at Guaranteed Rate Field against the White Sox...Jake pitched 6.0 solid innings, allowing just two runs (single tallies in the first and fourth innings) on five hits, with two walks and eight strikeouts -- his most since fanning eight Tigers here at Comerica Park on June 9.

**A RETURN TO FORM:** Jake's last six starts have produced five Twins wins, while he is 3-1 with a 2.65 ERA (34.0 IP, 10 ER), 13 walks and 37 strikeouts...he is trying to craft a stretch drive to mirror how his season began, as in his first 14 starts (through June 15), Odorizzi led the AL with a 2.24 ERA (76.1 IP, 19 ER) and 10 wins...over his next six (June 20 - July 24), he posted an 8.44 ERA (26.2 IP, 25 ER) and won just once...a closer look at the three stretches:

**IF YOU'RE RIGHT, YOU'RE WRONG:** Odorizzi has yielded just a .187 batting average (50-for-267) to right-handed hitters, third-best in the AL...he ranks fourth with a .574 OPS by righties.

**KEEPING IT IN THE YARD:** Pitching during the year of the home run, Odorizzi has yielded an average of 0.99 per 9.0 innings (15 HR in 137.0 IP), his lowest rate since 2015 (0.96) and fifth-best in the AL...he has not allowed a homer since a fifth-inning solo shot by Atlanta's Freddie Freeman on August 5, a span of 95 at-bats (105 batters faced) and four full starts since. ☞ He has surrendered only 15 home runs despite having the second-lowest ground ball rate in the game at 35.2 percent (only HOU's Justin Verlander is lower, at 34.8 percent).

**SOLAR POWERED:** Despite a loss in his last afternoon game (August 21 vs. Chicago-AL), Odorizzi still ranks second in the AL with a 1.82 daytime ERA (39.2 IP, 8 ER), while going 5-1 in seven starts. ☞ In three road starts under the sun, Odo is 3-0 with a 0.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 1 ER), six walks, 25 strikeouts and a .169/.258/.186 opponents' slash line (10-for-59 with one double)...he has won at New York-AL (May 4), at Tampa Bay (June 2) and here in Detroit (June 9).

**ROAD RULES:** The Twins have won all four of Odorizzi's road starts since the All-Star break (July 13 at CLE, July 30 at MIA, August 16 at TEX and August 28 at CWS), while he is 3-0 with a 2.78 ERA (22.2 IP, 7 ER) and a .207 opponents' batting average (17-for-92). ☞ He is 7-4 with a 3.68 ERA (63.2 IP, 26 ER) in 13 road starts overall this season (Twins are 9-4).

**3RD TIME NOT A CHARM:** Jake has held opposing hitters to a .208 batting average (43-for-207), 18 extra-base hits and a .621 OPS the first time through a lineup, then a .233 mark (47-for-202) with 11 XBH and a .651 OPS the second time...however, when navigating a lineup for a third time, Odorizzi has been touched for a .295 avg. (31-for-105), 13 XBH and an .877 OPS.
