THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 3-1 through four games on their final homestand of the 2019 season, taking two of three from Chicago and the series opener last night vs. Kansas City... tonight the Twins will play the second of four with the Royals, their final home series of 2019... after Sunday afternoon's finale, the Twins will travel to Detroit for an off-day on Monday, three vs. the Tigers September 24-26, then conclude the regular season with three in Kansas City September 27-29...the Twins have nine games remaining, six on the road and three at home.

BOMBA SQUAD CAPTAINS ACTIVATE: The Twins beat the Royals last night by a score of 8-5, their 10th win over KC this season... Kyle Gibson was the starter, allowing three runs in 1.2 innings pitched with four walks...the bullpen combined to allow two runs over 7.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded 10 hits, four being home runs from Mitch Garver (31), Nelson Cruz (38, 39) and Miguel Sanó (31)...Cruz's multiple home runs extended the Twins MLB record of most instances with a player having a multi-homer game to 32 times.
 ☞ It marked Cruz's seven multi-homer game this season, a new single-season career-high... it passes Harmon Killebrew's six multi-homer games in 1964, setting a Twins record.

RUNNING MEN: The Twins have now scored 885 runs, the most in Twins history (since 1961) and seven away from tying the Twins/Senators franchise record (since 1901):

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 14th of 19 scheduled games this season...they are 10-3 vs. KC this season, going 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 6-1 at Target Field...the Twins have gone 20-6 in their last 26 vs. KC overall, their best 26-game stretch vs. KC in franchise history...last night's win secured the season-series over the Royals.

☞ Twins most ever wins over KC was in 2002, going 14-5.
 ☞ Miguel Sanó is hitting .318 (34-for-107) with 10 home runs, 37 RBI, a .387 OBP, a .664 SLG and a 1.050 OPS in his last 28 games vs. Kansas City.
 ☞ C.J. Cron is hitting .305 (32-for-105) with seven doubles, eight home runs, 17 RBI and a .965 OPS in 31 career games vs. the Royals.

NOTE: One more homer and Cruz will become the ninth Dominican-born player to reach 400 homers, joining Pujols (656), Sosa (609), M. Ramirez (555), Ortiz (541), Beltré (477), Guerrero (449), Encarnación (414) and Soriano (412).

39 FOR 39: Nelson Cruz hit his 39th home run last night and is now one homer shy from becoming the 26th player in baseball history with at least four seasons of 40-plus homers (Cruz previously: 40 with BAL in 2014, 44 with SEA in 2015 & 43 with SEA in 2016...more on Cruz:
 ☞ He joins Hank Aaron (1973) and Barry Bonds (2003 & '04) as the only 39-year-olds to hit a homer equal to their age in a season.

☞ He reached the 100-RBI mark, joining Eddie Rosario as the 10th set of Twins teammates with 100-plus RBI in a season, first since Jason Kubel (103) and Justin Morneau (100) in 2009.
 ☞ Became the third DH in club history with 100-plus RBI, joining Paul Molitor (113 in 1996), Jason Kubel (103 in 2009).

☞ One more homer and he will become the third different Twin (since 1961) to hit 40, joining Harmon Killebrew (7x: '61, '62, '63, '64, '67, '69, '70) and Brian Dozier ('16)...full homer count on page 193 of 2019 Twins Media Guide.

 ☞ 2019 Division Series ticket strips for possible home games at Target Field, as allotted by Major League Baseball, have sold out, the club announced today...a limited number of single-game tickets for potential Division Series games at Target Field will be made available at a later date; details will be announced prior to a possible on-sale.
 ☞ On this day in 2004, the Twins won their 88th game of the season and clinched the AL Central with an 8-2 win over Chicago-AL...it marked the Twins third consecutive division championship.

SO FAR, SO GOOD: Through seven big league appearances, Dobnak has thrown 17.0 innings, allowing just four earned runs...Dobnak has had a lot of traffic on the basepaths, however, as he has already allowed 23 hits (20 singles, 2 doubles, 1 home run) with 12 strikeouts...threw a career-high 5.0 IP at Cleveland on Sept. 15.

SAVE THE DATE!: Randy recently got engaged to his fiancée, Aerial Munson, and their wedding is scheduled for Saturday, Sept. 28 at 3:30 P.M. ET in Williamsport, MD...coincidentally, the Twins are slated to play these Kansas City Royals in Missouri at 6:15 P.M. CT that same night.

The soon-to-be Dobnak family has two registries, one for Target and another for Bed, Bath and Beyond...some of the items requested: Pine-Sol, an Amazon Echo, Pledge Multisurface Cleaner, a Fiskars 67" Leaf Rake and a Coleman GuestRest Double-High Airbed (Queen sized).

FIRST BIG LEAGUE APPEARANCE: In his first big league appearance, Dobnak relieved Devin Smeltzer with 4.0 shutout innings on August 9, striking out three without issuing a walk against this Cleveland Indians lineup.

Yielded his first hit to perennial All-Star Francisco Lindor, the second batter he faced, while notching his first strikeout in the seventh inning, setting down Roberto Pérez swinging.

Allowed a baserunner to reach in each of his innings of work, but stranded all seven of them (6 singles and 1 fielder's choice), limiting the Indians to a 1-for-11 clip with runners on (.091 AVG).

Became just the sixth reliever in Twins history, first since Francisco Oliveras on May 3, 1989 vs. Milwaukee, to throw 4.0-or-more shutout innings in his ML debut.

AS A STARTER IN THE MINORS: Dobnak is no stranger to starting, as he started 45 of his 54 career games in the Minor Leagues, amassing a 2.53 ERA (228.0 IP, 64 ER) with 167 strikeouts to just 47 walks as a Minor League starter, as opposed to a 2.73 ERA (69.1 IP, 21 ER) in his 11 relief appearances.

His last start with Triple-A Rochester came on August 23 at Syracuse (New York-NL), throwing 5.0 innings of two-run ball, scattering four hits with four strikeouts and two walks.

He left the Minors with an active streak of 11 starts throwing at least 5.0 innings, dating back to May 29 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (3.2 IP).

A LOOK AT THE RÉSUMÉ: Dobnak definitely took the road less-traveled to the Majors...below is a list of all the previous jobs he's held, aside from being a professional pitcher, according to his LinkedIn profile:

AMATEUR HOUR: Prior to joining the Twins organization, Dobnak spent six weeks playing amateur ball for the Utica Unicorns of the United Shore Professional Baseball League.

In six games with the Unicorns, finished with a 3-0 record in 35.0 innings pitched while allowing just 22 hits, six walks, and had 29 strikeouts, and a 2.31 ERA and WHIP of just 0.80.

In 2016, as a junior at Division II Alderson Broaddus University in West Virginia, he finished with a 7-3 overall record with five complete games, leading the G-MAC in strikeouts with 89 and ranked 43rd in NCAA Division II in strikeouts...opponents hit just .246 against him and allowed only three home runs.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSÉ BERRÍOS (SEASON: 13-8, 3.58 ERA // CAREER: 42-34, 4.19 ERA)

Berrios has the ball tomorrow night in game three against these Royals...earned his 13th win of the year in his last start on Monday vs. the White Sox, firing 7.1 two-run innings, allowing five hits and two walks with eight strikeouts...is 0-0 with a 3.21 ERA (14.0 IP, 5 ER) in two starts against Kansas City this year, and 2-2 with a 4.11 ERA over 11 career starts against them...faced the Royals last on June 22 in Missouri, throwing 7.0 innings of two-run ball in an eventual 5-3 Twins win...last saw them in Minnesota on Sept. 8, 2018 (4-1 loss, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 5 SO).

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Randy won Pitcher of the Week for the week ending July 28 after making two starts, going 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA (12.1 IP, 2 ER) with seven hits, a hit batsman, three walks and 10 strikeouts...he was the only IL pitcher with two wins, tied for the league lead with 12.1 innings, and ranked fourth in the league with a 0.81 WHIP, and seventh with a .159 batting average against during the period.

- ☞ In 13 games vs. KC this season, Twins bullpen has a 2.03 ERA (44.1 IP, 10 ER) with nine saves, eight holds, nine walks, 36 strikeouts and a .204 BAA (233-for-162).
- ☞ Relievers have fashioned a 3.09 ERA (131.0 IP, 45 ER) in the last 32 games (beginning 8/16), best ERA in AL in that span (2nd in majors)...bullpen is 10-2 with 12 saves (15 opp.) and 31 holds.
- ☞ For the season, Twins 'pen ranks 4th in the AL & 5th in the majors in save percentage (70.1%, 47-for-67)... 'pen has 9.49 K/9.0, 4th best in AL and their 2.86 BB/9 is tops in all of baseball.
