THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-1 through five games on their final homestand of the 2019 season, taking two of three from Chicago and the first two vs. Kansas City the last two nights...tonight the Twins will play the third of four with the Royals, their final home series of 2019...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Detroit for an off-day on Monday, three vs. the Tigers from Tuesday-Thursday, then conclude the regular season with three in Kansas City next weekend.

RANDY'S DANDY, CAREER WIN ONE: The Twins beat the Royals last night by a score of 4-3...Randy Dobnak (1-1) was the starter and winner, the first victory of his major league career, allowing one run on three hits in 5.1 innings pitched...Trevor May earned his second save of the season with three strikeouts on three batters faced in the ninth inning...the offense recorded five hits, three going for extra-bases, a Nelson Cruz double (24), Jorge Polanco double (39) and a Miguel Sanó triple (2)...Twins are now 22-11 in one-run games, a .667 win%, best in the AL.

CAUTION, HIGH(EST) WATER: The Twins are currently at their high-water mark of 36 games over .500...the last time the Twins were 36 games over was at the end of the 1965 season when they were 42 over with a record of 102-60...their highest in club history.

RUNNING MEN: The Twins have now scored 889 runs, the most in Twins history (since 1961) and three away from tying the Twins/Senators franchise record (since 1901):

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 15th of 19 scheduled games this season...they are 11-3 vs. KC this season, going 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 7-1 at Target Field...the Twins have gone 21-6 in their last 27 vs. KC overall, their best 27-game stretch vs. KC in franchise history...Twins most ever wins over KC was in 2002, going 14-5.

FULL NELSON: Nelson Cruz has 39 home runs, third most in the AL, trailing Jorge Soler and Mike Trout, each with 45 and ninth most in all of baseball...23 of those home runs have been hit since the All-Star break, most in the AL, ahead of Soler's 22...below is where Cruz ranks on MLB's all-time home run list:

NOTE: One more homer and Cruz will become the ninth Dominican-born player to reach 400 homers, joining Pujols (656), Sosa (609), M. Ramirez (555), Ortiz (541), Beltré (477), Guerrero (449), Encarnación (414) and Soriano (412).

THIS IS 40?: Nelson Cruz is one homer shy from becoming the 26th player in baseball history (chart below) with at least four seasons of 40-plus homers (Cruz previously: 40 with BAL in 2014, 44 with SEA in 2015 & 43 with SEA in 2016)...one more homer and he will become the third different Twin (since 1961) to hit 40, joining Harmon Killebrew (7x: '61, '62, '63, '64, '67, '69, '70) and Brian Dozier ('16)...full homer count on page 193 of 2019 Twins Media Guide.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: Since the All-Star break, the bullpen has posted a 3.96 ERA (245.1 IP, 108 ER), the fourth best in the AL...in fact, in 33 games since August 16, the bullpen has posted a 3.01 ERA (134.2 IP, 45 ER), second best in baseball, trailing only Chicago-NL (2.91).
☞ Additionally, last night, the Twins staff set a new club record for strikeouts in a season, finishing the game with 1,381, passing their previous record of 1,377, done last season.

SANÓ, DONTCHA KNOW: Miguel Sanó has posted a .958 OPS and a .596 slugging percentage in his last 37 games, dating back to August 5, including 22 walks, 13 home runs and 33 RBI...since that date, he leads the Twins in OPS and ranks 13th in the AL.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, the Twins defeated Cleveland by a score of 6-4 and clinched their sixth division title in nine years as Ron Gardenhire earned his 800th managerial win...in 1997, Brad Radke pitched 10 innings to beat the Brewers 2-1 and earned his 20th win...he is one of 13 pitchers in club history to win 20 games and the last Twins starter to pitch 10 innings in a game.

BERRÍOS CRUISES PAST CHICAGO: Following a tough start to September (5.0 IP, 6 ER in Boston), the two-time All-Star recovered with back-to-back 7.0+ IP performances...

- Berrios allowed two early runs, one in each of the first two innings, coming on a sac-fly from José Abreu and a solo home run from James McCann...
• It was his 30th start of 2019, making him the 10th Twins pitcher to log multiple 30-start campaigns prior to his 26th birthday (chart below).

THIS IS 30: Berrios will be making his 31st start of 2019 tonight, his second consecutive season with 30-plus starts (32 last year).

- He has limited Royals hitters to a .240 average (12-for-50) this year, including .182 (2-for-11) with runners in scoring position.
• Is making his first start against the Royals at home this year, first time since Sept. 8 of last year (6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 5 SO in a 4-1 Twins loss).
