BERRÍOS CRUISES PAST CHICAGO: Following a tough start to September (5.0 IP, 6 ER in Boston), the two-time All-Star recovered with back-to-back 7.0+ IP performances, earning his first set of consecutive wins since late-July, throwing 7.1 innings with five hits and two runs allowed with eight strikeouts in a 5-3 Twins win on Monday.

 Berríos allowed two early runs, one in each of the first two innings, coming on a sac-fly from José Abreu and a solo home run from James McCann...following the longball, Berríos settled into to retire 18 of this final 22 batters, allowing only five baserunners on two walks, two singles (one by Moncada, who was later picked off first base) and an error...he struck out eight batters in the effort, his second eight-strikeout game over his last four starts.

 Berrios is fourth in the American League (T-8th in MLB) with 20 quality starts, while 21 out of his 30 starts have gone at least 6.0 innings (including 10 7.0+ inning efforts)...not only that, but in 101 career starts, Berrios has throw 50 quality starts (49.5 percent).

THIS IS 30: Berríos will be making his 31st start of 2019 tonight, his second consecutive season with 30-plus starts (32 last year).
