LAST START: Martín did not factor into the decision last Tuesday vs. the White Sox after tossing 4.2 innings of three-run ball with 10 hits and four strikeouts...marked just his ninth career game with 10-plus hits allowed and his second resulting in a win, the last coming April 5, 2018...also marked his shortest outing at home since he threw four innings against New York-AL on July 22 and marked his first no-decision since August 18, a span of five starts.

B Scattered three hits and no runs in the first three innings until a lead-off double from Eloy Jímenez and a single from James McCann brought in their first run of the game in the fourth inning...a two-run two-hit fifth inning got started with back-to-back singles from Adam Engel and Leury García and they then advanced bases on a wild pitch...a sacrifice-fly brought home Engel while García moved over to third and was then brought home on a José Abreu single... exited after 4.2 innings with three runs on 10 hits with four strikeouts.

TROUBLE WITH MEN ON: Martín has seen a lot of success in 2019 when working out of the wind-up, as **he boasts an opponents' batting average of .240 (86-for-358) with an OPS of .702 when the bases are clear**...however, once he allows someone to reach base, Pérez struggles to a .322 average (85-for-264) with an .866 OPS when pitching out of the stretch...with runners in scoring position, the lefty hasn't found much success either, as opponents are hitting .304 (45-for-148) with 12 XBH and 63 RBI with RISP, including .307 (23-for-75) with 30 RBI with RISP and two outs.

THE OTHER SIDE OF THE BATTERY: Over his 30 games, Pérez has thrown to each of the three catchers this season: Astudillo (4 games), Castro (10 games) and Garver (16 games)...below is a breakdown of how the left-hander has fared, depending on who's calling his pitches, courtesy of Baseball Reference: ERA IP/ER HITS/AB CATCHER GAMES BAA XBH (HR) 3.98. 6.10. 4.48. SWEET, SOFT CONTACT: Pérez has created a lot of weak contact in 2019, as referenced by the 85.2 MPH average exit velocity against him this season, the second lowest in baseball behind Tampa Bay's Ryan Yarbrough (83.7 MPH) with a minimum of 300 batted balls...he also owns an average distance on balls in play of 152 feet, tied for fourth-best in the American League.
 Pérez also ranks in the 94th percentile in opponents' hard hit percentage (5th in baseball, 29.7%, min. 300 batted balls).

A DEEPER LOOK AT TIMES THROUGH THE LINEUP: Pérez has done his best work early in ballgames, as he boasts a 2.91 ERA (58.2 IP, 19 ER) while he weaves through a given lineup for the first time in a game, with a BAA of .222 and just 14 XBH...however, those numbers spike dramatically the second time through, as his ERA balloons to 6.41 (53.1 IP, 38 ER) and his opponents' average jumps to .318...when he makes it to a third tour, his ERA rests at 5.45 (34.2 IP, 21 ER) with 13 extra-base hits

ROYAL SHOWDOWN: Pérez is making his seventh career start against the Kansas City Royals, fourth this season...owns a 1-1 record with a 4.46 ERA (36.1 IP, 18 ER) against the Royals while holding their hitters to a .270 average (37-for-137).

TUESDAY'S STARTER - JAKE ODORIZZI RHP (SEASON: 14–7, 3.89 ERA ; CAREER: 61–55, 3.90 ERA)

Odorizzi will be making his 30th start on Tuesday opposite of Spencer Turnbull...in his last start on Wednesday vs. the White Sox he was dealt his seventh loss of the season after allowing two runs on seven hits with a walk and nine strikeouts marking his fifth nine-strikeout performance of the season, second consecutive (10 on 9/7 vs. Cleveland)...has faced the Royals twice this year going 1-1, 7.20 ERA (10.0 IP, 8 ER) with two home runs, three walks and nine strikouts...over his career he is 3-5 with a 4.88 ERA (55.1 IP, 30 ER) over 11 games (10 starts)...looking for his second win against KC at home this year, last came June 15 where he allowed four runs over seven hits in 6.0 innings of work.
