THE ICING ON TOP: Odorizzi takes the ball tonight and possibly Sunday at Kansas City, looking to top off what is arguably his best big league season...the first-time All-Star has already set a career high with 14 wins...

ODO-METER: With enough innings to qualify (3.0 IP short), Odorizzi would rank among the top-15 AL pitchers in 14 statistical categories (and in the top-10 in 10)...

HIGH QUALITY, IF NOT HIGH QUANTITY: Odorizzi averages about 5.1 innings per start and owns just nine efforts of 6.0-plus innings, including only two in his last 15 trips to the hill...

A RETURN TO FORM: Jake's last nine starts have produced seven Twins wins, while he is 3-2 with a 3.06 ERA (50.0 IP, 17 ER), 16 walks and 63 strikeouts...

SWING AND A MISS: Odorizzi owns a career-best rate of 10.06 strikeouts per 9.0 innings and, with 171 total (in 153.0 IP), is three shy of matching his career high 174 (set in 2014 with Tampa Bay).

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD: Pitching during the year of the home run, Odorizzi has yielded an average of 0.94 per 9.0 innings (16 HR in 153.0 IP), his lowest rate since 2015 (0.96) and what would rank as fourth-best in the AL...

ROAD RULES: The Twins have won all five of Odorizzi's road starts since the All-Star break (including September 2 here at Detroit), while he is 3-0 with a 3.25 ERA (27.2 IP, 10 ER).

CAREER NOTES

- Finished 2018 with 32 starts, his fifth-straight season with at least 28 starts; along with Kyle Gibson (32) and José Berrios (32), they became the first trio of Twins with 30-plus starts in the same season since 2007.
• Was Twins Opening Day starter March 29, 2018 at Baltimore, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts...first Opening Day start of career.

TAMING THE TIGERS: Odorizzi is 2-0 with a 2.00 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER) in two starts against Detroit this season, holding Tigers hitters to 11 hits in 61 at-bats (.180), with one double, one homer, one walk, one hit batter and 20 strikeouts.

- Jake's teams have won all five of his career starts here at Comerica Park, while he is 3-0 with a 2.54 ERA (28.1 IP, 8 ER)...the Twins are 4-0 behind Odo in Detroit, and he is 2-0, 3.22 (22.1 IP, 8 ER)...this season, the Twins won 12-2 on June 9 and 4-3 on September 2.
• The Twins are 7-0 in Odo's starts overall against the Tigers, as he is 3-0 with a 3.86 ERA (37.1 IP, 16 ER).

CENTRALLY SPEAKING: In 13 starts vs. the AL Central this season, Odorizzi is 7-3 with a 2.86 ERA (72.1 IP, 23 ER), while the Twins are 9-4.

LAST TIME OUT: Jake fell victim to the White Sox bullpen last Wednesday night at Target Field, taking a 3-1 loss as eight Chicago pitchers held the Twins to three hits...he scattered seven hits over 5.2 innings, allowing two runs with one walk and
