**THE TWINS:** After taking five of seven games in their last regular season homestand of 2019, The Twins began their final regular season roadtrip with a 4-2 win last night in Detroit...they will play tonight and tomorrow here at Comerica Park before flying to Kansas City for three over the weekend...the Twins are a season-high 37 games over .500 (97-60), their best mark since ending the 1965 season a club-record 42 games over (102-60).

**TWINS RIDE BIG 7TH INNING TO VICTORY:** The Twins beat the Tigers last night by a score of 4-2... Jake Odorizzi (15-7) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits over 6.0 innings pitched, becoming the first Twins pitcher with 15-or-more wins since Ervin Santana (16) in 2017...the offense recorded eight hits, two each by Jake Cave and LaMonte Wade Jr., as well as two-RBI hits in the seventh inning from Williams Astudillo and Eddie Rosario...Kyle Gibson threw 2.0 innings of relief, followed by Taylor Rogers, who nailed down his 29th save.

**ROAD RULES:** The Twins have won 12 of their last 15 away from Target Field and have gone 51-25 (.671) on the road this season, marking the most road wins and highest road winning percentage in baseball...Twins have outscored opponents on the road 468-345...51 road wins is now tied with the Twins' single-season record set back in 1965...the Twins are 22-11 (.667) against AL Central foes, their best in-division road record since joining the Central in 1994, and their second-best in Minnesota history (the 1970 Twins went 31-14...689 on the road against AL West opponents)...below are the Twins all-time best road seasons (since 1961):

**Note:** They are just the 11th team since 2000 to record at least 51 road wins in a season...over that span, only two teams in the AL Central have done so: 2017 Cleveland Indians (57-24) and 2005 Chicago White Sox (52-29)...in fact, of the other 10 teams to do win at least 51 road games in a season, five of them made it to the World Series, including three winners: CWS (2005), HOU (2017) and BOS (2018).

**TWINS AND TIGERS:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the 18th of 19 scheduled games this season... they are 12-5 vs. Detroit this season, going 6-2 at Comerica Park and 6-3 at Target Field...since 2017, Minnesota has gone 35-20 against Detroit and has a +93 run differential in those games (330-237), their best vs. any opponent in that time span.

- ⊕ Nelson Cruz is hitting .353 (24-for-68) with four home runs, 14 RBI and a .961 OPS in 17 games vs. Detroit this year, including a .486 (17-for-35) batting average in Detroit...his 1.341 OPS in Comerica Park this season is the third highest single-season OPS here since it opened in 2000 (min. 30 AB).
- ⊕ Mitch Garver is 13-for-30 (.433) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 10 RBI, 11 walks and a 1.619 OPS in 10 games vs. Detroit this season...his 1.619 OPS vs. Detroit this year is the fourth highest in baseball history (since 1901, min. 40 PA), trailing Reggie Jefferson (1.755 in 1996), Jim Thome (1.641 in 1996) and José Ramírez (1.625 in 2017), just ahead of Babe Ruth (1.585 in 1929).
- ⊕ Eddie Rosario is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with three doubles, two home runs and 13 RBI in 13 games vs. Detroit this season...he has five homers and 17 RBI vs. DET in his last 17 games (.878 OPS).

**CENTRALLY SPEAKING:** The Twins enter tonight's matchup with Detroit with a record of 46-25 against teams in their own division...if the Twins won each of their five remaining games against divisional opponents (2 vs. Detroit, 3 vs. Kansas City), they would set the all-time club record for wins against the AL Central...entering tonight, 46 wins is tied for the club's fourth-most single-season wins against the division (2009, '04), trailing only the 2002 club (50) and the 2010 and '01 teams (47).

⊕ With a win tonight and a Cleveland loss to the White Sox (7:10 P.M. CT), the Twins would clinch the Central division for the first time since 2010.

**DOBNAK RETURNS TO MICHIGAN:** Tonight's starting pitcher, Randy Dobnak, has seen his name in a bevy of headlines for his circuitous route taken to the big leagues over the past few years...for Dobnak, however, it all began roughly 25 miles north of here in Utica, MI, as a member of the Utica Unicorns of the United Shore Professional Baseball League in 2017.

⊕ Dobnak spent six weeks with the Unicorns, pitching to a 3-0 record over 35.0 IP, while allowing just 22 hits, six walks, and 29 strikeouts with a 2.31 ERA before signing a Minor League deal with the Twins.

⊕ The 2019 Utica club won the USPBL championship 6-5, over the Westside Woolly Mammoths on Sept. 8...according to their team website, nine Unicorns were signed to Minor League contracts in 2019.

**BULLISH PEN:** Since August 16, Twins relievers lead the American League and rank second in all of baseball with a 3.36 ERA (147.1 IP, 55 ER)...during that 36-game stretch, the 'pen is 11-3 with 14 saves (in 17 opportunities), 36 walks and 172 strikeouts...the Twins have gone 24-12 in that span overall, tied for the second-most wins in the AL with Oakland (24-11), trailing Houston (25-10).

⊕ Tyler Duffey, who began the season with Triple-A Rochester, has not allowed a run over his last 25 games...owns baseball's longest active scoreless innings streak (22.2), dating back to July 28 at CWS.

**FLIPPING THE CALENDAR:** With the win last night, the Twins are 14-8 with 27 scheduled September games, giving the Twins all six winning months this season...the only other times in their history (since 1961) to win all six months were 2002 and 1965.

⊕ The Twins had a winning month in September of 2018...this September marks eight consecutive winning months for the first time since previously doing so in from June-September of 1969, then continuing the streak from April-July of 1970.

**DOBNAK EARNS FIRST DUB OVER ROYALS:** In what was his eighth big league appearance, fourth start, Dobnak pitched his way to a 4-3 victory over the Kansas City Royals last Friday at Target Field, recording his first Major League victory...scattered just two hits through the first 5.0 innings of work, both singles to rookie Ryan McBroom...was spotted a two-run lead, courtesy of a Nelson Cruz sac fly and a Miguel Sano triple...exited following a single to Jorge Soler and a groundout by Hunter Dozier, but Soler would come around to score on an Alex Gordon double off Cody Stashak.

**SAVE THE DATE!:** Randy and his soon-to-be wife Aerial Munson are preparing for their wedding, which is scheduled for this Saturday, Sept. 28 at 3:30 P.M. ET in Maryland Line, MD...coincidentally, the Twins are slated to play the Kansas City Royals in Missouri at 6:15 P.M. CT that same night.

☞ During his last start, word of his wedding registries went viral on social media around Twins Territory, and Twins fans overwhelmed the Dobnak family with support, purchasing them a myriad of different items on each registry...since that night, the Dobnak's have added an option to their registry: a direct link to donate funds to St. Jude's Children Hospital, which has already earned \$2,780 as of noon today.

☞ On Twitter postgame, Randy shared a message from Aerial that said "After Randy's game, around 2:00 A.M., we discussed all the craziness of the wedding story and decided to have our family and friends (or unknown fans) donate to a charity. It was a no-brainer...our first thought was St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Anyone who knows me, knows my dream is to one day work at St. Jude. Randy has a special place in his heart for children and even more so now after visiting a local children's hospital in Minnesota."

**DOBNAK RETURNS TO DETROIT, 25 MILES SOUTH OF UTICA:** Prior to joining the Twins organization, Dobnak spent six weeks playing amateur ball for the Utica Unicorns of the United Shore Professional Baseball League, playing in Utica, MI, just 25 miles from Comerica Park.

☞ In six games with the Unicorns, Dobnak pitched to a 3-0 record over 35.0 IP, while allowing just 22 hits, six walks, and 29 strikeouts with a 2.31 ERA and WHIP of just 0.80.

☞ His last outing with the Unicorns came on July 22, 2017, when he threw a complete game, allowing two runs on four hits with seven strikeouts on the road against the Eastside Diamond Hoppers...the Twins signed him to a minor league contract six days later.

☞ Has made one relief appearance in this ballpark, striking out Ronny Rodríguez, Brandon Dixon and Willi Castro on August 31.

**AS A STARTER IN THE MINORS:** Dobnak is no stranger to starting, as he started 45 of his 54 career games in the Minor Leagues, amassing a 2.53 ERA (228.0 IP, 64 ER) with 167 strikeouts to just 47 walks as a Minor League starter, as opposed to a 2.73 ERA (69.1 IP, 21 ER) in his 11 relief appearances.

☞ His last start with Triple-A Rochester came on August 23 at Syracuse (New York-NL), throwing 5.0 innings of two-run ball, scattering four hits with four strikeouts and two walks.

☞ He left the Minors with an active streak of 11 starts throwing at least 5.0 innings, dating back to May 29 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (3.2 IP).
