TWINS TAKE SERIES WITH TIGERS: The Twins beat the Tigers last night by a score of 5 Randy Dobnak (2-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one unearned run on one hit in 6.0 innings pitched...Tyler Duffey, Trevor May and Zack Littell combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded nine hits, highlighted by home runs from Luis Arraez (4) and Eddia Rosario (32)

**ROAD RULES:** The Twins have won 13 of their last 16 away from Target Field and have gone 52-25 (.675) on the road this season, marking the most road wins and highest road winning percentage in baseball...Twins have outscored opponents on the road 473-346...52 road wins surpassed the Twins' single-season record set back in 1965 (51)...the Twins are 23-11 (.676) against AL Central foes, their best in-division road record since joining the Central in 1994, and their second-best in Minnesota history (the 1970 Twins went 31-14, .689 on the road against AL West opponents)...below are the Twins all-time best road seasons (since 1961):

Note: They are just the seventh team since 2000 to record at least 52 road wins in a season...over that span, only two other teams in the AL Central have done so: 2017 Cleveland Indians (53-28) and 2005 Chicago White Sox (52-29)...in fact, of the other six teams to win at least 52 road games in a season, three of them made it to the World Series, including two winners: CWS (2005) and HOU (2017).

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing for the 19th and final time this season... they are 13-5 vs. Detroit this season, going 7-2 at Comerica Park and 6-3 at Target Field... since 2017, Minnesota has gone 36-20 against Detroit and has a +97 run differential in those games (330-237), their best vs. any opponent in that time span.

■ 13 wins over the Tigers is tied with their 1962 total for third best by the Twins in a single season...trailing their 2003 total (15-4), 2001 (15-4) and 2002 (14-4) - all Ron Cardonhiro managed teams

Gardenhire-managed teams.

**CENTRAL HEATING:** The Twins enter today's matchup with Detroit with a record of 47-25 against teams in their own division...if the Twins win each of their four remaining games against Detroit and Kansas City, they would set the all-time club record for wins against the AL Central...entering today, 47 wins is tied for the club's second-most single-season wins against the division (47-25 in 2010), trailing only the 2002 club (50-25).

**COMING INTO TODAY:** Smeltzer is making his 11th appearance of the season today, and he does so riding a 4.0-scoreless inning streak, that included a 3.0 IP, one-hit outing in Cleveland on Sept. 14... he's made five starts and five relief appearances to this point, and he is part of a group of Twins rookies who have combined to post a 4.13 ERA (257.1 IP, 118 ER).

**SMELTZER'S SMALL SAMPLE SIZE SUCCESS:** Despite appearing in only 10 games with the big league club, Smeltzer has displayed an ability to limit damage when runners are on-base, holding opponents to a .222 (14-for-63) batting average...he has also fared much better in day games, going 1-0 with a 1.56 ERA (17.1 IP, 3 ER) with a 14/2 SO/BB rate in the daytime.

DEBUT NOTES: Smeltzer's historic Major League debut against the Milwaukee Brewers came on May

- 28 at Target Field...some of the highlights are listed below:

  Became the fourth Twins starter in history to throw 6.0-or-more shutout innings in his debut, joining Andrew Albers (8.1 on August 6, 2013), Anthony Swarzak (7.0 on May 23, 2009) and
- Eric Milton (6.0 on April 5, 1998).

  Recorded seven strikeouts, one shy of the franchise record in a debut, set by Boof Bonser on May 21, 2006 at Milwaukee...became just the fifth Twins pitcher to record seven-or-more strikeouts joining Bonser, Yohan Pino (7 in 2014), Darrell Jackson (7 in 1978) and Bert Blyleven (7 in joining Bonser, Yohan Pino (7 in 2014), Darrell Jackson (7 in 1978) and Bert Diviever (7 in 1970)...was matched by Lewis Thorpe, who struck out seven in his debut against Chicago-AL on June 30, marking the first time in Senators/Twins history to have multiple rookies. strikeout seven-plus batters in their debuts in the same season, and just the eighth pair in baseball history (Toronto's Trent Thornton and Jacob Waguespack did so earlier this year).

GET TO KNOW THE KID: Smeltzer was raised in New Jersey and graduated from Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken Township in 2014 (became the ninth New Jersey-born player, seventh pitcher to make his debut for the Twins, first since RHP Rob Delaney on Sept. 4, 2010)... was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft, but chose to continue his development at Florida Gulf Coast University.

• Following his season at FGCU, the left-hander transferred to San Jacinto College North in San Jacinto, Texas, where he would go on to lead the NJCAA League 14 in ERA (1.18) and strikeouts (128), while ranking third with nine wins...won the National Junior College Athletic Association Player of the Week award for April 4-10, 2016, after throwing a complete game no-hitter in an 8-0 win over Wharton County Junior College, in which he struck out 16 batters and walked three...also threw two no-hitters in high school and one in a college summer league game.

SMELTZER THE CANCER SURVIVOR: When Smeltzer was just nine years old, he was diagnosed with pelvic rhabdomyosarcoma (bladder cancer), as a tumor had formed against his bladder that was connected to his prostate...he underwent surgery and chemotherapy at St. Christopher's Hospital for Children in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and sent the cancer into full remission in 2012.

- While he fought off the cancer, he lost a substantial amount of weight as the radiation and chemotherapy weakened his immune system, leading to frequent vomiting...missed baseball while he was ill, so he made a deal with the chief of oncology at St. Christopher's that he could go back to playing baseball...if he grew weaker, he had to stop and be fed through a feeding tube.
- While receiving treatment, Smeltzer became popular throughout the hospital as he would always talk to the other kids, helping them get through treatments the way he did...the lefty, who's worn glasses and a goatee for the majority of his professional career, continues to offer support to others fighting cancer.
