 The Berríos pitched a perfect first inning before the Royals got on the board first with a Ryan O'Hearn double and a Meibrys Viloria sac fly...following Viloria, Berríos set down 10 of his next 12 batters, before the Royals rode four singles and an O'Hearn homer in the sixth to plate three more runs.

 The game remained tied at 5 apiece until the ninth inning, where three pitchers (Rogers, Hildenberger and Alcala) combined to get three outs while allowing seven runs on eight his and two walks, including a pinch-hit, two-run home run by Cheslor Cuthbert.

 Berríos is fourth in the American League (T-10th in MLB) with 20 quality starts, while 22 out of his 31 starts have gone at least 6.0 innings (including 10 7.0 + inning efforts)...not only that, but in 102 career starts, Berríos has thrown 50 quality starts (49.0 percent).

 José enters tonight's start with 49 walks, which ranks tied for the ninth-frewest in the American League (min. 150.0 IP)...he's looking to become the first Twins pitcher to throw at least 150.0 IP while issuing 50-or-less walks since Mike Pelfrey (164.2 IP, 45 BB) and Phil Hughes (155.1 IP, 16 BB) in 2015.
