THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 6-1 through seven games on their 10-game roadtrip, starting with a three-game sweep of the White Sox, followed by three wins in four games at Detroit...tonight the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three in Boston through Thursday...the Twins have 25 games remaining, 12 against teams above .500 and 13 against teams below .500.

TWINS TAKE DOWN TIGERS: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Comerica Park by a score of 4-3...Jake Odorizzi was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 14 hits, including three from both Jorge Polanco and Luis Arraez...Ehire Adrianza hit his fifth home run of the season, a second inning two-run shot off Jordan Zimmermann...Max Kepler's two-out, two-run single in the eighth rallied the Twins.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins announced today that they have recalled right-handed pitchers Ryne Harper, Trevor Hildenberger and Fernando Romero from Triple-A Rochester...Harper, who spent the majority of the season with the Twins, appeared in 56 games out of the bullpen including making his major league debut on March 31...he went 3-2 with a 3.65 ERA (49.1 IP, 20 ER) while recording one save and 11 holds...Harper made three appearances (3.0 IP) while with the Red Wings...Hildenberger split the season between the Twins and Triple-A Rochester, along with a brief rehab stint with the GCL Twins, making a combined 36 relief appearances overall...he started the season with the Twins and made 19 appearances before being optioned on May 15...Hildenberger, who missed over two months with a right elbow strain, finished the Triple-A season with 8.1 scoreless innings after being activated from the Injured List on August 20...Romero, who will be making his fourth stint with the Twins this year, made 35 appearances (1 start) for the Red Wings this season, in addition to his eight appearances with the Twins...the 24-year old made his major league debut last season appearing in 11 games...the Twins now have 36 active players on their roster.

TWINS-SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fourth of six scheduled meetings this season...the last meeting between these two came June 17-19 as the Twins won the middle of the three-game series at Target Field...Twins have won just one game in their last six against the Sox...their last trip to Fenway was July 26-29 of last season, winning game one of the four-game series.

- ☞ The Twins have gone 18-11 vs. AL East opponents this season, going 6-0 vs. Baltimore, 2-4 vs. New York, 4-3 vs. Toronto, 5-2 vs. Tampa Bay and 1-2 vs. Boston...they currently have a .621 winning percentage against the AL East.
- ☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .300 (102-for-340) with 21 doubles, three triples, 22 home runs and 64 RBI in 90 career games against the Red Sox...he has hit safely in eight straight against Boston.

- ☞ Twins relief pitchers have a strike rate of 66.7% (1,408/2,112) with RISP this season -- highest in MLB; League Avg: 63.1%.
- ☞ Twins hitters are slugging .533 (1,479 total bases in 2,773 ABs) against starting pitchers this season -- best in MLB; League Avg: .443.
- ☞ Twins hitters have 111 home runs in innings 1-3 this season -- most in MLB.
- ☞ Max Kepler has 51 extra-base hits out of 75 total hits (68.0%) against starting pitchers this season -- best in MLB; League Avg: 40.4%
- ☞ Tyler Duffey has struck out 61.5% (8/13) of right-handed batters faced in his last five appearances -- 2nd best in MLB over the last two weeks; League Avg: 25.6%.
- ☞ The Twins have used a defensive shift 976 times in 1,670 plate appearances (58.4% shift rate) vs right-handed batters this season -- highest in MLB; League Avg: 23.3%.

SO FAR, SO GOOD: So far through three big league appearances, Dobnak has thrown 8.0 innings without allowing an earned run...Dobnak has had to work to keep his ERA at 0.00, however, as he has already allowed 13 hits (12 singles, 1 double) with six strikeouts...has pitched twice this roadtrip, throwing a combined 4.0 IP, allowing seven hits and two unearned runs at Chicago-AL (8/29) and Detroit (8/31).

FIRST BIG LEAGUE APPEARANCE: In his first big league appearance, Dobnak relieved Devin Smeltzer with 4.0 shutout innings on August 9, striking out three without issuing a walk against a potent Cleveland Indians lineup.

- ⊕ Yielded his first hit to perennial All-Star Francisco Lindor, the second batter he faced, while notching his first strikeout in the seventh inning, setting down Roberto Pérez swinging.
- ⊕ Allowed a baserunner to reach in each of his innings of work, but stranded all seven of them (six singles and one fielder's choice), limiting the Indians to a 1-for-11 clip with runners on (0.91 AVG).
- ⊕ Became just the sixth reliever in Twins history, first since Francisco Oliveras on May 3, 1989 vs. Milwaukee, to throw 4.0-or-more shutout innings in his ML debut.

AS A STARTER IN THE MINORS: Dobnak is no stranger to starting, as he started 45 of his 54 career games in the Minor Leagues, amassing a 2.53 ERA (228.0 IP, 64 ER) with 167 strikeouts to just 47 walks as a Minor League starter, as opposed to a 2.73 ERA (69.1 IP, 21 ER) in his 11 relief appearances.

- ⊕ His last start with Triple-A Rochester came on August 23 at Syracuse (New York-NL), throwing 5.0 innings of two-run ball, scattering four hits with four strikeouts and two walks.
- ⊕ He left the Minors with an active streak of 11 starts throwing at least 5.0 innings, dating back to May 29 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (3.2 IP).

AMATEUR HOUR: Prior to joining the Twins organization, Dobnak spent six weeks playing amateur ball for the Utica Unicorns of the United Shore Professional Baseball League.

- ⊕ In six games with the Unicorns, finished with a 3-0 record in 35.0 innings pitched while allowing just 22 hits, six walks, and had 29 strikeouts, and a 2.31 ERA and WHIP of just 0.80.
- ⊕ In 2016, as a junior at Division II Alderson Broaddus University in West Virginia, he finished with a 7-3 overall record with five complete games, leading the G-MAC in strikeouts with 89 and ranked 43rd in NCAA Division II in strikeouts...opponents hit just .246 against him and allowed only three home runs.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Randy won Pitcher of the Week for the week ending July 28 after making two starts, going 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA (12.1 IP, 2 ER) with seven hits, a hit batsman, three walks and 10 strikeouts...he was the only IL pitcher with two wins, tied for the league lead with 12.1 innings, and ranked fourth in the league with a 0.81 WHIP, and seventh with a .159 batting average against during the period.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSÉ BERRÍOS (SEASON: 11-7, 3.57 ERA // CAREER: 40-33, 4.20 ERA)

Berrios will have his start pushed back a day as he takes the ball tomorrow night against these Red Sox...earned his 11th win of the year in his last start of August 29 at Chicago-AL, throwing 6.0 innings and allowing three runs on seven hits with eight strikeouts...faced these Sox on June 17 at Target Field and was outdueled by Rick Porcello, as Berrios spun 8.0 innings, allowing just one run (one-out J.D. Martinez single in the first inning) on five hits with 10 strikeouts in a 2-0 Twins loss...is 0-2 with a 5.73 ERA (11.0 IP, 7 ER) in two starts in this ballpark, with his last coming on July 29 of last year (4.2 IP, 9 H, 3 ER)...has allowed exactly three earned runs in three of his last four starts...is 3-1 with a 2.67 ERA (33.2 IP, 10 ER) in five starts against the American League East this season.
