THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 7-1 through eight games on their 10-game roadtrip, starting with a three-game sweep of the White Sox, followed by three wins in four games at Detroit and a win over the Red Sox last night in Boston...tonight the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three in Boston through tomorrow night...the Twins have 24 games remaining, 11 against teams above .500 and 13 against teams below .500.

TWINS CONTINUE TO ROLL ON ROAD: The Twins beat the Red Sox last night at Fenway Park by a score of 6-5...Randy Dobnak was the Opener, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning...Lewis Thorpe (2-1) earned his second career victory, allowing three runs on two hits in 3.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, two from both Luis Arraez and Miguel Sanó...Sanó hit his 27th home run of the season and Nelson Cruz hit his 35th.

ROAD RAGE: Twins have won 11 of their last 12 on the road, out-scoring opponents 94-53 in that span...they lead baseball in road wins, going 47-23 away from Target Field...below are the Twins all-time best road seasons (since 1961):

THE 30 CLUB: Eddie Rosario and Miguel Sanó each have 27 home runs and Mitch Garver has 26...if any of them make it to 30, they would join Max Kepler (36) and Nelson Cruz (35) and become the fifth trio of Senators/Twins to reach 30 HR apiece...Twins have never had four players do so...the other trios: Tom Brunansky (32), Gary Gaetti (31) and Kent Hrbek (34) in 1987...Bob Allison (32), Harmon Killebrew (49) and Tony Oliva (32) in 1964...Allison (35), Jimmie Hall (33) and Killebrew (45) in 1963...Allison (30), Killebrew (42) and Jim Lemon (33) in 1959.

WHOA NELLY! Nelson Cruz hit his 35th home run last night, marking his sixth straight season with 35-plus...he becomes the ninth player in baseball history to hit 35-plus in at least six consecutive seasons, joining Alex Rodriguez (11, 1998-2008), Sammy Sosa (10, 1995-2004), Jimmie Foxx (9, 1930-40), Rafael Palmeiro (9, 1995-2003), Babe Ruth (7, 1926-32), Ralph Kiner (7, 1947-53), Adam Dunn (7, 2004-10), and Willie Mays (6, 1961-66).

☞ Along with Cruz's 35 home runs, Max Kepler has 36...they are one of two sets of teammates with 35-plus joining Atlanta's Freddie Freeman (38) and Ronald Acuña Jr. (36)...also the second pair of Twins teammates to ever accomplish that feat, joining Harmon Killebrew (45) and Bob Allison (35) who did it in 1963.

TWINS-SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fifth of six scheduled meetings this season...the Twins have gone 2-2 against the Sox this season, going 1-2 at Target Field from June 17-19 and 1-0 at Fenway.

☞ The Twins have gone 19-11 vs. AL East opponents this season, going 6-0 vs. Baltimore, 2-4 vs. New York, 4-3 vs. Toronto, 5-2 vs. Tampa Bay and 2-2 vs. Boston...they currently have a .633 winning percentage against the AL East, the second best in their history (.655 in 1991 at 55-29).

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .299 (103-for-344) with 21 doubles, three triples, 23 home runs and 65 RBI in 91 career games against the Red Sox...he has hit safely in nine straight against Boston.

CLUTCHING UP: The Twins are hitting .270 (431-for-1599) with 86 home runs with two strikes this season...their 86 home runs are tied with New York-AL for most in baseball...their 431 hits rank second to Boston and their .270 average ranks third, trailing Boston (.276) and New York-AL (.273).

AUGUST RUSH INTO SEPTEMBER: The Twins have gone 14-4 since August 15, tied with Atlanta for the second best record in the majors since that date, trailing St. Louis (15-5)...since August 15, Minnesota is averaging 7.39 runs -- second only to Washington's 7.76 runs per game for the highest in baseball.

CAUTION, HIGH WATER: The Twins are currently at their high-water mark of 34 games over .500, marking the first time being 34 games over since ending the 1970 season with a record of 98-64...last time they were 35 over was at the end of the 1965 season when they were 42 over with a record of 102-60.

RED HOT JORGE: Jorge Polanco has hit safely in eight straight games, hitting .471 (16-for-34) with six multi-hit games in that span...he has 156 hits from the shortstop position this season, already fifth best in club history since 1975, trailing Cristian Guzmán (170 in 2002), Roy Smalley (167 in 1979), Smalley (159 in 1978) and Guzmán (158 in 2004).

THIS AND THAT:

☞ On this day in 2010, Jim Thome hit his 583rd and 584th career home runs to pass Mark McGwire and take over ninth place on baseball's all-time list in a Twins 12-4 win over Texas...Thome currently ranks eighth on baseball's all-time list.

BERRÍOS GETS BACK ON TRACK IN CHICAGO: Following a quartet of starts that saw Berríos' ERA balloon from 2.80 to 3.53, the righty regained his All-Star form in Chicago as he recorded his 18th quality start in a 10-5 Twins win, tossing 6.0 innings of three-run ball, striking out eight...he didn't allow a home run for the first time since July 31, which was also the last time he earned a victory.

- ☞ Berríos was spectacular through four innings, yielding just two singles and two walks, before three consecutive hits to lead off the fifth inning plated a pair of runs before another run scored in the fifth on a two-out RBI single by Eloy Jiménez.
- ☞ Threw a career-worst four wild pitches in the effort, becoming the first Twin to record at least four in an outing since Bert Gallia in 1917, and the first to do so *and win* since Walter Johnson in 1914.
- ☞ Berríos is tied for fourth in the American League (T-9th in MLB) with 18 quality starts, while 19 out of his 27 starts have gone at least 6.0 innings (including nine 7.0+ inning efforts)...not only that, but in 98 career starts, Berríos has thrown 48 quality starts (49.0 percent).

HAPPY CENTENNIAL, JOSÉ! When Berríos steps on the mound this evening, it will be the 100th time he's done so at the Major League level, becoming the 91st pitcher in Twins history to pitch in 100 games...this will be his 99th start, as he made one relief appearance at the end of 2017 vs. Detroit.

- ☞ Enters with 553 career strikeouts...with one tonight, he will own the most strikeouts by any Twin in history through 100 career games, surpassing Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven, who concluded his 100th career game on Sept. 16, 1972 vs. Kansas City with 553 strikeouts.
- ☞ The Bayamón, Puerto Rico native already owns the record for most strikeouts through 100 career games among Puerto Rican big leaguers, as the record was previously held by Javier Vázquez (Ponce, PR), who amassed 496 strikeouts through his first 100 career games.

WITH AUGUST IN THE REARVIEW, BERRÍOS LOOKS TO FINISH STRONG: Earlier this season, Berríos made his second career appearance in an All-Star Game, and it was ultimately deserved, as he pitched to an 8-5 record with a crisp 3.00 ERA (117.0 IP, 39 ER) with 104 strikeouts and 15 home runs allowed in 18 starts...since then, he has amassed a 3-2 record with a 4.85 ERA (52.0 IP, 28 ER) with 59 strikeouts and seven homers in just nine starts (Twins are 4-5).

- ☞ Despite his strong conclusion to the month, his month of August was one of his worst statistical months ever, as he posted a 7.57 ERA (27.1 IP, 23 ER) following a 12-start stretch in which he went 4-3 with a 2.31 ERA (78.0 IP, 20 ER), from May 24-July 31.
- ☞ He is no stranger to second-half swoons, as he owns a career 3.58 ERA (379.1 IP, 151 ER) from March-July (62 starts), but has pitched to a 5.52 ERA (189.0 IP, 116 ER) with 28 home runs allowed from August-October (38 games, 36 starts, includes postseason).

THE OTHER SIDE OF THE BATTERY: Over his 27 starts, Berríos has thrown to each of the three catchers this season: Astudillo (3 games), Castro (14 games) and Garver (10 games)...below is a breakdown how La Makina has done, depending on who's calling his pitches, courtesy of Baseball Reference:
