LAST TIME OUT: Pineda continued his hot streak by adding another win to the column after tossing six innings of two-run ball with five hits, one walk and nine strikeouts in a Twins 8-3 win over the Tigers at Comerica Park...now has five consecutive wins (in 6 starts), which sets a new career-high...allowed one hit in the first before the Tigers plated their first run in the second inning on back-to-back doubles from Dawel Lugo and Brandon Dixon...pitched perfect third and fourth innings until Dixon came around to score in the fifth as he reached on a walk, was moved over on a wild pitch and then was brought home on a single from Victor Reyes...in the sixth, Big Mike gave up a leadoff infield single and then struck out the next three batters to end his day.

FIVE COUNTING ON FIVE: Pineda is now 5-0 over his last six starts and is 7-2, with a 3.08 ERA (76.0 IP, 26 ER) over his last 13 starts dating back to June 13...he ranks seventh in the AL for ERA since June 13 (min. 75.0 innings pitched)...the Twins have went 10-3 over that stretch...he has allowed 68 hits, with 15 walks, 77 strikeouts and an opponents' slash line of .238/.279/.378.

- ♥ Pineda is 7-2 in his last nine decisions while going 5-1 on the road and 2-1 at Target Field over those nine.
- He has limited teams to three earned runs-or-less in 17 of his last 19 starts, dating back to May 5 at New York-AL...he owns a 3.57 ERA (111.0 IP, 44 ER) while striking out 108 batters over that stretch (Twins are 22-6), with 11 quality starts and a 1.08 WHIP.

WALK TALK: Pineda ranks fourth fewest in all of baseball with 26 free passes this season Walk THLR: Finded ranks fourth revest in an or based an with 20 here passes this season with at least 25 starts (excludes openers)...his walks-per-nine innings rate is 1.67, which ranks seventh best in the majors among starters with at least 140.0 IP...has eight starts without walking a batter this season and 11 with walking just one.
 Michael also averages one walk per 0.45 batters he faces, which is the sixth lowest in baseball among pitchers with at least 140.0 IP while his 5.00 strikeout-to-walk rate sits T-11th in the majors.

- Pineda has a combined 19 starts this season with walking one or fewer batters...over those 19 he owns a 10-4 record.

AGAINST THE CENTRAL: The right-hander enters today's start with a record of 15-12 in 34 career starts against American League Central opponents, holding opposing batters to a .247 average while surrendering just 23 home runs in 202.1 innings pitched...in 2019, Pineda has fared well against the Central, posting a 6-1 record with a 3.79 ERA (57.0 IP, 24 ER) with just five walks and 57 strikeouts,

The Pineda now has five consecutive wins over AL Central opponents this season with his last loss coming on June 23 at Kansas City, where he allowed five runs on eight hits over 5.0 innings of work.

AGAINST CLEVELAND: Pineda is making his third career start against Cleveland tonight and his second this season...in his last start on March 31, his Twins debut, he did not factor into the decision after tossing 4.0 scoreless innings with five strikeouts in a Twins 9-3 win...his lone win against the Tribe came on August 5, 2016, after allowing four runs in 6.0 innings pitched with six strikeouts as a member of the New York Yankees...owns a lifetime record of 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and 11 strikeouts.
