THE TWINS: After the Twins completed their 10-game roadtrip with a record of 8-2 (3-0 vs. the White Sox, 3-1 vs. Detroit and 2-1 vs. Boston), they began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a loss to the Indians last night...tonight the Twins will continue the homestand with the second of three vs. the Tribe...they will complete the series tomorrow afternoon, enjoy an off-day Monday, then host the Nationals for three from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have 21 games remaining, nine against teams above .500 and 12 against teams below .500.

TWINS SUFFER TOUGH LOSS TO TRIBE: The Twins lost to the Indians last night by a score of 6-2...Michael Pineda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing just one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched...Sergio Romo suffered a blown save, allowing a run in the eighth inning...the bullpen allowed four runs in the 11th...the offense recorded nine hits, just one going for extra-bases, a C.J. Cron double.

NOTE: Since August 13, the Twins have gone 16-7, the third most wins in baseball, trailing only St. Louis (18-7) and Atlanta (18-4).

TWINS-TRIBE: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 15th of 19 scheduled meetings this season...Twins are 6-8 vs. the Indians this season, going 3-5 at Target Field and 3-3 at Progressive Field...more team comparisons in box to lower right.

⚡ Eddie Rosario is hitting .313 (93-for-297) with 15 doubles, four triples, 17 home runs, 38 RBI, 48 runs scored and a .908 OPS in 78 career games vs. Cleveland; the homers and hits all being his personal most vs. any opponent...his 93 hits and 17 homers vs. Cleveland since 2015 lead baseball.

⚡ Max Kepler has 14 career home runs against Cleveland, his most vs. any opponent.
⚡ Nelson Cruz has 23 career home runs vs. the Indians (second-most among actives, Cabrera - 46), including 12 in his last 23 games (21 RBI).

MULTI POLO: Jorge Polanco recorded his 50th multi-hit game last night, the first Twin with 50-plus multi-hit games since Joe Mauer (55) and Denard Span (54) in 2009...37 have been two-hit games, nine have been three-hit games, two have been four-hit games and two have been five-hit games...on the season, his 50 multi-hit games rank fifth best in the AL and seventh best in baseball.

⚡ Polanco has hit .382 (29-for-76) with a 1.013 OPS in his last 18 games...for the season, he is hitting .302...his batting average hasn't dipped below .290 all season.

'PEN PALS: Since August 1, Taylor Rogers, Sergio Romo, Tyler Duffey, Zack Littell and Trevor May have combined to post a 1.64 ERA (66.0 IP, 12 ER), a .190 (45-for-237) opponent BA, 85 strikeouts, 22 holds and 11 saves.

⚡ Since August 16, the bullpen as a whole has posted a 2.61 ERA (76.0 IP, 22 ER) with 9.4 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP and a 4.94 strikeouts-per-walk ratio...their ERA in that span leads baseball, their 4.94 K/BB ranks second and their 1.13 WHIP ranks fourth.

ARRAEZ TO THE OCCASION: Among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 250 plate appearances, Luis Arraez leads in batting average (.341), on-base percentage (.411), and is eighth in OPS (.852)...the Twins all-time rookie batting average record among "qualifying" rookies is held by Tony Oliva at .323 in 1964...Twins have had seven Twins rookies all-time hit over .300 with a minimum of 250 PA's: Oliva (previously mentioned), Danny Santana (.319 in 2014), Danny Valencia (.311 in 2010), Corey Koskie (.310 in 1999), Kent Hrbek (.301 in 1982) and Mark Salas (.300 in 1985).

⚡ Among all MLB players with at least 250 PA's, he ranks first in fewest strikeouts (24).

3/30: Eddie Rosario has 28 home runs, Miguel Sanó has 27 and Mitch Garver has 26...if any of them make it to 30, they would join Max Kepler (36) and Nelson Cruz (35) and become the fifth trio of Senators/Twins to reach 30 HR apiece...Twins have never had four players do so...the other trios: Tom Brunansky (32), Gary Gaetti (31) and Kent Hrbek (34) in 1987...Bob Allison (32), Harmon Killebrew (49) and Tony Oliva (32) in 1964...Allison (35), Jimmie Hall (33) and Killebrew (45) in 1963...Allison (30), Killebrew (42) and Jim Lemon (33) in 1959.

BRING 'EM OUT, BRING 'EM OUT!: Twins rank fifth in the AL in total attendance, having drawn 1,967,619 this season, trailing New York (3,049,761), Boston (2,593,506), Los Angeles (2,574,822) and Houston (2,437,883)...Twins need 32,381 to reach the 2-million mark for the 19th time in club history, first since 2017 (2,051,279)...it will mark the eighth time in 10 seasons at Target Field to draw 2-million (2016 & '18 being the exception).

⚡ The Twins yesterday announced that fans can join in the pennant race and "Pack the Park" at Target Field with 2-for-1 tickets to home games on September 10-12 vs. Washington and September 16-18 vs. Chicago-AL...this limited-time Twins ticket offer is good for Home Plate View tickets (Sections 310-319) and can be purchased at twinsbaseball.com/packthepark.

HBD, SMELTZ!: Devin Smeltz is celebrating his 24th birthday today...he shares a birthday with the late rapper Eazy-E, NBA stars Kevin Love and Donovan Mitchell, comedian Leslie Jones and actor Corbin Bernsen, who played Roger Dorn in Major League.

⚡ Double-A Pensacola won last night in Game 3 of the Southern League Semifinals, making the series 1-2 in favor of Biloxi...Game 4 will be at 6:35 (CT) tonight in Biloxi.

⚡ Single-A Cedar Rapids won the decisive Game 3 of the Midwest League Quarterfinals over Quad Cities last night by a score of 4-2...the Kernels move on to the MWL Western Division Championship Series and will play at Clinton at 6:30 (CT) tonight.

WHATCHU KNOW 'BOUT THAT: The first 10,000 fans in attendance receive the fourth and final in a set of four commemorative Joe Mauer bobbleheads...today's bobblehead honors Mauer's final Major League game on September 30, 2018, featuring Joe, in his catcher's gear, tipping his cap.

LOOKING FOR #15: Odorizzi has set a career high with 14 wins (14-6 in 27 starts), surpassing his 11 victories for Tampa Bay in 2014 (11-13 in 31 starts)...

The Twins' .704 winning percentage (19-8) with Odorizzi on the mound is tops among the club's starting rotation.

HIGH QUALITY, IF NOT HIGH QUANTITY: Odorizzi averages about 5.1 innings per start and owns just nine efforts of 6.0-plus innings, including only two in his last 13 trips to the hill...

The Twins are 8-1 when Jake pitches at least 6.0 innings, while he is personally 7-0 with a 1.45 ERA (56.0 IP, 9 ER) and .169 opponents' batting average (33-for-195).

LAST TIME OUT: The Twins improved to 7-0 against Detroit over the last two seasons with Odorizzi on the mound, rallying for a 4-3 win in Monday's series finale at Comerica Park...

A RETURN TO FORM: Jake's last seven starts have produced six Twins wins, while he is 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA (39.0 IP, 13 ER), 13 walks and 44 strikeouts...

IF YOU'RE RIGHT, YOU'RE WRONG: Odorizzi has yielded just a .194 batting average (54-for-278) to right-handed hitters, third-best in the AL...

However, over his last three starts, righties are 12-for-33 (.364) with a .932 OPS...by contrast, left-handed batters are just 6-for-31 (.194) with a .438 OPS in that stretch.

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD: Pitching during the year of the home run, Odorizzi has yielded an average of 1.01 per 9.0 innings (16 HR in 142.0 IP), his lowest rate since 2015 (0.96) and fourth-best in the AL...

He has surrendered only 16 home runs despite having the fourth-lowest ground ball rate in the game at 36.2 percent.

However, Odorizzi has allowed 11 of his 16 home runs here at home (in 73.1 IP)...has been touched for only five on the road (in 68.2 IP).

HOMEWARD BOUND: The Twins have won nine of Odorizzi's 13 starts this season at Target Field, while he is personally 7-2 with a 3.44 ERA (73.1 IP, 28 ER) here at home...

The Twins are 19-10 over the last two seasons when Jake toes the rubber at home, while he is 12-6 with a 4.09 ERA (154.0 IP, 70 ER).

CAREER NOTES

- Finished 2018 with 32 starts, his fifth-straight season with at least 28 starts; along with Kyle Gibson (32) and José Berríos (32), they became the first trio of Twins with 30-plus starts in the same season since 2007 (Johan Santana - 33, Carlos Silva - 33, and Boof Bonser - 30).
• Was Twins Opening Day starter March 29, 2018 at Baltimore, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts...first Opening Day start of career.
• Selected by Milwaukee in the first round (32nd overall) of 2008 First-Year Player Draft, traded to Kansas City in 2010, then in 2012 traded to Tampa Bay where he remained until his trade to Minnesota on February 17, 2018.
• On May 29, 2016 vs. New York-AL, retired his first 16 batters faced, tied for third-longest perfect game bid in Rays history.
• Established career-highs in 2016 for starts (33) and innings pitched (187.2).
• Earned his first major league win on April 4, 2014 vs. Texas.

VS. THE INDIANS: Odorizzi is 2-0 with a 1.06 ERA (17.0 IP, 2 ER) in three starts against Cleveland this season, holding Indians hitters to 10 hits in 59 at-bats (.169), with three doubles, two home runs, eight walks, one hit batter and 19 strikeouts.

Jake has won both of his starts vs. the Tribe in the second half, with an 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, 1 ER), while in non-Odorizzi starts vs. Cleveland since the All-Star break, the Twins are 1-5...he pitched the Twins to a 6-2 victory July 13 at Progressive Field (5.1 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 2 SO)...

In two starts vs. the Indians this season at Target Field, he has allowed just one run on seven hits in 11.2 innings (0.77 ERA), with six walks and 17 strikeouts...the lone run came via a Hanley Ramirez solo homer back on March 30, the lone blemish in Odorizzi's 6.0 innings of one-hit ball.

He is 3-4 with a 4.42 ERA (59.0 IP, 29 ER) in 12 career starts vs. Cleveland, including 2-3, 4.65 (40.2 IP, 21 ER) in eight overall starts with the Twins.

CENTRALLY SPEAKING: In 11 starts vs. the AL Central this season, Odorizzi is 7-2 with a 2.79 ERA (61.1 IP, 19 ER), while the Twins are 8-3.

Jake is 4-1 with a 2.06 ERA (35.0 IP, 8 ER) and .188/.250/.297 opponents' slash line in six starts vs. the AL Central at Target Field this season.

- Twins 'pen is 27-19-43 with a 4.23 ERA (485.2 IP, 228 ER), 82 holds, 161 walks & 504 strikeouts this season (141 games)...allowing a .258 opp. batting average (489-for-1893).
- For the season, Twins 'pen ranks 7th in the AL...8th in the majors in save percentage (69.4%, 43-for-62)...pen has 9.34 K/9.0, 5th best in AL and 3.13 K/BB the best in the AL, 2nd in baseball.
- Relievers have fashioned a 2.61 ERA (76.0 IP, 22 ER) in the last 20 games (beginning 8/16), best ERA in baseball in that span.
- Twins bullpen is 2-5, 4.06 ERA (61.0 IP, 23 ER) with a .227 BAA, 4 saves and 8 holds in 14 games vs. Cleveland this season.
- Twins relievers are 2.79 ERA (184.0 IP, 57 ER) with 17 HR, 46 BB, 194 K's and a .232 BAA in 58 games vs. the AL-Central this season...2.83 ERA (47.2 IP, 15 ER) in last 13 vs. AL-Central.

- Is 3-2, 3.81 ERA (54.1 IP, 23 ER) w/ 16 BB and 52 K's in 21 career G vs. CLE (6 starts)...has 2.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 2 ER) in last 8 G vs. CLE.
- Has 15.2 scoreless IP streak, the longest active streak in baseball and longest for a Twin since Taylor Rogers' 28.2 streak that ended 4/2... during streak, Duffey has 3 wins, 7 holds, 5 BB, 0 HR, 27 Ks and a .167 BAA...struck out multiple batters 8 times during streak.
- Has been equally effective vs. both left-handed batters (.222, 20-for-90 with 7 XBH) and right-handers (.204, 20-for-98 with 5 XBH).
- Is 4-1 with 11 holds, a 2.59 ERA (48.2 IP, 14 ER), 14 walks and 67 strikeouts in 49 relief appearances this season...has held opponents to a .213/.273/.351 slash line.
