Odorizzi was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched...Taylor Rogers earned his 25th save with a perfect ninth inning...the offense recorded seven hits as Mitch Garver went 2-for-3 with two home runs and four RBI, his fifth multi-homer game of the season and second in his last eight days...Garver's multi-homer game gave the Twins their 30th multi-homer game of the season, extending the major league record.

WELCOME BACK, LaMARRE: The Twins have acquired outfielder Ryan LaMarre in a trade with Atlanta in exchange for cash...LaMarre, 30, spent the season with Triple-A Gwinnett, hitting .311 (126-for-405) with 24 doubles, eight triples, nine home runs, 53 RBI, 55 runs scored, 38 walks, 19 stolen bases and an .857 OPS in 112 games...the four-year major league veteran played in 43 games for the Twins in 2018, hitting .263 (26-for-99) with five doubles, eight RBI, eight walks and seven runs scored before being designated for release or assignment in early lath. We finished seven runs scored before being designated for release or assignment in early July...he finished 2018 in the Chicago White Sox organization, hitting .303 (20-for-66) with the big league club.

**CAUTION, HIGH WATER:** The Twins are currently at their high-water mark of 34 games over .500 for the third time this season...prior to this season, last time the Twins were 34 games over was they ended the 1970 season at a record of 98-64...last time they were 35 over was at the end of the 1965 season when they were 42 over with a record of 102-60.

SO FAR, SO GOOD: Through four big league appearances, Dobnak has thrown 9.0 innings without allowing an earned run...Dobnak has had to work to keep his ERA at 0.00, however, as he has already allowed 13 hits (12 singles, 1 double) with eight strikeouts...pitched thrice in the last roadtrip, throwing a combined 5.0 IP, allowing seven hits and two unearned runs at Chicago-AL (8/29) and Detroit (8/31).

FIRST BIG LEAGUE APPEARANCE: In his first big league appearance, Dobnak relieved Devin Smeltzer with 4.0 shutout innings on August 9, striking out three without issuing a walk against a potent Cleveland Indians lineup.

- Tielded his first hit to perennial All-Star Francisco Lindor, the second batter he faced, while
- notching his first strikeout in the seventh inning, setting down Roberto Pérez swinging.

  Allowed a baserunner to reach in each of his innings of work, but stranded all seven of them (6 singles and 1 fielder's choice), limiting the Indians to a 1-for-11 clip with runners on (.091 AVG).
- Became just the sixth reliever in Twins history, first since Francisco Oliveras on May 3, 1989 vs. Milwaukee, to throw 4.0-or-more shutout innings in his ML debut.

**AS A STARTER IN THE MINORS:** Dobnak is no stranger to starting, as he started 45 of his 54 career games in the Minor Leagues, amassing a 2.53 ERA (228.0 IP, 64 ER) with 167 strikeouts to just 47 walks as a Minor League starter, as opposed to a 2.73 ERA (69.1 IP, 21 ER) in his 11 relief appearances.

This last start with Triple-A Rochester came on August 23 at Syracuse (New York-NL), throwing 5.0 innings of two-run ball, scattering four hits with four strikeouts and two walks.
