THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-0 so far on their six-game roadtrip, after a three-game sweep in Detroit and two wins over the Royals the last two days...today they will complete the 2019 regular season with the third of three games against the Royals...**the Twins are a season-high 41 games over .500, their best mark since ending the 1965 season a club-record 42 games over (102-60).**

TWINS POYS: The Twins announced today that outfielder Trevor Larnach has been named the 2019 Sherry Robertson Award winner as the Twins Minor League Player of the Year and right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak has been named the 2019 Jim Rantz Award winner as the Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

☞ Larnach, 22, split the season between Single-A Ft. Myers and Double-A Pensacola, combining to hit .309 (147-for-476) with 30 doubles, one triple, 13 home runs, 66 RBI and an .842 OPS in 127 games...the 6-foot-4, 223-pound outfielder was named Florida State League Most Valuable Player and named to both Florida State League midseason and postseason All-Star teams...he was FSL Player of the Week in early June and MiLB.com FSL Player of the Month in May. Prior to the season he was ranked as the fifth-best prospect in the Twins system by both Baseball America and MLB.com

☞ Dobnak, 24, split the 2019 season between Single-A Ft. Myers, Double-A Pensacola, Triple-A Rochester and Minnesota...the 6-foot-1, 230-pound pitcher went 12-4 with a 2.07 ERA (135.0 IP, 31 ER), 28 walks, 109 strikeouts, a 0.98 WHIP and a .212 opponent batting average in 24 games (21 starts) at three levels of the Twins minor league system this season...he was named International League Pitcher of the Week in late July...Dobnak had his contract selected by Minnesota in mid-August and has since posted a record of 2-1 with a 1.59 ERA (28.1 IP, 5 ER), five walks and 23 strikeouts.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing for the final time this season...they are 14-4 vs. KC this season, going 6-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 8-2 at Target Field...the Twins have gone 20-8 in their last 28 overall vs. KC.

☞ 14 wins ties their best mark in a single season over the Royals, matching their 2002 total of 14-5.

THE HOMER CHASE: Twins have hit 304 home runs this season...on Thursday they became the first team in baseball history to reach the 300-homer mark...the New York Yankees have 305 on the season...full list above.

LAST START: Martín did not factor into the decision in his last start against the Royals a week ago today after allowing five runs on eight across just 2.1 innings of work, his shortest start of the season...stranded men on second and third base with nobody out in the first inning before Nick Dini hit a two-out, two-run home run in the second inning...the struggles continued into the third inning with four of the first five batters reaching base, including back-to-back doubles to start the frame...was relieved by Zack Littell, who stranded a runner on second base with a pair of groundouts. ☞ Marked his shortest start since September 28, 2018 at Seattle where he worked just 1.2 innings after allowing five runs (two earned) on one hit. ☞ Over his last five starts (since August 31), Pérez has labored to a 9.15 ERA (20.2 IP, 21 ER) surrendering 35 hits (12 XBH), with an opponents slash line of .376/.412/.591 (1.003 OPS)... no pitcher in baseball has a higher batting average against since that date (min. 20.0 IP).

TROUBLE WITH MEN ON: Martín has seen a lot of success in 2019 when working out of the wind-up, as he boasts an opponents' batting average of .245 (89-for-363) with an OPS of .711 when the bases are clear...however, once he allows someone to reach base, Pérez struggles to a .328 average (90-for-274) with an .885 OPS when pitching out of the stretch...with runners in scoring position, the lefty hasn't found much success either, as opponents are hitting .310 (48-for-155) with 13 XBH and 66 RBI with RISP, including .303 (23-for-76) with 30 RBI with RISP and two outs.

THE OTHER SIDE OF THE BATTERY: Over his 31 games, Pérez has thrown to each of the three catchers this season: Astudillo (4 games), Castro (10 games) and Garver (17 games)...below is a breakdown of how the left-hander has fared, depending on who's calling his pitches, courtesy of Baseball Reference:

SWEET, SOFT CONTACT: Pérez has created a lot of weak contact in 2019, as referenced by the 85.3 MPH average exit velocity against him this season, tied for the third lowest in all of baseball, with a minimum of 300 batted balls...he also owns an average distance on balls in play of 153 ft., fourth-best in the American League. ☞ Pérez also ranks in the 94th percentile in opponents' hard hit percentage (5th in baseball, 29.5%, min. 300 batted balls).

A DEEPER LOOK AT TIMES THROUGH THE LINEUP: Pérez has done his best work early in ballgames, as he boasts a 3.13 ERA (60.1 IP, 21 ER) while he weaves through a given lineup for the first time in a game, with a BAA of .230 and just 15 XBH...however, those numbers spike dramatically the second time through, as his ERA increases to 6.83 (54.0 IP, 41 ER) and his opponents' average jumps to .327...when he makes it to a third tour, his ERA rests at 5.45 (34.2 IP, 21 ER) with 13 extra-base hits.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Pérez is 5-3 with a 4.81 ERA (67.1 IP, 36 ER), 37 walks, 47 strikeouts, seven home runs allowed and a .266 (71-for-267) batting average against in 12 road starts this season...in 16 starts at Target Field, he is 5-4, 5.36 ERA (92.1 IP, 55 ER) with 27 walks, 83 strikeouts, 15 home runs and an opponents' average of .292 (108-for-378).

ROYAL SHOWDOWN: Pérez is making his eighth career start against the Kansas City Royals, fifth this season...owns a 1-1 record with a 5.35 ERA (38.2 IP, 23 ER) against the Royals while holding their hitters to a .296 average (45-for-152). ☞ His lone win against these Royals came on July 14, 2017 at Kauffman Stadium (7.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R, 1 HR, 1 BB, 1 SO). ☞ So far this season, the lefty has gone 0-1 (Twins are 3-1) against Kansas City, receiving the loss on June 16 at Target Field and not factoring into the decision five days later in Kansas City, here on August 2 and September 22...has an 8.53 ERA (19.0 IP, 18 ER) in those four starts.

CAREER NOTES

- Battled through injury in 2018 after breaking his non-throwing arm in the offseason after being charged by his pet bull.
- According to Inside Edge, opponents had a groundball rate of 67.3 percent (37/55) against Pérez's changeup in 2018, the highest in Major League Baseball with at least 80.0 IP.
- Led the Rangers in wins (13-career high), starts (32) and innings (185.0) in 2017, while setting a career-best in strikeouts (115).
- His career-high 198.2 IP in 2016 were the sixth-most by a Texas pitcher age 25-or-younger and the most since José Guzmán in 1988.
- Went 10-6 with a 3.62 ERA (50 ER in 124.1 IP) in 2013, ranking tied for first among American League rookies in wins, second in ERA and third in both starts (20) and quality starts (11).
