THE TWINS: After opening their 60th season last night in Chicago with a win over the White Sox, the Twins will play the second of three today on the South Side...following tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel home and enjoy an off-day in Minneapolis on Monday, followed by a six-game homestand vs. the Cardinals (July 28-29) and Indians (July 30-August 2)...Twins are seeking their 500th win over the White Sox today (since 1961).

ROAD OPENER WIN!: Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 10-5, their largest margin of victory in a road opener since an 11-4 win over Texas on April 8, 1975...Jose Berrios was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the bullpen of Trevor May (W), Tyler Clippard, Tyler Duffey and Cody Stashak combined for 5.0 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits, two by Max Kepler (2 HR), Jorge Polanco, Nelson Cruz, Jake Cave and Luis Arraez...five players with multi-hit games marked the most in a Twins Opening Day (since 1961) since 1999 (6).

MAX OUT: Last night, Max Kepler became the eighth player in baseball history to hit at least two home runs on Opening Day while batting first:

NOTE: Prior to Kepler, only two other players in the last 20 years have hit a leadoff home run on the first pitch of the season: Kaz Matsui of the Mets in 2004, and Ian Happ of the Cubs in 2018. Credit Elias. NOTE: Prior to Kepler, the last player to homer in his first two at bats of a season was Philadelphia's Daniel Nava in 2017.

MARK ONE FOR THE ROAD: Last night the Twins won a road opener for the first time since 2003, snapping a nine-game road-opener losing streak...below are the lineup comparisons between their previous road-opener win and last night (Radke was winner in 2003):

INDIVIDUALS VS. LHP IN 2019: Nelson Cruz hit .322 (37-for-115) with 16 home runs and a .424 OBP...Mitch Garver hit .321 (34-for-106) with 12 home runs and a .434 OBP...Byron Buxton hit .317 (20-for-63) with a .368 OBP...Marwin Gonzalez hit .300 (36-for-120)...Max Kepler hit .293 (43-for-147) with a .356 OBP...Kepler's average ranked third in the AL among left-handed batters, trailing Kevin Kiermaier (.311) and Yordan Alvarez (.307).

A LOOK AT THE ROSTER: The Twins open the 2020 season with 16 players on their 30-man roster who were not on the 2019 Opening Day roster: pitchers (11) - Homer Bailey, Tyler Clippard, Randy Dobnak, Rich Hill, Zack Littell, Kenta Maeda, Sergio Romo, Devin Smeltzer, Cody Stashak, Lewis Thorpe and Matt Wisler; catcher (1) - Alex Avila; infielders (2) - Luis Arraez and Josh Donaldson; and outfielders (2) - LaMonte Wade, Jr. and Aaron Whitefield...of the 30 players on the Twins active roster, 15 began their professional careers in the Twins organization...Whitefield is the only Twin looking to make his major league debut.

THE BRINGER: Josh Donaldson signed a four-year contract on January 22...was one of seven players to draw 100 or more walks in 2019...named 2019 National League Comeback Player of the Year...his 68 defensive runs saved from 2012-19 were third most among MLB third basemen in that span, behind Nolan Arenado (117) and Manny Machado (89)...also since 2013 ranks second in the majors in Wins Above Replacement to Mike Trout, according to both Fangraphs (Donaldson-40.6, Trout-62.7) and Baseball Reference (Donaldson-43.6, Trout-61.5)...he also ranks among the MLB leaders in that span in walks (7th, 543), home runs (209, 10th), runs scored (617, 10th), RBI (608, 11th), extra-base hits (430, 11th), slugging pct. (.519, 11th) and OPS (.895, 13th).
