ROAD OPENER WIN!: Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 10-5, their largest margin of victory in a road opener since an 11-4 win over Texas on April 8, 1975José Berríos was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.0.

was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the bullpen of Trevor May (W), Tyler Clippard, Tyler Duffey and Cody Stashak combined for 5.0 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits, two by Max Kepler (2 HR), Jorge Polanco, Nelson Cruz, Jake Cave and Luis Arraez...five players with multi-hit games marked the most in a Twins Opening Day (since 1961) since 1999 (6).

A LOOK AT THE ROSTER: The Twins open the 2020 season with 16 players on their 30-man roster who were not on the 2019 Opening Day roster: pitchers (11) - Homer Bailey, Tyler Clippard, Randy Dobnak, Rich Hill, Zack Littell, Kenta Maeda, Sergio Romo, Devin Smeltzer, Cody Stashak, Lewis Thorpe and Matt Wisler; catcher (1) - Alex Avila; infielders (2) - Luis Arraez and Josh Donaldson; and outfielders (2) - LaMonte Wade, Jr. and Aaron Whitefield...of the 30 players on the Twins active roster, 15 began their professional careers in the Twins organization...Whitefield is the only Twin looking to make his major league debut.

THE BRINGER: Josh Donaldson signed a four-year contract on January 22...was one of seven players to draw 100 or more walks in 2019... named 2019 National League Comeback Player of the Year...his 68 defensive runs saved from 2012-19 were third most among MLB third basemen in that span, behind Nolan Arenado (117) and Manny Machado (89)...also since 2013 ranks second in the majors in Wins Above Replacement to Mike Trout, according to both Fangraphs (Donaldson-40.6, Trout-62.7) and Baseball Reference (Donaldson-43.6, Trout-61.5)...he also ranks among the MLB leaders in that span in walks (7th, 543), home runs (209, 10th), runs scored (617, 10th), RBI (608, 11th), extra-base hits (430, 11th), slugging pct. (.519, 11th) and OPS (.895, 13th).

DOBNAK MAKES SEASON DEBUT AFTER WHIRLWIND YEAR: 2019 was a great year to be Randy Dobnak. the 25-year-old rookie started the season at Single-A Ft. Myers, and made his final appearance of the year on the mound against the New York Yankees in Game 2 of the American League Division Series...became just the fourth rookie in Twins history (sixth instance) to start a Postseason game and 18th ever to pitch in one...traversed four levels of the Twins' player development system, with stints in Ft. Myers, Double-A Pensacola, Triple-A Rochester and culminating in his major league debut on August 9 vs. Cleveland...earned the Jim Rantz Award for Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year after combining to go 12-4 with a 2.07 ERA (135.0 IP, 31 ER) in 24 games (21 starts) across three levels...named starting pitcher on Twins MiLB.com organization All-Star team.

Began his career with 9.0 scoreless innings before allowing two runs in a start September 8 vs. Cleveland...pitched 6.0 innings with just one hit allowed Sept. 25 at Detroit, becoming the second rookie in Twins/Senators history to throw at least 6.0 innings and allow no more than one batter to

reach safely via hit, walk or hit-by-pitch...Twins win, plus Cleveland loss, clinched the division title. With the blessing of manager Rocco Baldelli, who gave him permission to leave the team to attend his own wedding, Dobnak also married his wife, Aerial, on Sept. 28...Twins defeated the Royals that day, 4-3, in celebration.

CENTRAL FOCUS: Dobnak has faced the White Sox just once before in his young career, notching his first save in just his second career appearance last August 28...worked the final 3.0 innings of a 10-5 Twins win over Chicago here at Guaranteed Rate Field, allowing five hits and two unearned runs.

 Of his nine career appearances, seven have come against the teams of the AL Central, including four of his five career starts.
 He's 2-1 with a 1.37 ERA (26.1 IP, 4 ER) lifetime against the AL Central...this includes 2-1 with a 1.96 ERA (18.1 IP, 2 ER) in four starts...has never allowed an earned run in relief against the AL Central, working 8.0 innings and yielding 13 hits, two unearned runs, no walks and six strikeouts.

ROAD WARRIOR: Dobnak's miniscule career ERA shrinks even further away from Target Field, as he's 1-0 with one save, a 0.56 ERA (16.0 IP, 1 ER), two walks and 13 strikeouts in five appearances (three starts) on the road...holding opponents to a .222 (14-for-63) batting average in their home parks, and also has a 6.50 strikeout-to-walk ratio on the road.

NO EXTRAS: Just four of the 27 hits Dobnak has allowed in his career have gone for extra bases (1 HR, 3 2B)...opponents are batting just .193 (11-for-57) against him with runners on base, and just .107 (3-for-28) with runners in scoring position.

◆ Opponents have also struggled mightily against him with runners in scoring position on the road, as he's holding them to a .125 (2-for-16) batting average in scoring situations.
