**THE TWINS:** The Twins are 1-1 through the first two games of the 60th season in Minnesota history...the club will wrap up the first series of the new campaign today on the South Side... following today's series finale, the Twins will travel home and enjoy an off-day in Minneapolis tomorrow, followed by a six-game homestand vs. the Cardinals (July 28-29) and Indians (July 30-August 2)...Twins are seeking their 500th win over the White Sox today (since 1961).  
 ☞ Original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in the finale of four games at Chicago-AL today.

**RECAP:** Twins received their first setback of the 2020 campaign, falling to the White Sox 10-3 yesterday afternoon and setting the stage for today's rubber game...Randy Dobnak took the loss despite yielding just one run on three hits in 4.0 innings (3 K, 2 BB) in his season debut...Nelson Cruz drove in all three Twins runs with one swing, a three-run homer in the sixth...Mitch Garver continued his success vs. LHS, going 2-for-3 against Dallas Keuchel.  
 ☞ Friday night's 10-5 win and yesterday's 10-3 loss mark the first time in Twins history and second time in Twins/Senators history the club scored 10+ runs then allowed 10+ runs in the first two games of the season...the 1955 Senators began the campaign with a 12-5 win over Baltimore on April 11 and then fell to New York-AL, 19-1, on April 13.

**BRING ON THE BIRDS:** After tomorrow's home off-day, Twins will take the field at Target Field in a two-game Interleague series against the St. Louis Cardinals...clubs will face off again in St. Louis September 8-9...all-time Interleague series is tied 13-13 since 1997...Twins hold a 4-3 advantage in Postseason play (1987 World Series)...Cardinals won both spring training matchups in Florida in March...the last time the two clubs played in the regular season was 2018, with the Twins winning the season series 4-1 and outscoring the Cardinals 22-9.

**BEGINNING, MIDDLE, END:** Last season, the Twins went 36-16 in series openers but just 6-11 in rubber games and 26-27 in series finales...however, the Twins are 6-5 in their last 11 series finales, dating back to last August 25 vs. Detroit (7-4 W).

☞ **Twins are 29-18-8 all-time in season-opening series of two-or-more games, including a 13-5-4 record at home and 16-13-4 record on the road.**  
 ☞ Twins have won a season-opening series of two-or-more games each of the last three seasons overall, but have lost five of the last six such series on the road (won in '18, lost in '16, '15, '14, '12 and '11...the club opened at home in '19, '17 and '13).

**NEW DECADE, SAME NELLY:** Nelson Cruz hit his first homer of the year yesterday, a three-run shot in the sixth inning that accounted for all of the Twins' runs...marked his 402nd career homer...at 40 years, 20 days old Cruz became the oldest player to homer in an MLB game since Ichiro Suzuki on August 22, 2017 for the Marlins at age 43 (credit Sarah Langs).

☞ Cruz became the fifth different player age 40-or-older to homer in a Twins uniform and the first since Torii Hunter on September 24, 2015 at age 40 and 68 days...the others are Baseball Hall of Famers Dave Winfield, Paul Molitor and Jim Thome.  
 ☞ Cruz and Winfield are the only two hitters 40-or-older in Twins/Senators history to homer within the first two games of the season...Winfield homered on Opening Day 1993-94.  
 ☞ In 18 games vs. Chicago-AL as a Twin, Cruz is batting .426 (29-for-68) with five doubles, nine home runs, 27 RBI and a 1.410 OPS...he's also 9-for-11 (.818) in scoring situations.

**15 IS THE NEW 40:** A 162-game season is defined by certain statistical plateaus to strive for, such as 40 home runs for hitters and 20 wins for pitchers...some numerical equivalences for a 60-game season include [162-game value (60-game value)]: 5 (2), 10 (4), 20 (7), 30 (11), 40 (15), 50 (19), 75 (28), 100 (37), 150 (56), 150 IP (55.1 IP), 160 IP (59.1 IP).

**WELCOME, WHITEFIELD:** Aaron Whitefield made his major league debut yesterday, entering the game as a pinch runner for Eddie Rosario in the ninth inning...the 23-year-old Brisbane native became the 35th Australian to play in the majors, debuting in the same ballpark where teammate Lewis Thorpe (the 34th Australian in MLB) made his first big league appearance last season...nine of the 35 Aussies (25.7%) to play in the majors have made their debut for the Twins, the most of any major league team.

**A LOOK AT THE ROSTER:** The Twins open the 2020 season with 16 players on their 30-man roster who were not on the 2019 Opening Day roster: pitchers (11) - Homer Bailey, Tyler Clippard, Randy Dobnak, Rich Hill, Zack Littell, Kenta Maeda, Sergio Romo, Devin Smeltzer, Cody Stashak, Lewis Thorpe and Matt Wisler; catcher (1) - Alex Avila; infielders (2) - Luis Arraez and Josh Donaldson; and outfielders (2) - LaMonte Wade, Jr. and Aaron Whitefield...of the 30 players on the Twins active roster, 15 began their professional careers in the Twins organization.

**CUDDYER, HALL OF FAMER:** The Single-A Florida State League recently announced its 2020 Hall of Fame class, including Twins Hall of Famer Michael Cuddyer on the list of inductees...selected by the Twins in the first round of the 1997 draft out of Great Bridge High School (VA), Cuddy spent the 1999 season with Ft. Myers, batting .298 (139-for-466) with 24 doubles, four triples, 16 home runs, 82 RBI and 87 runs scored in 130 games...led the team in runs scored and RBI, while sharing the lead in hits and ranking second in home runs and stolen bases (14)...also ranked fifth among all Twins minor leaguers in runs scored, tied for fifth in hits and seventh in RBI...Cuddyer will be enshrined into the FSL Hall of Fame alongside Baseball Hall of Famers Mariano Rivera and John Smoltz, current Los Angeles-NL Manager Dave Roberts, former Philadelphia infielder Chase Utley, New York-NL Senior Pitching Advisor Phil Regan, umpire Tim McClelland and executives Paul Taglieri of the Mariners and Trevor Gooby of the Mets.

**WELCOME TO THE CLUB:** Maeda was acquired in a trade with Los Angeles-NL on February 10, along with minor league catcher Jair Camargo and cash, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Brusdar Graterol, minor league outfielder Luke Raley and a Competitive Balance B pick in the 2020 MLB First-Year Player Draft...with the draft selection, the Dodgers chose right-handed pitcher Clayton Beeter out of Texas Tech University...previously, the Twins and Dodgers exchanged pleasantries at the trade deadline in 2018 when the Twins sent infielder Brian Dozier to Los Angeles, and in return received Raley, infielder Logan Forsythe and left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer.

**SUMMER CAMP RECAP:** In his first semi-formal game action in Minnesota, Maeda tossed 5.0 innings in game simulation scrimmages during summer camp...in those frames, he allowed five runs on seven hits, two walks and a team-leading 11 strikeouts...had a 7.20 ERA alongside a 1.80 WHIP against his own squad...earlier in the year, in spring training, the 32-year-old pitched 8.2 innings, yielding two earned runs on six hits, three walks and 10 strikeouts...held opposing batters to a .188 average, and only needed 69 pitches to navigate his 8.2 innings

**PLATOON STRATEGY:** By the numbers in 2019, Maeda attacks right-handed and left-handed batters in very different ways...when facing righties, he overwhelmingly favors sliders to retire his opposition, as 72 (69%) of his same-side strikeouts came on the pitch...conversely, when attacking left-handers, Maeda's changeup has proved effective, with 41 left-handed strikeouts (63 percent) on the change of pace...right-handers hit .165 (28-for-189) against his slider, and left-handers batted .174 (25-for-144) against the changeup.

**POSTSEASON PROWESS:** Maeda has pitched in the Postseason each year since his MLB debut. Here's how he's fared in October:

- ☞ 2019: Made four scoreless relief appearances for Los Angeles-NL in the NLDS, allowing one hit and striking out seven batters in 4.2 innings.
- ☞ 2018: Posted a 4.05 ERA (6.2 IP, 3 ER) in eight relief outings for the Dodgers...struck out 10 batters, including five in 2.0 innings of relief in Game 3 of the World Series vs. Boston.
- ☞ 2017: Went 2-0 with a 0.84 ERA (10.2 IP, 1 ER) in nine relief appearances across three rounds of Postseason play.
- ☞ 2016: Started thrice for Los Angeles-NL in the NLDS and NLCS, posting a 6.75 ERA (10.2 IP, 8 ER), with seven walks and 12 strikeouts.

- Will become the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- 9.79 career K/9.0 IP ratio is fourth among Japanese-born pitchers in MLB history (min. 100.0 IP), and his .227 career opponent batting average is sixth.
