TWINS COUNTING CARDS: Twins opened their 11th season at Target Field last night with a 6-3 victory over the Cardinals, scoring five runs in the second inning...Homer Bailey made his Twins debut, earning the win, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by homers from Jorge Polanco (1) and Josh Donaldson (1).

BETTER WITH AGE: Tonight's starter Rich Hill and DH Nelson Cruz gave the Twins their first pair of 40 year-olds on an Opening Day roster...it is the first time since 2004 that Twins have two 40-year-olds on their roster at the same time...below is the Twins/Senators franchise list of 40-year-olds to play for the team in the same season:

RAIN OVER TARGET FIELD: Josh Donaldson went 2-for-3 with a home run and two RBI last night and is now hitting .384 (33-for-86) with seven doubles, 11 home runs, 23 RBI, 13 walks, a .465 on-base percentage, a .849 slugging percentage and a 1.314 OPS in 23 career games at Target Field...below are Target Field all-time ranks among players with at least 100 plate appearances:

SANÓ KNOWS THE NL: Miguel Sanó has reached base safely in each of his last 26 starts in IL Play, hitting .296 (29-for-98) with nine doubles, six home runs, 17 RBI, 16 walks, a .400 on-base percentage and a .971 OPS in that span...below are the longest IL on-base streaks in club history in which a player starts a game:

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Twins went 8-12 in Interleague Play last season, going 1-2 at Philadelphia, 1-3 vs. New York, 2-2 vs. Milwaukee, 2-1 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Atlanta and 1-2 vs. Washington...this season and the next, they play the NL Central in Interleague...they have had just one winning season against the NL since 2010, that coming in 2017 (13-7).

From 1997 (IL Play's inception) to 2009, the Twins went 132-96 in IL Play, second to only the Yankees (133-95) in wins during that span...since then they have gone 88-107, tied for 24th most IL wins in baseball in that span.

Mitch Garver hit .333 (17-for-51) with a 1.260 OPS in 14 IL games last season...Garver's nine IL home runs last season tied him with Nolan Arenado for most in baseball...the nine home runs tied him with Trevor Plouffe (2012) for most single-season IL home runs in club history.

Josh Donaldson is a career .307 hitter (55-for-179) with a .857 OPS in 51 career IL games.

Josh Donaldson is hitting .312 (144-for-461) with 25 doubles, 29 home runs, 93 RBI and a .963 OPS in his last 122 Interleague games, dating back to 2012...in that span his 29 home runs are tied with St. Louis' Matt Carpenter for eighth most in baseball...he enters tonight with a seven-game IL hitting streak.

The Twins have homered in a major league record 24 straight IL games, dating back to July 4, 2018, hitting 44 in that span.

TWINS AND CARDS: Twins and Cardinals are playing each other for the second of four this season...Twins are 6-1 in their last seven vs. STL...these two will face off again in St. Louis September 8-9...Twins are 14-13 all-time vs. St. Louis in Interleague Play...Twins hold a 4-3 advantage in Postseason play (1987 World Series)...Cardinals won both spring training matchups in Florida in March...prior to 2020, the last time the two clubs played in the regular season was 2018, with the Twins winning the season series 4-1 and outscoring the Cardinals 22-9.

SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins recorded 11 sweeps last season, one in four games, eight times in three games and twice in two games... their last sweep of a National League opponent was Pittsburgh in two games August 14-15, 2018 at Target Field...they last swept St. Louis in two games May 7-8, 2018 at Busch Stadium.

INNINGS BREAKDOWN: Twins have had the lead this season in 24 of their 36 innings played...they have scored multiple runs in eight different innings this season...last season they scored multiple runs 258 times...they scored five-plus runs 25 times last season; they have twice already in 2020.

ON THIS DAY IN 2018: Former Twins Jim Thome and Jack Morris were inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame...Morris, the St. Paul native, played one season for the Twins in 1991, going 18-12, 3.43 ERA (246.2 IP, 94 ER), including a World Series record that Fall of 2-0, 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP, 3 ER) in three starts against Atlanta earning World Series MVP honors...he pitched a Game 7 complete game 10-inning shutout with seven hits allowed, two walks and eight strikeouts opposite Hall of Famer John Smoltz...Thome, who played parts of two seasons with the Twins from 2010-11, hit 37 home runs in 179 games in a Twins uniform, including his 600th and 601st homers at Comerica Park on August 15, 2011, off Rick Porcello and Daniel Schlereth.

RICH READY TO ROCK AND ROLL: Hill signed a one-year contract with the Twins on December 31, 2019, the same day the Twins signed last night's starter Homer Bailey...entered 2020 recovering from elbow surgery last October...was originally expected to be ready by mid-year, but the season's pause due to the COVID-19 pandemic enabled him to complete his recovery in time for the start of the regular season...last pitched for an American League team in the veteran enters his 16th major league season in 2020, as well as his 19th in professional baseball.

OVER THE HILL...OR NOT: At age 40 years, 140 days, Hill is the oldest pitcher in Twins history to make a start within the club's first five games of the season, as well as the oldest pitcher in Twins/Senators history to start within the team's first five games of the season since Connie Marrero (age 41.360) started the fourth game of the Senators' 1953 campaign...he's the oldest pitcher to start

of the Twins overall since Bartolo Colon (age 44 years, 130 days) on October 1, 2017.

Hill and Nelson Cruz became the first 40-year-olds to both make the Opening Day roster in Twins history, and are just the fourth pair of 40-year-olds to play for the Twins, joining Pat Borders and

Terry Mulholland in 2004, and Clark Griffith and Jack Ryan from 1912-13.

RICH'S PITCHES: The wiley veteran Hill threw seven different offerings to hitters last season, according to Baseball Savant...his four seamer and curve were his typical weapons of choice, throwing them 51.9 percent of the time and 41.4 percent, respectively...Hill also threw in 17 eephus pitches, 16 to righty batters and just one to a lefty...Hill's repertoire over the years has evolved with his pitching style and age, though Baseball Savant's pitch tracking ability only came into existence in the fourth season of Hill's career (2008)...early on in his career, he relied on his sinker more often, throwing it as much as 42.2 percent of the time in 2012...however, he threw the nitch just seven times in 2019. threw the pitch just seven times in 2019.

NL CENTRAL FOCUS: Hill began his career in the NL Central division with the Chicago Cubs, and will be making his 50th career appearance and 43rd start against the division tonight... is 18-7 lifetime with a 3.40 ERA (249.0 IP, 94 ER), 100 walks and 254 strikeouts...his 18 wins over the NL Central are his most against any division in his career, and his 42 starts are his

second most, behind 50 starts vs. the NL West.

Bill last faced the NL Central on June 14, 2019, earning the win over the Cubs at Dodger Stadium...worked 7.0 innings, allowing three runs and striking out seven batters while

HOLDING YOUR CARDS CLOSE: Despite beginning his long career in the NL Central, Hill has faced the Cardinals just eight times (seven starts)...however, he's had success vs. the Birds, going 3-1 with a 5.03 ERA (34.0 IP, 19 ER), with 25 walks, 27 strikeouts and a puny .181

CROSSING LEAGUE LINES: 2020 marks Hill's first stint in the American League since 2016. when he was the Oakland Athletics' Opening Day starter before he was traded to Los Ange-les-NL...began his career in the Senior Circuit, but has made more career appearances in the Juinor Circuit, appearing 151 times in an AL uniform compared to 133 times in an NL one.

PLAYOFF RICHES: Hill is 1-2 with a 3.06 ERA (53.0 IP. 18 ER) with 32 walks and 65 strikeouts in 13 career playoff appearances (12 starts)...started Game 4 of the 2019 NLDS for Los Angeles-NL against Washington, allowing one run on two hits in 2.2 innings...held batters to a .155/.310/.172 slash line in four games (three starts) in the Dodgers' run to the World Series in 2018...first pitched in the Postseason in 2007; his next appearance after that came nine years later, in 2016.
