THE TWINS: In their 60th season in Minnesota, the Twins have gone 4-1, taking two of three Field over the last two nights...tonight the Twins will continue their eight-game homestand with the first of four vs. Cleveland through Sunday, then two vs. Pittsburgh Monday-Tuesday.

© Original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in an off-day during the middle of eight-

game homestand against Los Angeles-NL, Houston and Cleveland.

KING OF THE HILL LEADS TWINS TO SWEEP: Twins beat the Cardinals last night by a score of 3-0, led by Rich Hill who earned his first win in his Twins debut, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed an a walk...the bullpen retired 11 of 12 batters faced and combined for seven strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, highlighted by an Eddie Rosario solo homer.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Twins starters have gone 3-0, 2.40 ERA (15.0 IP, 4 ER) with four walks, 12 strikeouts and a .185 opponent batting average in their last three outings...the games were started by Kenta Maeda (7/26 at CWS), Homer Bailey (7/28 vs. STL) and Rich Hill (7/29 vs. STL), all of whom were acquired in the off-season...in fact, according to Elias, the last time in the MLB that three pitchers all making their team debut, started and won their start all within the team's first five games of the season was the San Diego Padres in 1969 when Dick Selma, Johnny Podres, and Dick Kelley (04/08/1969 - 04/10/1969) all won the first three games of the season, which were the Padres first three games in franchise history...the only time the Twins franchise has done this was, too, their first season of existence: Washington Senators in 1901 - Bill Carrick, Win Mercer, and Watty Lee (04/26/1901 - 04/30/1901).

ADJUST YOUR TV: Tonight's game can be seen on FOX, one of two games carried by FOX this season, the other will be between these two teams again on September 12 at Target Field at 7:15 pm...broadcasters tonight will be Adam Admin and A.J. Pierzynski...additionally, FOX National will be using Virtual Fans tonight.

TWINS-TRIBE: Twins and Cleveland are playing each other tonight for the first of 10 times in

- 2020...seven of those games will be played at Target Field and three at Progressive Field...Twins will travel to Cleveland August 24-26 then the Tribe will come back to Minneapolis September 11-13.

 © Eddie Rosario is hitting .306 (97-for-317) with 15 doubles, four triples, 20 home runs, 42 RBI and a .907 OPS in 83 career games vs. the Tribe...the hits and home runs are all his personal most vs. any opponent...97 hits vs. the Tribe are the most in baseball since 2015.

 ◆ Josh Donaldson played just 16 games for Cleveland in 2018...he began that season with Toronto and was traded to the Tribe along with cash at the deadline, in exchange for a player to be named later (RHP Julian Merryweather)...was limited during time in Cleveland due to left calf strain...is a career .327 (51-for-156) hitter vs. the Tribe with seven doubles, 11 home runs, 40 RBI and a 1.038 OPS...is hitting .362 (21-for-58) with six homers and a 1.237 OPS in last 14 vs. CLE.

 ◆ Other notable individuals vs. Cleveland pitching: Luis Arraez is hitting .319 (15-for-47)... lake Cave is hitting .313 (15 for 48)
- Jake Cave is hitting .313 (15-for-48).

REVISITING RIVALRY: Last season the Twins went 50-26 vs. the AL Central, while the Tribe went 48-28...since 2015, the Tribe have a record of 232-151 inside the AL Central, while the Twins have the second-most wins at 199-184...last season the Twins went 9-10 head-to-head vs. the Tribe, going 4-6 at Target Field and 5-4 at Progressive...below was the AL Central race during the 2019 season:

BOMBAS FROM THE BEGINNING: Twins have hit 10 home runs on the season, tied with Chicago-AL for fourth most in baseball, trailing Cincinnati (12), Detroit (12) and Chicago-NL (11)...they have homered in all five games, already their third longest streak in club history to begin a season, their best being seven, done in both 1982 and 1987.

- Twins have a +16 run differential (36-20), the best in the AL and second best in baseball, trailing only Los Angeles-NL (+17, 31-14).

 ▼ Twins are the only team in baseball yet to commit an error (174 total chances).

 ▼ Twins have held a lead in 33 of their 44 innings played this season...additionally, Minnesota hasn't trailed in a game for 27 consecutive innings, dating back to Sunday's 14-2 victory over Chicago-AL.

 ▼ Nelson Cruz leads baseball with 11 RBI, three ahead of the next players, Nick Castellanos and Dansby Swanson, each with eight.
- The 'pen has allowed one run on six hits in 12.0 innings since Sunday (3 games)...they have a 12.0 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP in that span.

LAST START: Made second career Opening Day start July 30 at Chicago-AL opposite Lucas Giolito... allowed five runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings pitched but was supported with seven runs in an eventual 10-5 victory...entered the second inning with a 5-1 lead but allowed a three-run homer to Yoan Moncada which tied the game at 5-5...Twins scored two more in the fourth before he was relieved by Trevor May inn the fifth...threw 75 pitches, 52 strikes.

BERRÍOS VS. CLEVELAND: Perhaps Berríos' most noteworthy start against Cleveland took place on Opening Day in 2019, as dissected in the following note, but the 26-year-old has made an impact against the Tribe on multiple occasions in his career...in seven starts against Cleveland since 2018, Berríos is 3-0 with a 3.24 ERA (41.2 IP, 15 ER) and 43 strikeouts...four of those seven appearances were quality starts, and he's held Indians hitters to a .183 batting average

AN EVENTFUL 2019: After an All-Star-caliber 2019 campaign, Berríos looks to build off of a memorable season:

- ₱ Last season, squared off against then-Cleveland starter Corey Kluber at Target Field on Opening Day, blanking the Indians through 7.2 innings...ceded to left-hander Taylor Rogers, who recorded a save in the Twins' first of 101 victories.

 ◆ In 2019, Berríos pitched in his second-consecutive All-Star Game, retiring his brother-in-law,
- Chicago-NL's Javier Báez, to end a scoreless third inning.

 ◆ Berríos made his final 2019 start in the Postseason, taking to the hill for Game 1 of the
- ALDS against New York-AL...allowed three runs (1 ER) and four hits in 4.0 innings, striking out six and walking three.

TURNING THE CORNER: Berríos finished his 2019 campaign with a 3.68 ERA, and saw an uptick in performance in a myriad of different pitching categories between 2017-18 and 2019.
