THE TWINS: The Twins have begun their first homestand of 2020 with a record of 3-1, going 2-0 vs. St. Louis before splitting with Cleveland over the last two nights...tonight they will play the third of four with Cleveland...they will wrap this series tomorrow afternoon then welcome Derek Shelton and the Pittsburgh Pirates in for two games on Monday and Tuesday.
 ☞ The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in the second of three vs. Houston in the middle of a eight-game homestand.

RANDY DOBINATES: Twins beat the Indians and Mike Clevinger last night by a score of 4-1, evening the four-game series at 1-1...Randy Dobnak (1-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with just three hits allowed, two walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, highlighted by home runs by Max Kepler and Alex Avila...Kepler led off the game with a home run, his second leadoff homer of the season and eighth of his career, passing Shannon Stewart (7) and moving into sole possession of fifth on the club's all-time list.

TWINS-TRIBE: Twins and Cleveland are playing each other tonight for the third of 10 times in 2020...after tonight four more games will be played at Target Field and three at Progressive Field...Twins will travel to Cleveland for three August 24-26 then the Tribe will come back to Minneapolis for three September 11-13.

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .306 (99-for-324) with 16 doubles, four triples, 20 home runs, 44 RBI and a .903 OPS in 85 career games vs. the Tribe...the hits and home runs are both his personal most vs. any opponent...99 hits vs. the Indians are the most in baseball since 2015.

COOKIE MONSTERS: Individual career numbers vs. Carlos Carrasco: Jorge Polanco is 9-for-19 (.474) with a double and two walks...Josh Donaldson is 4-for-9 (.444) with a double, two home runs and three RBI...Nelson Cruz is 10-for-27 (.370) with four home runs, three doubles and eight RBI...Alex Avila is 7-for-22 (.318) with one double, one home run and six walks...Eddie Rosario is 9-for-29 (.310) with two doubles, one home run and four walks.

KEPLER CRUSHES CLEVELAND: Last night, Max Kepler hit his 15th career home run off Cleveland pitching...Kepler has three multi-homer games off Cleveland, including two three-run home run games on August 1, 2016 and June 6, 2019, both at Progressive Field...15 home runs are his personal most vs. any opponent...he has hit 16% of his career homers off the Indians (15 of 95).

FAST STARTS: The Twins have scored 12 runs in both the first inning and second inning this season, accounting for 60% of their runs on the season (24 of 40)...they lead baseball in runs scored in both individual innings...last season, they ranked eighth in baseball in first inning runs (107) and second in second inning runs (113).

☞ Twins are 5-0 when scoring first...they were 78-23 when scoring first in 2019.

BOMBA SQUAD, 2020 VISION: Twins have homered in six of seven games this season (shutout Thursday vs. Bieber)...they have hit 12 bombas this season, tied for second most in baseball with four other teams, the MLB leader being Ron Gardenhire's Tigers with 15 bombas.

'PEN PALS: Twins bullpen has allowed a 3.41 ERA (29.0 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks, 36 strikeouts, an opponent batting average of .234 and 11.2 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched...aside from their outing on Saturday, July 25 at Chicago-AL in which the 'pen allowed nine runs on 11 hits and five home runs in 4.0 innings pitched, they have allowed two runs on 14 hits in 25.0 innings with 28 strikeouts.

ROGER THAT: Taylor Rogers has appeared in two games this season, saving both on 16 pitches (13 strikes) while facing a total of just six batters...since becoming the Twins primary closer at the start of June 2019, he has saved 28 games in 32 opportunities, leading baseball in saves in that span.

FOR STARTERS: Twins starting pitchers have gone 4-2, 3.27 ERA (33.0 IP, 12 ER) with four home runs allowed, 11 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .213 opponent batting average...since José Berrios allowed five runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings to the White Sox on Opening Day, they have combined to post a 2.17 ERA (29.0 IP, 7 ER) with a .183 opponent batting average.

- Became the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Mischeal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
• Entering 2020, 9.79 career K/9.0 IP ratio was fourth among Japanese-born pitchers in MLB history (min. 100.0 IP), and .227 career opponent batting average was sixth.
• Recorded his first career save in his first career relief appearance on June 9, 2017 (4.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 6 K).
• 16 wins in 2016 were the second most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
• In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
• Named to the 2016 Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
• Pitched six scoreless innings in his major-league debut, also hitting a solo home run in his second-career at-bat.

Struck out season-high 12 batters on May 15 vs. San Diego, keeping the Padres scoreless through 6.2 innings before garnering the win.

SUNDAY'S STARTER - HOMER BAILEY, RHP [SEASON: 1-0, 3.60 ERA + CAREER: 81-86, 4.56 ERA]

Right-hander Homer Bailey is scheduled to start the game on the mound for Minnesota tomorrow. He's coming off his first career win as a Twin, after he maneuvered 5.0 innings on July 28 vs. St. Louis, allowed two earned runs on four strikeouts and two walks...along with newcomers Maeda and Rich Hill, combined to become the first trio of Minnesota pitchers to make their team debut, start and win within the first five games of the season, and second such group in franchise history (Bill Carrick, Win Mercer and Watty Lee between April 26-30 for the 1901 Washington Senators). Bailey has made 11 starts against Cleveland in his career, going 4-4 with a 4.91 ERA (58.2 IP, 33 ER), along with 47 strikeouts and 27 walks.
