TWINS-TRIBE: Twins and Cleveland are playing each other tonight for the third of 10 times in 2020...after tonight four more games will be played at Target field and three at Progressive Field...Iwins will travel to Cleveland for three August 24-26 then the Tribe will come back to Minneapolis for three September 11-13.
क Eddie Rosario is hitting 306 (99-for-324) with 16 doubles, four triples, 20 home runs, 44 RBI and a . 903 OPS in 85 career games vs. the Tribe...the hits and home runs are both his personal most vs. any opponent... 99 hits vs. the Indians are the most in baseball since 2015.
COOKIE MONSTERS: Individual career numbers vs. Carlos Carrasco: Jorge Polanco is 9-for-19 (.474) with a double and two walks...Josh Donaldson is 4 -for-9 (.444) with a double, two home runs and three RBI...Nelson Cruz is 10-for-27 (.370) with four home runs, three doubles and ight RBI...Alex Avia Rosario is 9 -for-29 (.310) with two doubles, one home run and four walks.

KEPLER CRUSHES CLEVELAND: Last night, Max Kepler hit his 15th career home run off Cleveland pitching...Kepler has three multi-homer games off Cleveland, including two three-run home run games on August 1, 2016 and June 6, 2019, both at Progressive Field... 15 home runs are his personal most vs, any opponent he has hit $16 \%$ of his career homers off the Indians (1500 95).

FAST STARTS: The Twins have scored 12 runs in both the first inning and second inning this season, accounting for $60 \%$ of their runs on the season (24 of 40)...they lead baseball in runs scored in both individual innings...last season, they ranked eighth in baseball in first inning runs (107) and second in second inning runs (113).
$\mp$ Twins are 5-0 when scoring first...they were 78-23 when scoring first in 2019.
BOMBA SQUAD, 2020 VISION: Twins have homered in six of seven games this season (shutout Thursday vs. Bieber)...they have hit 12 bombas this season, tied for second most in baseball with four other teams, the MLB leader being Ron Gardenhire's Tigers with 15 bombas.
'PEN PALS: Twins bullpen has allowed a 3.41 ERA ( 29.0 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks, 36 strikeouts, an opponent batting average of . 234 and 11.2 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched...aside from their outing on Saturday, July 25 at Chicago-AL in which the 'pen allowed nine runs on 11 hits and five home runs in 4.0 innings pitched, they have allowed two runs on 14 hits in 25.0 innings with 28 strikeouts.

ROGER THAT: Taylor Rogers has appeared in two games this season, saving both on 16 pitches ( 13 strikes) while facing a total of just six batters...since becoming the twins primary closer at the start of June 2019, he has saved 28 games in 32 opportunities, leading baseball in saves in that span.

FOR STARTERS: Twins starting pitchers have gone 4-2, 3.27 ERA ( 33.0 IP, 12 ER) with four home runs allowed, 11 walks, 26 strikeouts and a . 213 opponent batting average....since José Berríos allowed five runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings to the White Sox on Opening Day, they have combined to post a 2.17 ERA (29.0 IP, 7 ER) with a .183 opponent batting average.

LAST TIME OUT: Six days ago, on July 26, Maeda made his Twins debut at Chicago-AL, dueling Reynaldo López...in his first start for an American League club, Maeda pitched 5.0 innings and allowed just two runs...runs came via the bat of rookie outtielder and top prospect Luis Robert in the fifth inning, when he launched a two-run homer over the centerfield wall on a hanging changeup...rifling off the bat at 111.4 MPH, Robert's home run remains the hardest-hit ball by an MLB rookie this season.... Maeda struck out six and walked one...despite the lone blemish on his outing, the Twins routed the South Siders, 14-2.

MAEDA VS. THE AL CENTRAL: Albeit in a limited capacity, after his first-career start today vs. Cleveland, Maeda will have faced every AL Central club, including the Twins....made lone start against Minnesota on July 25,2017 , at Dodger Stadium...opposite José Berríos, Maeda threw 5.0 innings, allowing just one earned run on a Zack Granite single in the third inning...struck out five, walked two and secured his ninth win of the season...in total against the AL Central, Maeda owns a 4-1 record with a 3.12 ERA ( $26.0 \mathrm{IP}, 9 \mathrm{ER}$ ), along with 25 strikeouts and six walks.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: Maeda was acquired in a trade with Los Angeles-NL on February 10 , along with minor league catcher Jair Camargo and cash, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Brusdar Graterol, minor league outfielder Luke Raley and a Competitive Balance B pick in the 2020 MLB FirstYear Player Draft...with the draft selection, the Dodgers chose right-handed pitcher Clayton Beeter out of Texas Tech University...previously, the Twins and Dodgers exchanged pleasantries at the trade deadline in 2018 when the Twins sent infielder Brian Dozier to Los Angeles, and in return received Raley, infielder Logan Forsythe and left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer.
