<b>THE TWINS:</b> The Twins have gone 1-4 through five games on their current eight-game roadtrip,
going 1-1 at Pittsburgh and 0-3 at Kansas Citytonight they will begin a three-game series
with the Brewers through Wednesdayafter tonight's game with the Brewers, the Twins will
return home for a four-game series vs. Kansas City (August 14-17) and another three-game
series vs. Milwaukee (August 18-20).

The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in the middle of an eight-game roadtrip with the first of four in Boston

**ROYAL PAINS:** The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 4-2, suffering their first sweep of the season and first since July 16-17, 2019 vs. New York-NL in two games...it marked their first time being swept in three games since September 3-5, 2018 at Houston (82 series ago)...José Berríos (1-2) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on eight hits in 5.1 innings pitched...he earned his 600th career strikeout, fanning Maikel Franco in the second inning...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Nelson Cruz - his fifth multi-hit game in 2020.

TWINS LOOK TO AVOID FIVE STRAIGHT L's: After starting the season 10-2, the Twins have now lost four straight for the first time since dropping four straight from August 6-9, 2019... they are looking to avoid losing five straight for the first time since September 1-5, 2018 (also 5)...below is a look inside their first 12 compared to their last four:

**HAPPY HANDLEBAR 'STACHE DAY:** Tonight's starter, Randy Dobnak, has a 0.60 ERA (15.0 IP, 1 ER) in his first three starts...according to *Elias*, it marks the lowest ERA in a pitcher's first three starts of a season, among Twins, since the Twins moved to Minnesota in 1961 (min. 15 IP):

WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE: The Twins are 5-1 this season in Interleague Play, sweeping the Cardinals in two July 28-29, sweeping the Pirates at Target Field last Monday-Tuesday, then splitting at PNC Park Wednesday-Thursday...they have had just one winning season against the NL since 2010, that coming in 2017 (13-7).

♣ Remaining IL schedule (14 games): three at Milwaukee this week...home for three vs. Milwaukee August 18-20...two at St. Louis September 8-9...three at Wrigley Field September 18-20...three at home vs. Cincinnati September 25-27.

♣ From 1997 (IL Play's inception) to 2009, the Twins went 132-96 in IL Play, second to only the Yankees (133-95) in wins during that span...since then they have gone 92-108, tied for 20th most IL wins in baseball in that span.

CRUZ AND THE BREWS: Nelson Cruz is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBI and four walks in eight career games vs. Milwaukee, hitting safely in each of his last six games vs. the 'Crew (dating back to 2014)...Cruz began his major league career with Milwaukee in 2005, appearing in eight games for the Brewers, hitting .200 (1-for-8)...that 2005 season, he was named the Brewers Robin Yount Performance Award winner for minor league Player of the Year... traded away by the Brewers to Texas on July 26, 2006...others involved in that trade, Milwaukee acquired Carlos Lee and Texas acquired Julian Cordero, Francisco Cordero, Kevin Mench and Laynce Nix.

© Cruz is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with three home runs. 10 RBI and a .943 OPS in his last 11 IL games...among actives, he ranks fourth in homers, tied for third in RBI and 11th in OPS.

BATTLE OF 1-94: The Twins are 231-224 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and have a record against them of 65-55 in Interleague Play...last season, they went 2-2 vs. the Brewers, going 1-1 at Target Field from May 27-28 and 1-1 in Milwaukee from August 13-14...the Brewers moved from the AL to the NL to start the 1998 season...below are some differences vs. the Twins when the 'Crew was an AL team vs. being an NL team:

\$\Phi\$ AL (1969-1997, including one year as the Seattle Pilots): 365 G, 185-180, .507, 1699-1623 RS/RA...Twins' .278 batting average against the Brewers/Pilots from 1969-1997 was second only to a .281 average against the Mariners (1977-1997) in that span, not including Interleague play in 1997.

additist the Dieweis/Hous Holin 1303-1337 was second only to a .201 average against the manners (1577 1507) in the capacity in the league play in 1997.

NL (1998-2019): 108 G, 58-50, 537, 557-520 RS/RA...Twins' .344 on-base percentage against the Brewers from 1997-now is the club's fourth highest against any single opponent in that span and the team's .786 OPS is the third highest against any single opponent in that span (min 20 G)...557 runs scored over the Brewers are Twins' most against any National League foe in that span as well

that span as well.

ALSO, DID YOU KNOW?: Twins radio stud Cory Provus - broadcasting from his perch at Target Field - spent three seasons from 2009-11 with Brewers, doing play-by-play with Hall of Famer Bob Uecker on WTMJ-AL and the Brewers Radio Network.

WHAT'S SO DIFFERENT: Twins enter tonight with a +23 run differential (78-55)...they are tied for the AL lead in run differential with Oakland (71-48)...only three teams have a higher mark - all in the National League: Los Angeles (41), Colorado (31) and Atlanta (27).

**UNDER THE RADAR ROSTER MOVE:** Outfielder Aaron Whitefield was just outrighted off the 40-man roster...he was removed from the 60-man player pool and cleared waivers...right-handed pitcher Casey Lawrence, who was signed as a minor league free agent prior to spring training, has been assigned to the 60-man player pool in St. Paul...player pool is now at 59.

NEGRO LEAGUES CENTENNIAL: The Twins will be celebrating the Negro Leagues Centennial this Sunday, August 16 when they host the Kansas City Royals...highlights of the day will include:

TV Broadcast: FS North to run an updated, never-aired segment featuring Toni Stone in the Pre-Game Show...FSN to feature a conversation with LaTroy Hawkins about Twins Baseball and the meaning of the 100th Anniversary of the Negro Leagues.

Radio Broadcast: Twins Radio to feature an interview between Dan Gladden and Bob Kendrick, the President of the Negro League Baseball Museum.

On field: Negro Leagues Centennial patch on left chest of jerseys, commemorative base jewels and lineup cards and players will wear the Negro Leagues Centennial shirt by Roots of Fight during pregame.

Other gameday features to include social posts and in-ballpark elements such as 15-20 Big Head cutouts of Negro Leagues players.

LAST TIME OUT: In a homecoming start, Pittsburgh-area native Dobnak was lights out against the Pirates on August 5, allowing just three baserunners and inducing a career-high 11 ground ball outs in 6.0 scoreless innings, as the Twins won 5-2.

TOTAL DOBINATION: Dobnak has allowed just one earned run in 15.0 innings so far this season. good for a 0.60 ERA that leads all major league pitchers who have worked at least 15.0 innings this season...his .173 opponent batting average (9-for-52) is seventh lowest in the American League (min. 50 AB) and his two wins are tied for tops among MLB rookies.

◆ According to Elias, Dobnak's 0.60 ERA so far is the fifth lowest mark by a Twins pitcher through his first three starts of the season (min. 15.0 IP), trailing only: Jim Perry in 1965 (0.36), Ervin Santana in 2017 (0.41), Fernando Romero in 2018 (0.54) and Francisco Liriano in 2006 (0.56).

**GOOSE EGGS AND GROUND BALLS:** Dobnak enters tonight with a career-best 12.0-inning scoreless streak, the longest run by any pitcher in just 2020, as well as the second-longest active run in the majors, behind Atlanta's Mark Melancon (12.1 IP, 9/7/19-present)...Dobnak also hasn't allowed a home

Turn in his last 31.1 innings (since 9/11/19), the eighth-longest active homerless streak in the majors.

Dobnak has induced 30 ground balls this season, T-5th most in the majors...his 6.00 ground ball to fly ball ratio is T-1st in MLB with Miami's Pablo López (min. 10.0 IP)...his 68.2 ground ball percentage is second in MLB (min. 10.0 IP) to tonight's Milwaukee starter, Adrian Houser (74.1).

INTERLEAGUE HISTORY: Tonight marks Dobnak's second consecutive and second career Interleague start...he's 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (7.0 IP, 1 ER) in two outings (1 start)...pitched the final inning of a 6-2 Twins loss to Washington on September 11, 2019, striking out the first batter he faced but allowing a Trea Turner solo homer, the only longball he's allowed in his career so far.

ON THE ROAD: Dobnak is 2-1 with a 0.69 ERA (26.0 IP, 2 ER) and .204 opponent batting average (20-for-98) in seven career road outings, including five starts...as a starter on the road, he has a 0.82 ERA (22.0 IP, 2 ER) and .172 (13-for-78) opponent batting average.
