THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-4 through six games on their current eight-game roadtrip, going 1-1 at Pittsburgh, 0-3 at Kansas City and winning game one in Milwaukee last night...tonight they will play the second of three in Wisconsin...after the Twins play the series finale tomorrow night at Miller Park, they will return home for an off-day on Thursday in Minneapolis, then start a seven-game homestand with four-game series vs. Kansas City (August 14-17) and another three-game series vs. Milwaukee (August 18-20).

☞ The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in the middle of an eight-game roadtrip with the second of four in Boston.

☞ When the Twins wrap up this scheduled three-game series in Milwaukee, they will have played a game on 16 consecutive days, beginning with the July 28 Home Opener... Thursday marks the lone scheduled off day in the month of August, before Minnesota is slated to play 20 straight days August 14-September 2...after that stretch, the Twins are set to have four off days in the final four weeks of the regular season (September 3, 10, 21 and 24), while playing 21 games.

ROSIE'S GRANNY SNAPS THE SLIDE: The Twins beat the Brewers last night in Milwaukee by a score of 4-2, snapping their four-game losing streak, their first win since Wednesday in Pittsburgh...Randy Dobnak (3-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, lowering his ERA to a major league leading 0.90...Eddie Rosario provided all the offense with a third inning grand slam, the Twins' second this season (Cave - July 26 at Chicago-AL) and Rosario's fourth of his career.

☞ According to *The Elias Sports Bureau*, it marks the third time in club history that a grand slam accounted for all the runs in a Twins victory:

ADDITIONAL NOTE: The Twins' .229 team batting average through the first 17 games of the season is the 14th lowest in Twins/Senators history (14th lowest out of 120 years of team history)...however, the 2020 Twins are one of three teams in Twins/Senators history to have a team batting average under .230 and at least 10 wins through the first 17 games of the season, joining the 1905 Senators (.191, 10-7) and the 1912 Senators (.216, 10-7).

WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE: The Twins are 6-1 this season in Interleague Play, going 2-0 vs. St. Louis, 3-1 vs. Pittsburgh and 1-0 vs. Milwaukee...they have had just one winning season against the NL since 2010, that coming in 2017 (13-7)...Twins' .857 IL winning percentage is tops in the AL.

☞ Remaining IL schedule (13 games): two more at Milwaukee this week...home for three vs. Milwaukee August 18-20...two at St. Louis September 8-9...three at Wrigley Field September 18-20...three at home vs. Cincinnati September 25-27.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .313 (15-for-48) with three home runs, 10 RBI and a .898 OPS in his last 12 IL games...among actives, he ranks fourth in homers and tied for third in RBI.

☞ Eddie Rosario has nine home runs and 23 RBI in his last 25 Interleague games.

BATTLE OF I-94: The Twins are 232-224 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and have a record against them of 66-55 in Interleague Play...Twins have won two of their last three at Miller Park...a win tonight would give the Twins their first series victory in Milwaukee in a three-game series since taking two of three May 18-20, 2012.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .385 (20-for-52) in 14 career games vs. MIL...hit safely in seven straight vs. the Brewers and 12 of 14 in career.

SLICK LEATHER: Twins are tied with St. Louis for fewest errors committed in baseball, having just two on the season...the only errors committed have come from Miguel Sanó on July 30 vs. Cleveland and Ehre Adrianza on August 2 vs. Cleveland...Twins rank third in defensive runs saved at 11, trailing Los Angeles-NL (16) and Cleveland (13).

SOCIAL DISTANCING BASEBALLS: Twins have homered in 13 of 17 games this season...only non-homer games came on July 30 vs. Cleveland, August 3 vs. Pittsburgh, August 4 vs. Pittsburgh and August 9 at Kansas City...they have hit 26 bombas this season, tied for fifth most in baseball with Atlanta, trailing San Diego (30), Los Angeles-NL (29), Los Angeles-AL (28) and New York-AL (27).

TWINS MAKE TRADE: The Twins announced today that they have acquired infielder Ildemaro Vargas from Arizona in exchange for cash considerations...Vargas, 29, was 3-for-20 (.150) in eight games with Arizona this season, before getting designated for assignment on Thursday...additionally, the Twins have reinstated Willians Astudillo from the 10-day Injured List and optioned him to the alternative training site.

SIRI, TELL ME ABOUT SERIES: Twins are looking for their fifth series victory today after, going 4-1-1 thus far...they went 2-1 in Chicago, 2-0 vs. St. Louis, 3-1 vs. Cleveland, 2-0 vs. Pittsburgh, 1-1 at Pittsburgh and 0-1 at Kansas City...last season the Twins went 31-15-6 in series play.

RIP, CARROLL HARDY: Outfielder Carroll Hardy passed away Sunday at age 87 from complications of dementia...Hardy played eight major league seasons finishing his career with Minnesota, playing in 11 games in 1967...Hardy was the only player ever to pinch-hit for Ted Williams, doing so on September 20, 1960 after Williams fouled a ball off his foot in the first inning...Hardy lined into a double play.

CAREER NOTES

- With his debut for the Twins, became the 25th pitcher in MLB history to play for 10 franchises...he's played for nine of the 10 since 2015.
- Appeared in 69 games in seven consecutive seasons (2010-16), and is one of just nine pitchers in major league history to reach that number in seven different seasons: RHP Kent Tekulve (10), LHP Mike Myers (9) and LHP Mike Stanton (9) are the only pitchers with more such seasons...Myers (1996-2002) and LHP Buddy Groom (1996-2002) are the only other pitchers to make 69 appearances in seven consecutive seasons...no other pitcher has more than five such seasons since 2010...has appeared in 702 games since the start of 2010, the most in baseball.
- Has 215 holds since 2010, second most in baseball (Tony Watson (219)...778.0 IP since the start of the 2009 season leads all major league relievers over that span.
- Converted from a starter to a reliever in 2009 with Washington.
- Made his MLB debut May 20, 2007, starting and earning the win for New York-AL at New York-NL (6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 3 BB, 6 K).
