THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-5 through seven games on their current eight-game roadtrip, going 1-1 at Pittsburgh, 0-3 at Kansas City and 1-1 in Milwaukee...tonight they will play the three-game series finale in Wisconsin...after the game, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow in Minneapolis, then start a seven-game homestand with a four-game series vs. Kansas City over the weekend and another three-game series vs. Milwaukee early next week.
 ☞ The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in the third of four in Boston.

OFF WISCONSIN: The Twins lost to the Brewers last night by a score of 6-4 in Milwaukee, evening the three-game series at 1-1...Tyler Clippard was the Opener, allowing one run in 1.0 inning...the Twins used six pitchers, allowing four home runs...the offense recorded 10 hits, including a season-high three from Byron Buxton, two home runs from Eddie Rosario and one homer from Jorge Polanco...Miguel Sanó played in his 500th career game.
 ☞ Manny Piña homered twice for the Brewers...he and Rosario marked the second pair of opponents to hit multiple homers in a Twins Interleague game...the other was April 9, 2019 at New York-NL, when Mitch Garver, Jonathan Schoop and Pete Alonso all did it.

NO DAYS OFF FEW DAYS OFF: Tomorrow the Twins will enjoy their second off-day of the season and will be their last off-day until September 3...in between they will play a stretch of 20 straight games, leading up to September 2...in September they will have four off-days and play 23 games during the final month.

LAG WITH THE LUMBER: After starting the season 10-2, the Twins have gone 1-5...below is a look inside their first 12 compared to their last six:

NATIONAL TREASURE: Eddie Rosario hit two home runs last night, one in the first inning and one in the third...he has now homered in three consecutive Interleague games (8/6, 8/10-11) for the second time in his career, also doing so from 8/20, 9/12-13/17...he is the second Twin to homer in three-straight IL games twice, joining Max Kepler (see chart below):

☞ Rosario joins Torii Hunter (4) and Jacque Jones (2) as the only three Twins to have two-plus multi-homer games in IL Play...Rosario's other two-homer IL game was August 8, 2017 vs. Milwaukee at Target Field.

☞ Rosario also homered in his final game vs. the Milwaukee in 2019...since the Brewers moved to the AL in 1998, only six AL players, including Rosario, have homered in three consecutive games against them...the others are Mitch Moreland (2013), Edwin Encarnación (2012), Jason Kubel (2008), Manny Ramirez (1998-2003) and Jim Thome (2001).

☞ Rosario's five IL home runs lead baseball...Twins all-time single-season record vs. NL teams is nine, done by Mitch Garver in 2019 and Trevor Plouffe in 2012...Rosie has 11 home runs in IL games since the start of 2019 (27 games), the most in baseball.

WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE: The Twins are 6-2 this season in Interleague Play, going 2-0 vs. St. Louis, 3-1 vs. Pittsburgh and 1-1 vs. Milwaukee...Twins have a .750 IL winning percentage, best in the AL and tied for fourth best in baseball...additionally, only the Rockies and Tigers have as many IL wins this season.

☞ Remaining IL schedule (12 games): one more at Milwaukee here...home for three vs. Milwaukee August 18-20...two at St. Louis September 8-9...three at Wrigley Field September 18-20...three at home vs. Cincinnati September 25-27.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .306 (63-for-206) with 12 doubles, three triples, six home runs, 27 RBI, 22 runs scored, 18 walks and a .843 OPS in 58 career Interleague games...he has a seven-game road IL hitting streak.

BORDER BATTLE SLUGFEST: The Twins are 232-225 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and have a record against them of 66-56 in Interleague Play...a win tonight would give the Twins their first series victory in Milwaukee in a three-game series since taking two of three May 18-20, 2012.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .386 (22-for-57) in 15 career games vs. MIL...has hit safely in eight straight vs. the Brewers and 13 of 15 in career.

☞ 15 of the 16 runs scored in this series between both teams have come via home run.

SIRI, TELL ME ABOUT SERIES: Twins are looking for their fifth series victory today after going 4-1-1 thus far...they went 2-1 in Chicago, 2-0 vs. St. Louis, 3-1 vs. Cleveland, 2-0 vs. Pittsburgh, 1-1 at Pittsburgh and 0-1 at Kansas City...last season the Twins went 31-15-6 in series play.

DO YOU KNOW THE DAZZLE MAN?: On this day in 1993, Twins radio superstar Dan Gladden went 3-for-6 with five RBI and a two-run homer off Fernando Valenzuela, leading the Tigers to a 17-11 victory over Baltimore...the homer capped off a streak of three straight days with a homer, the longest streak of his career...during the streak, he had 12 RBI and a 1.500 OPS in 16 at-bats - basically video game style numbers, almost like he was playing RBI Baseball 1993 on Rookie Level for Sega Genesis...additionally, Gladden's three straight homers was one of 222 times that a player has homered in three straight against Baltimore - Babe Ruth is also on that list.

BOBBLE, BOBBLE: In celebration of the team's 60th season in Minnesota, and in proud support of efforts to provide every kid a safe place to play, the Minnesota Twins today introduced a limited edition Twins Hall of Fame Bobblehead set depicting the 34 members of this exclusive club - including 2020 electee Justin Morneau...the Twins Hall of Fame Bobblehead set will go on sale at 10:00 a.m. CT tomorrow (Thursday, August 13) only at twinsbaseball.com/hofbobbles; net proceeds will benefit the Minnesota Twins Community Fund.

LAST TIME OUT: In his last start, on August 6 at Pittsburgh, Maeda put forth his second consecutive quality start, and his second of the season...he allowed three runs in 6.0 IP, and struck out four and walked one...all three runs came on one swing when Pirates outfielder Gregory Polanco hit a three-run homer in the third inning – Maeda's second longball surrendered on the season...he was in line for his 50th career win when Minnesota entered the final frame, leading 5-4, before left-hander Taylor Rogers blew the save in the ninth inning, beginning the Twins' season-long streak of four consecutive losses.

SMASHING BREWS: Maeda has faced Milwaukee five times in his career, and owns a 2-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 9 ER)...he's allowed just a single run in three of his five starts (6/19/16, 6/30/16, 8/25/17), and each of those occasions was deemed a quality start as well...he's faced the Brewers second-most of any NL Central team (St. Louis, 7 G), and is 9-6 with a 4.22 ERA (111.0 IP, 52 ER) all-time against the division.

MAEDA AMONG THE BEST: Maeda is one inning shy of qualifying for MLB leaderboards, but slots in among the league's best pitchers with at least 17.0 IP...he's currently second in batting average on balls in play (BABIP) (.146), third in opponent on-base percentage (.177), third in hits allowed (8), and fourth in opponent batting average (.136).

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: Maeda was acquired in a trade with Los Angeles-NL on February 10, along with minor league catcher Jair Camargo and cash, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Brusdar Graterol, minor league outfielder Luke Raley and a Competitive Balance B pick in the 2020 MLB First-Year Player Draft...with the draft selection, the Dodgers chose right-handed pitcher Clayton Beeter out of Texas Tech University...previously, the Twins and Dodgers exchanged pleasantries at the trade deadline in 2018 when the Twins sent infielder Brian Dozier to Los Angeles, and in return received Raley, infielder Logan Forsythe and left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer.

FRIDAY'S STARTER - JAKE ODORIZZI, RHP (SEASON: 0-0, 6.00 ERA ; CAREER: 62-55, 3.89 ERA)

On Friday, the Twins return home to begin their second homestand of the season, and have tabbed right-hander Jake Odorizzi as their starter...the 30-year-old began the season on the Injured List with a right intercostal strain, and subsequently missed 14 games...he made his 2020 debut on August 8 in Kansas City, where, on a pitch count, he threw three innings, and allowed two earned runs on four hits, and walked two and struck out two...Friday's game will mark Odorizzi's second consecutive start against the Royals, with whom he made his major league debut in 2012...all-time against the Royals, he owns a 3-5 record with a 4.94 ERA (58.1 IP, 32 ER) with 20 walks and 55 strikeouts.
