<b>THE TWINS:</b> The Twins went 3-5 on their eight-game roadtrip (August 5-12), going 1-1 at Pittsburgh,
0-3 at Kansas City and 2-1 in Milwaukeeafter their second off-day of the season yesterday, today
the Twins begin a seven-game homestand with the first and second of four vs. Kansas City and a
three-game series vs. Milwaukee starting on Tuesday.

Today the Twins commence their longest stretch of games without an off-day, playing on 19 consecutive days...Minnesota is also in the middle of playing 36 games in 36 days.
 The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in the second of three against Kansas City.

**LET'S PLAY 2:** In 2019, the Twins played three doubleheaders, and went a combined 5-1 in such situations...Minnesota swept two games at Baltimore on April 20 as a part of a three-game sweep, split vs. Detroit on May 11 and took both vs. Cleveland on September 14.

ST. LOUIS RESUMES PLAY: MLB yesterday announced the resumption of the St. Louis Cardinals' season, beginning with a doubleheader today at Chicago-AL...in an effort to create an additional off-day for the Cardinals in September, the two-game series between the Cardinals and Twins at Busch Stadium, scheduled for September 8-9, will now be played as a doubleheader on Tuesday, September 8 beginning at 2:15 p.m. (CT).

SMASHED BREWS: The Twins on Wednesday beat the Brewers in the series finale, 12-2, thus winning the three-game set...right-handed starter Kenta Maeda was perfect through 3.2 innings, marking the second time his season he's held an opponent hitless through at least 3.2 IP (4.1 on August 1 vs. Cleveland)...Maeda maneuvered into the seventh, tossing his third-consecutive quality start with 6.2 innings pitched, two runs allowed, five hits, one walk and five strikeouts...he moved to 3-0 on the season, and earned his 50th career win...Minnesota's 15 hits were a season high, and 12 runs were the most since July 26 at Chicago-AL (14).

Byron Buxton and Mitch Garver each logged three hits, with Buxton matching his season high from the night before, and Garver setting his own season best...marked the first game the Twins had two players with three-plus hits since August 3 vs. Pittsburgh.

Luis Arraez and Marwin Gonzalez each had two hits...combined with Buxton and Garver's performances, was the first instance the Twins had at least four players with multiple hits since their 14-2 rout at Chicago-AL on July 26.

**ROSTER SHUFFLE:** The Twins on Thursday announced that they reinstated right-handed pitcher Zack Littell from the 10-day Injured List and activated newly-acquired infielder Ildemaro Vargas to the 28-man roster...Vargas was acquired on Tuesday from Arizona in exchange for cash considerations... to make room on the roster, the Twins placed right-handed pitcher Cody Stashak on the 10-day Injured List with lower back inflammation (retro to August 12), and designated right-handed pitcher Cory Gearrin for release or assignment.

TWO FOR A BUCK: Byron Buxton launched two home runs against Milwaukee on Wednesday: one in the fifth inning off of Justin Grimm and the second in the sixth inning off of the sidewinding Eric Yardley...Buxton authored his second-career multi-home run game, and his first since he hit three homers in Toronto on August 27, 2017.

◆ After hitting .067 (1-for-15) with one RBI in his first six games, Buxton is batting .406 (13-for-32) with one double, five home runs, nine RBI, a .906 slugging percentage and a 1.300 OPS in his last nine games, raising his batting average to .298 (14-for-47).

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins will begin their second of three series vs. Kansas City today, and will venture to Kauffman Stadium from August 21-23 to round out their 2020 matchups...in the teams' previous meeting, the Royals swept the Twins in three games from August 7-9 in Kansas City.

4 The Twins are hitting .208 (21-for-101) with five home runs off of KC pitching this season... Twins pitching owns a 6.00 ERA (24.0 IP, 16 ER) and a .295 opp. BA vs. the Royals in 2020.

5 Eddie Rosario is hitting .321 (9-for-28) off of lan Kennedy, with three doubles, a home run, four RBI and three strikeouts.

**FIRST IN THE FIRST:** The Twins have scored 21 first-inning runs this season, which are the most in baseball, ahead of New York-AL's second-place total of 16...in the first frame, the Twins are leading MLB in batting average (.299), hits (23), total bases (46), RBI (21), on-base percentage (.378) and slugging percentage (.597).

RECORD

**SECOND IS THE BEST:** The Twins are also league-best with 20 second-inning runs, ahead of second-place Houston's 18...in the second inning, Minnesota is first in hits (28), first in RBI (19), T-first in batting avearge (.333), third in total bases (44), third in on-base percentage (.400) and sixth in slugging percentage...combined with their first-inning run production, the Twins have scored 41 runs in the first two innings, which accounts for 41.8 percent of their total runs (98).

**THIRD IS THE BASE THAT GIVES 'EM UNREST:** Entering play today, Minnesota is the only team in the majors that has yet to record a triple... the 19-game drought is the longest in Twins/Senators history to start a season, ahead of the 1966 Twins' three-bagger hiatus of 14 games... shortstop Zoilo Versalles ended the streak with a second-inning triple off Dick Stigman, who was in his first year with Boston after being traded by the Twins earlier that year... Stigman remains the only major leaguer to be born in Nimrod, Minnesota.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY, TK!**: Former manager Tom Kelly is celebrating his 70th birthday today...TK shares a birthday with actress Jennifer Lawrence (29), actor Ben Affleck (47), The Walking Dead star Emily Kinney (34), former Twins player Chad Allen (52) and former Vikings Quarterback Bubby Brister (58) - Dan Gladden's starting quarterback on his Fantasy Football team in 2000 (0 TD, 1 INT, 82 Yards)...Kelly is the Twins all-time managerial wins leader (1140)...on his birthday, Kelly holds a managerial record of 7-6.

NEGRO LEAGUES CENTENNIAL: The Twins will be celebrating the Negro Leagues Centennial tomorrow, August 16 when they host the Kansas City

Royals...highlights of the day will include:

◆ TV Broadcast: FS North to run an updated, never-aired segment featuring Toni Stone in the Pre-Game Show...FSN to feature a conversation with LaTroy Hawkins about Twins Baseball and the meaning of the 100th Anniversary of the Negro Leagues.

◆ Radio Broadcast: Twins Radio to feature an interview between Dan Gladden and Bob Kendrick, the President of the Negro League Baseball Museum.

◆ On field: Negro Leagues Centennial patch on left chest of jerseys, commemorative base jewels and lineup cards.

◆ Other gameday features to include social posts and in-ballpark elements such as Big Head cutouts of Negro Leagues players, including Toni Stone, Willie Mays and others.

"FANS" IN THE STANDS: Today's first game is the debut of the Twins' "fan faces" big head cutouts. More than 2,200, two-and-a-half-foot high likenesses of fan faces are in the lower level of the Target Field seating bowl. Fans can purchase their own likeness through end-of-day tomorrow at twinsbaseball.com/fanface (a portion of proceeds benefit the Minnesota Twins Community Fund) and will be installed before the next homestand.

LAST TIME OUT + SUMMER/SPRING REDUX: Odorizzi made his first start of the season against these Royals one week ago today, on August 8 at Kauffman Stadium, after beginning the season against these Royals one week ago today, on August 8 at Kauffman Stadium, after beginning the season on the 10-day Injured List with a right intercostal strain...worked 3.0 innings, yielding two runs on four hits, with two walks, two strikeouts and one hit batter...plunked Whit Merrifield to start the game; Merrifield later scored on a single...permitted a solo homer to Jorge Soler in the third inning, his first homer allowed at Kauffman Stadium since Aug. 30, 2017 (with Tampa Bay, 3-R HR to Merrifield).

**DOUBLE TOIL AND TROUBLE:** Today marks the first time in Jake's major league career that he'll start the first game of a doubleheader...he's started the second game of a doubleheader thrice, all for Tampa Bay...owns no record and a 4.02 ERA (15.2 IP, 7 ER) across those three starts, with five walks, nine strikeouts and a .301 opponent batting average 19-for-63).

**AGAINST THE ROYALS:** Odorizzi made his major league debut for Kansas City on September 23, 2012 and his first two career starts occurred in a Royals uniform...he's 3-5 lifetime with a 4.94 ERA (58.1 IP, 32 ER) in 12 games (11 starts) against his former organization...Odorizzi has faced the Royals just twice at Target Field, going 1-0 with a 5.79 ERA (9.1 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in those starts...overall, he's 2-3 with a 3.82 ERA (35.1 IP, 15 ER), 12 walks, 36 strikeouts and a .245 opponent batting average (34-for-139) in seven games (six starts) against Managa City as the hopp neitsber scapping his time with both Tampa Royand Minnesota Kansas City as the home pitcher, spanning his time with both Tampa Bay and Minnesota

SETTLING IN: Since 2019, opposing batters have hit .298 (28-for-94) off Jake's first 15 pitches of his starts, including 1-for-2 on August 8...in the same span, that number drops to .187 (17-for-91) for pitches 16-30 and to .172 (16-for-93) for pitches 31-45.

HONEST FEET: Catcher Mitch Garver threw Nicky Lopez out trying to steal in the second inning of Jake's last start, in a sense continuing Odorizzi's trend of being one of the most difficult pitchers in the majors to steal a base against...in 2019, Jake was one of five pitchers in the majors with at least 150.0 innings pitched and one or fewer stolen bases against (one), alongside Baltimore's John Means (155.0 IP, 0 SB), St. Louis' Jack Flaherty (196.1 IP, 1 SB), Kansas City's Brad Keller (165.1 IP, 1 SB) and Los Angeles-NL's Hyun-Jin Ryu (182.2 IP, 1 SB).

© Odorizzi also became one of five pitchers in Twins/Senators franchise history with at least 159.0 innings pitched and one or fewer stolen bases against and the first since lim Perry (168.1 IP, 1

innings pitched and one or fewer stolen bases against, and the first since Jim Perry (168.1 IP, 1 SB) for the 1963 Twins...the others were all for the Senators and are: Don Lee in 1960 (165.0 IP, 1 SB), Bob Porterfield in 1954 (244.0 IP, 0 SB) and Montie Weaver in 1934 (204.2 IP, 1 SB).

HOMER PREVENTION SQUAD: In 2019, the year of the bomba, Odorizzi was among the league's best at keeping balls in the yard, allowing just 16 home runs in 159.0 innings, good for a career best 0.91 home runs-per-9.0 IP ratio...his ratio ranked third in the American League and eighth in the majors (min. 150.0 IP)....it was also the best mark by a Twins pitcher under those same parameters since Mike Pelfrey in 2015 (0.60, 11 HR, 164.2 IP).

GUAC AND BASES ARE EXTRA: In addition to keeping hitters in the yard. Odorizzi was a master at not allowing extra-base hits last season...he allowed just 47 extra-base hits in 159.0 innings, second fewest in the AL behind Kansas City's Brad Keller (44) and tied with now-teammate Kenta Maeda for fourth fewest among major league pitchers with at least 150.0 innings worked last season.

© Overall, Odo ranked seventh in the AL last season (min. 150.0 IP) by allowing just 7.87 hits-per-9.0 IP and 11.09 base runners-per-9.0 IP.

**THE REPERTOIRE:** Jake's primary reliance on his four seamer has been constant throughout his career...he threw the pitch 57.9 percent of the time in 2019, his highest percentage throwing a single pitch in a season in his career...opponents hit just .209 (68-for-325) overall against Jake's four seamer in 2019, with right-handed batters hitting just .174 (26-for-149) against the pitch...here's the full breakdown of Odorizzi's pitches in 2019, per Baseball Savant.
