LAST TIME OUT: Dobnak extended his career-long win streak to three games in his last start on Monday in Milwaukee...allowed a second-inning run on Orlando Arcia's double, snapping his career-best scoreless innings streak at 13.0...worked 5.0 strong innings (4 H, 1 BB, 3 K) in a 4-2 Twins win.
 ♥ Dobnak has allowed two-or-fewer walks and four-or-fewer hits in each of his last six starts, dating back to Sept. 20, 2019...his run is tied with Gabriel Moya (Sept. 2-27, 2018) and Johan Santana (June 15-July 11, 2004) for the longest such streak of starts in Twins/Senators history.
 ♥ Dobnak hasn't allowed a homer since Sept. 11, 2019 vs. Washington, a span of 36.1 innings that is the sixth-longest active streak in the majors (4th in AL)...he's allowed just one homer in 48.1 career innings, good for a 0.19 HR/9.0 IP ratio that leads the majors (min. 35.0 IP) since his debut on August 9, 2019.
