- Started Game 2 of the 2019 ALDS, becoming the fourth rookie pitcher in Twins history (6th occurrence) to start a Postseason game.
- Prior to joining the Twins organization, Dobnak spent six weeks playing amateur ball for the Utica Unicorns of the United Shore Professional Baseball League.
- Pitched collegiately for Division II Alderson Broaddus University (WV)...recorded a no-hitter against Bluefield State with one walk and finished fourth in the NCAA with eight complete games in 2015...during his freshman season, finished with a 6-1 record and two complete games finishing with a 2.02 ERA...gave up just one home run all season and finished with 9.47 strikeouts per game.

DOBNAK LOOKS TO BUILD ON WHIRLWIND YEAR: the 25-year-old rookie started last season at Single-A Ft. Myers, and made his final appearance of the year on the mound against the New York Yankees in Game 2 of the American League Division Series...became just the fourth rookie in Twins history (sixth instance) to start a Postseason game and 18th ever to pitch in one...traversed four levels of the Twins' player development system, with stints in Ft. Myers, Double-A Pensacola, Triple-A Rochester and culminating in his major league debut on August 9 vs Cleveland overall went $12-4$ with a 207 ERA ( 1350 IP 31 FR) in 24 games ( 21 starts) in the minors last season...began his major league career with 9.0 scoreless innings before allowing two runs in a start September 8 vs. Cleveland.
$\Phi$ He pitched 6.0 innings with just one hit allowed Sept. 25 at Detroit, becoming the second rookie in Twins/Senators history to throw at least 6.0 innings and allow no more than one batter to reach safely via hit, walk or hit-by-pitch...Twins win, plus Cleveland loss to Chicago-AL later tha night, clinched the division title.
