THE TWINS: The Twins are 2-1 to start this seven-game homestand...tonight they will play the last of four with KC...following this series, the Twins will host the Brewers for three from Tuesday-Thursday - all night games...a 10-game road trip will follow this homestand, featuring stops in Kansas City (3 games), Cleveland (3 games) and Detroit (4 games).
 ☞ The original 2020 schedule had today as an off day for the Twins, ahead of a six-game homestand against the White Sox and Tigers...Twins are 36.7% through their current 2020 schedule.

SQUEEZED OUT A SUNDAY W: The Twins took a 2-1 lead in this series with a 4-2 win over the Royals yesterday afternoon, the third-straight game in this set with a 4-2 final score...Randy Dobnak notched his fourth win of the season, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.1 innings (1 BB, 3 K, 2 HR)...Max Kepler delivered his team-high tying sixth homer of the season, a go-ahead two-run shot in the fifth inning...Jorge Polanco drove in an insurance run in the seventh, executing the Twins' first successful squeeze play since 2017.

WISLER WHILE YOU WORK, ERM, START: Matt Wisler is due to start tonight's finale against the Royals, his first nod as a Twin and 58th career...he's 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP, 2 ER) and .167 opponent batting average (.167) in six relief outings this year...of his 135 career appearances entering tonight, 78 have come in relief and 57 have been starts...owns a career 4.71 ERA (296.0 IP, 155 ER) as a starter and 6.27 ERA (103.1 IP, 72 ER) as a reliever...appeared as an Opener eight times for Seattle in 2019, pitching 10.0 scoreless innings and allowing just four hits and one walk, with 10 strikeouts and a .121 opponent batting average (4-for-33).
 ☞ Wisler began his six-year major league career as a traditional starter and was used in the role as recently as 2018, when he got the ball thrice for Atlanta and went 1-1 with a 3.63 ERA (17.1 IP, 7 ER)...has made one traditional start against the Royals, occurring on May 15, 2016 for the Braves...worked 7.1 innings and allowed eight hits and two runs, with no walks and seven strikeouts in a no-decision.

FEELING MINNESOTA: Twins enter tonight with the second best home winning percentage in baseball.

FULL NELSON: Nelson Cruz has six home runs on the season and has now hit 47 since joining the Twins in 2019, tied for seventh most in baseball in that span...of those 47, 31 have come against the AL Central, tied with Jorge Soler for most in baseball against the division in that span...of those 47, 12 have come against the Royals - most in baseball...below is where he ranks on the all-time home run list for Dominican-born players:

ONLY RAINDROPS FALL: The Twins' defense has been the best in baseball this year, posting a .997 team fielding percentage and committing just two errors in the club's first 22 games of the season, fewest in MLB and three times fewer than the next-closest club with at least 20 games played (Houston - 6)...per Fangraphs, Twins lead the American League and rank third in the majors with 14 defensive runs saved (DRS), trailing only Los Angeles-NL (22) and Chicago-NL (16)...Twins' ultimate zone rating (UZR) of 7.7 is second in MLB to Oakland's 10.9, also according to Fangraphs.

☞ The Twins' two errors committed through the first 22 games of the season is a first in Twins/Senators history...club that came closest to that was the 2010 Twins (4 E in 22 G)...Twins are on pace to commit just 5.5 errors this season, which would be the mathematical equivalent to 15 in a 162-game season...since 1901, the record for fewest errors in a single season is 54 by Baltimore in 2013, achieving the feat in 162 games...the record for fewest in a season of irregular length is 57 by the 1994 Orioles (112 G).
 ☞ The Twins' pitching staff ranks third in the majors with a 3.44 ERA and has gotten in on the defensive fun, with four pickoffs on the season that are tied with Los Angeles-AL for second most in MLB, behind Philadelphia (5).

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins are playing the seventh of 10 vs. Kansas City today...after tomorrow, they will wrap the season series this weekend with three at Kauffman Stadium from August 21-23...Twins are just 2-4 against the Royals this season...they would have to go 3-1 head-to-head the rest of the way to avoid losing a season series to the Royals, after winning two of the last three seasons (14-5 in 2019, 9-10 in 2018 and 11-8 in 2017).

☞ The Twins are hitting .208 (37-for-178) with eight home runs off of KC pitching this season
 ☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .472 (25-for-53) with five doubles, 11 home runs, 24 RBI and a 1.697 OPS in his last 15 games vs. KC.
 ☞ Three of Max Kepler's five hits against KC this season have gone for extra bases (2B, 2 HR)...since 2018 he's batting .368 (21-for-57) against the Royals at Target Field, with six doubles, one triple, three homers, 11 RBI and 18 runs scored in 19 games.

FEELING 22: The Twins' 14-8 record through 22 games is the club's best since also going 14-8 in 2010...club's 3.44 team ERA through 22 games is the team's lowest since posting a 3.32 ERA through the first 22 in 1977...pitching staff's 1.14 WHIP is the fourth lowest mark in Twins history (1961-present) through 22 games, trailing 1972 (0.97), 1968 (1.01) and 1965 (1.11)...club's 184 strikeouts are second most in Twins history through 22 games, behind 2018 (207).

FAST STARTS: The Twins have scored in the first inning in nine of their 22 games this season and in the second inning eight times...they have a run differential of +17 (22-7) in the first inning and +9 (20-11) in the second inning.

☞ 22 first-inning runs this season are the most in baseball, ahead of New York-AL's second-place total of 19...in the first frame, the Twins are leading MLB in batting average (.284), hits (25), total bases (48), RBI (22) and slugging percentage (.545).
 ☞ Twins are also tied for league-best with 20 second-inning runs, sharing the designation with Houston...in the second inning, Minnesota is first in hits (29), third in batting average (.309) and total bases (45) and fourth in on-base percentage (.383)...combined with their first-inning run production, the Twins have scored 42 runs in the first two innings, which accounts for 38.8 percent of their total runs (108).
