ONLY RAINDROPS FALL: The Twins' defense has been the best in baseball this year, posting a . 997 team fielding percentage and committing just two errors in the club's first 22 games of the season, fewest in MLB and three times fewer than the next-closest club with at least 20 games played (Houston - 6)...per Fangraphs, Twins lead the American League and rank third in the majors with 14 defensive runs saved (DRS), trailing only Los Angeles-NL (22) and Chicago-NL (16)...Twins' ultimate zone rating (UZR) of 7.7 is second in MLB to Oakland's 10.9, also according to Fangraphs.
