ONLY RAINDROPS FALL: The Twins' defense has been the best in baseball this year, posting a . 997 team fielding percentage and committing just two errors in the club's first 23 games of the season, fewest in MLB and three times fewer than the next-closest club with at least 20 games played (Houston - 7) ...per Fangraphs, Twins lead the American League and rank third in the majors with 14 defensive runs saved (DRS), trailing only Los Angeles-NL (22) and Chicago-NL (16)...Twins ultimate zone rating (UZR) of 7.7 is second in MLB to o oakland's 10.9, also according to Fangraphs.

'PEN PALS: The Twins bullpen has posted a 3.27 ERA ( 93.2 IP, 34 ER) with 28 walks, 109 strikeouts and a 233 opponent batting average...they have allowed just one run in their last five games, posting a 0.47 ERA ( $19.0 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in that span.
NELSON CRUZ....SUPERMAN: Nelson Cruz has reached safely in each of his last 16 starts via hit, walk or hit by pitch....he is hitting . 354 (29-for82) with four doubles, eight home runs, 23 RBI and a 1.125 OPS in 23 games this season....among AL leaders, he ranks second in RBI, seventh in batting average, tied for seventh in hits, 11th in on-base percentage (.412), sixth in slugging (.695) and fourth in OPS.

LOSS PREVENTION: In his last start, on August 12 at Milwaukee, Maeda set a new season high with 6.2 innings pitched, picking up his 50th career win in the process....he became the eighth Japanese-born player to reach the milestone...the Twins won the game, 12-2, and the Brewers scored their only two runs as a result of a two-out rally in the sixth inning...Minneosta's offense gave Maeda his most run support (12) since he was cushioned with 13 runs on August 16, 2016, with Los Angeles-NL.

ANOTHER CASE OF BREWS: Maeda today faces Milwaukee for his second-consecutive start, defeating the Brewers in Milwaukee last Wednesday...he's faced the Brewers six times in his career, and owns a 3-2 record with a 2.94 ERA (33.2 IP, 11 ER)....he's allowed just a single run in three of his six starts ( $6 / 19 / 16,6 / 30 / 16,8 / 25 / 17$ ) against the Brewers, and has contributed a quality start in four of his six starts...he's faced Milwaukee second-most of any NL Central team (St. Louis, 7 G ), and is 10-6 with a 4.13 ERA (117.2 IP, 54 ER) all-time against the division
