THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 3-1 through four games on their seven-game homestand, winning the four-game series with Kansas City that ended yesterday...tonight they will begin a three-game series with Milwaukee - all night games...following this series, they will begin a 10-game road trip with stops in Kansas City (3 games - August 21-23), Cleveland (3 games - August 24-26) and trip with stops in Kansas City (3 games - August 21-23), Cleveland (3 games - August 24-26) and Detroit (4 games - August 27-30).

The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins the middle of an eight-game homestand, play-

ing game one of two with the White Sox...Twins are 38.3% through their current 2020 schedule.

TWINS TAKE SERIES VS. KC: The Twins beat the Royals last night by a score of 4-1, winning the series, improving to 6-1-1 in series play on the season...Matt Wisler was the Opener, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings...Devin Smeltzer (2-0) was the winner, pitching 2.2 scoreless innings with one hit, one walk and three strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, highlighted by two home runs from Nelson Cruz, his 36th career multi-homer game.

FULL NELSON: Nelson Cruz has eight home runs on the season and has now hit 49 since joining the Twins in 2019, tied for sixth most in baseball in that span...last night's two home runs passed Duke Snider and tied Mark Teixeira for 55th on baseball's all-time home run list:

ONLY RAINDROPS FALL: The Twins' defense has been the best in baseball this year, posting a .997 team fielding percentage and committing just two errors in the club's first 23 games of the season, fewest in MLB and three times fewer than the next-closest club with at least 20 games played (Houston − 7)...per Fangraphs, Twins lead the American League and rank third in the majors with 14 defensive runs saved (DRS), trailing only Los Angeles-NL (22) and Chicago-NL (16)...Twins' ultimate zone rating (UZR) of 7.7 is second in MLB to Oakland's 10.9, also according to Fangraphs.

The Twins' two errors committed through the first 23 games of the season is a first in Twins/ Senators history...club that came closest to that was the 2010 Twins (4 E in 23 G)...Twins are on pace to commit just 5.2 errors this season, which would be the mathematical equivalent to 14 in a 162-game season...since 1901, the record for fewest errors in a single season is 54 by Baltimore in 2013. achieving the feat in 162 games...the record for fewest in a season

54 by Baltimore in 2013, achieving the feat in 162 games...the record for fewest in a season of irregular length is 57 by the 1994 Orioles (112 G).

◆ The Twins' pitching staff ranks third in the majors with a 3.33 ERA and has gotten in on the defensive fun, with four pickoffs on the season that are tied with Atlanta and Los Angeles-AL for second most in MLB, behind Philadelphia (5).

WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE: The Twins are 7-2 this season in Interleague Play, going 2-0 vs. St. Louis, 3-1 vs. Pittsburgh and 2-1 vs. Milwaukee...Twins have a .778 IL winning percentage, best in the AL and fifth best in baseball...additionally, only the Rockies and Orioles have as many IL wins this season, both with seven.

▼ Remaining IL schedule (11 games): three vs. Milwaukee this week...two at St. Louis September 8 (DH)...three at Wrigley Field September 18-20...three at home vs. Cincinnati September 25-27.

▼ Jorge Polanco is hitting .305 (64-for-210) with 12 doubles, three triples, six home runs, 28 RBI, 24 runs scored, 19 walks and a .840 OPS in 59 career Interleague games.

▼ Eddie Posarie has five home runs and 12 PRI vs. NI appropriets this season, including three home runs, and eight PRI vs. Milwaukee

🕏 Eddie Rosario has five home runs and 12 RBI vs. NL opponents this season, including three home runs and eight RBI vs. Milwaukee.

BORDER BATTLE: The Twins are 233-225 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and have a record against them of 67-56 in Interleague Play...these two teams met August 10-12 in Milwaukee as the Twins won the first and third games.

□ Jorge Polanco is hitting .377 (23-for-61) in 16 career games vs. MIL...has hit safely in nine straight vs. the Brewers and 14 of 16 in career.

□ Nelson Cruz began his major league career with Milwaukee in 2005, appearing in eight games for the Brewers, hitting .200 (1-for-8)... that 2005 season, he was named the Brewers Robin Yount Performance Award winner for minor league Player of the Year...traded away by the Brewers to Texas on July 26, 2006...others involved in that trade, Milwaukee acquired Carlos Lee and Texas acquired Julian Cordero, Francisco Cordero, Kevin Mench and Laynce Nix.

□ Twins are hitting .288 (32-for-111) with two doubles, seven home runs, 12 walks, 20 runs scored and a .861 OPS in the three games vs. Milwaukee this season.

SOCIALLY DISTANCING BASEBALLS: The Twins have homered in 19 of 23 games this season and have hit a total of 37 bombas...they are tied with Chicago-AL for fifth in homers, trailing Los Angeles-NL (46), Los Angeles-AL (40), New York-AL (40) and San Diego (40)...Nelson Cruz's multi-homer game last night marked the sixth of the season for a Twins player...last season the Twins had a player with a multi-homer game on 33 different occasions, the most in baseball, ahead of New York-AL (28), Toronto (24) and Houston (24)...33 also marked a Major League Baseball record and was 16 more than the next best Twins team, the previous record being 17, done in 1986.

'PEN PALS: The Twins bullpen has posted a 3.27 ERA (93.2 IP, 34 ER) with 28 walks, 109 strikeouts and a .233 opponent batting average...they have allowed just one run in their last five games, posting a 0.47 ERA (19.0 IP, 1 ER) in that span.

NELSON CRUZ....SUPERMAN: Nelson Cruz has reached safely in each of his last 16 starts via hit, walk or hit by pitch...he is hitting .354 (29-for-82) with four doubles, eight home runs, 23 RBI and a 1.125 OPS in 23 games this season...among AL leaders, he ranks second in RBI, seventh in batting average, tied for seventh in hits, 11th in on-base percentage (.412), sixth in slugging (.695) and fourth in OPS.

LOSS PREVENTION: In his last start, on August 12 at Milwaukee, Maeda set a new season high with 6.2 innings pitched, picking up his 50th career win in the process...he became the eighth Japanese-born player to reach the milestone...the Twins won the game, 12-2, and the Brewers scored their only two runs as a result of a two-out rally in the sixth inning...Minneosta's offense gave Maeda his most run support (12) since he was cushioned with 13 runs on August 16, 2016, with Los Angeles-NL.

ANOTHER CASE OF BREWS: Maeda today faces Milwaukee for his second-consecutive start, defeating the Brewers in Milwaukee last Wednesday...he's faced the Brewers six times in his career, and owns a 3-2 record with a 2.94 ERA (33.2 IP, 11 ER)...he's allowed just a single run in three of his six starts (6/19/16, 6/30/16, 8/25/17) against the Brewers, and has contributed a quality start in four of his six starts...he's faced Milwaukee second-most of any NL Central team (St. Louis, 7 G), and is 10-6 with a 4.13 ERA (117.2 IP, 54 ER) all-time against the division.

MAEDA AMONG THE BEST: Maeda ranks near the top of several MLB categories among qualified pitchers, including WHIP (3rd, 0.72) and opponent batting average (6th, .193)...furthermore, here is how Maeda stacks up against MLB pitchers with at least 20.0 innings pitched this season:

 Entering 2020, 9.79 career K/9.0 IP ratio was fourth among Japanese-born pitchers in MLB history (min. 100.0 IP), and .227 career opponent batting average was sixth.
- Recorded his first career save in his first career relief appearance on June 9, 2017 (4.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 6 K).
- 16 wins in 2016 were the second most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
